Director General, NIC visit to Puducherry

L-G moots MoU with MeitY to popularise a translation app

Lt. Governor K. Kailashnathan has mooted an agreement between the government and the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) to facilitate widespread adoption of the Bhashini translation app in the Union Territory.

Mr. Kailashnathan, who was briefed on the app by a visiting team from the Ministry at the Raj Nivas, called for popularising the usage of the app so people could benefit.

The Lt. Governor called for initiating steps to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the MeitY to implement the app on a pilot basis in Puducherry soon, a press note from the Raj Nivas said.

As envisaged, the Central government will provide the project app to the government free of cost, in addition to facilitating technical assistance and experts.
