Real-Time Speech Transcription and Translation at the Event

To enhance accessibility and understanding for a diverse audience, **BHASHINI's "Shrutlekh"** **real-time speech transcription application** was deployed during the event.

Key Features:

- Live speech transcription from **Telugu to English**
- Real-time display of transcribed content on the **main event screen**
- Accurate capture of speeches and addresses delivered during the programme
- Improved inclusivity for **non-Telugu-speaking attendees**, officials, and observers
- Support for **two-way voice-based interaction** between officials and citizens
- Enhanced communication with **tourists, tribal communities, and linguistically diverse populations**

This initiative aligns with the vision of **technology-enabled, citizen-centric governance and policing**, particularly in linguistically diverse regions such as **Araku Valley**.

Role of NIC Andhra Pradesh

Officials from **NIC Visakhapatnam (DIO/DIA/FMS)** were entrusted with providing comprehensive **technical support** during the event, which included:




Fig 1: Live Translation of Speech Given by Hon'ble Tourism of AP Sri K. Durgesh garu
