Origin & Evolution

The Andhra Pradesh Vigilance Commission came into being on **27 June 1964**, as an independent advisory body to deal with prevention of corruption and maintenance of integrity in public services, ensuring just and fair exercise of administrative powers vested in authorities under the State Government. It's primary objective is to advise the Government on matters relating to corruption, misconduct, lack of integrity or other malpractices or misdemeanour, on the part of public servants under the executive power of the State.

Abolition & Revival

The Commission was abolished vide **G.O.Ms.No.72, G.A. (SC.E) Department, dated 03-02-1983**, creating a special authority called "Dharma Mahamatra". With the enforcement of the **Andhra Pradesh Lok Ayukta and Upa Lok Ayukta Act, 1983**, the Commission was formally abolished on **18-08-1984**. Based on the recommendations of the Committee on Administrative Re-organisation, the Commission was revived through **G.O.Ms. No.368, G.A. (SC.D) Department, dated 29-06-1993**. It re-started functioning from

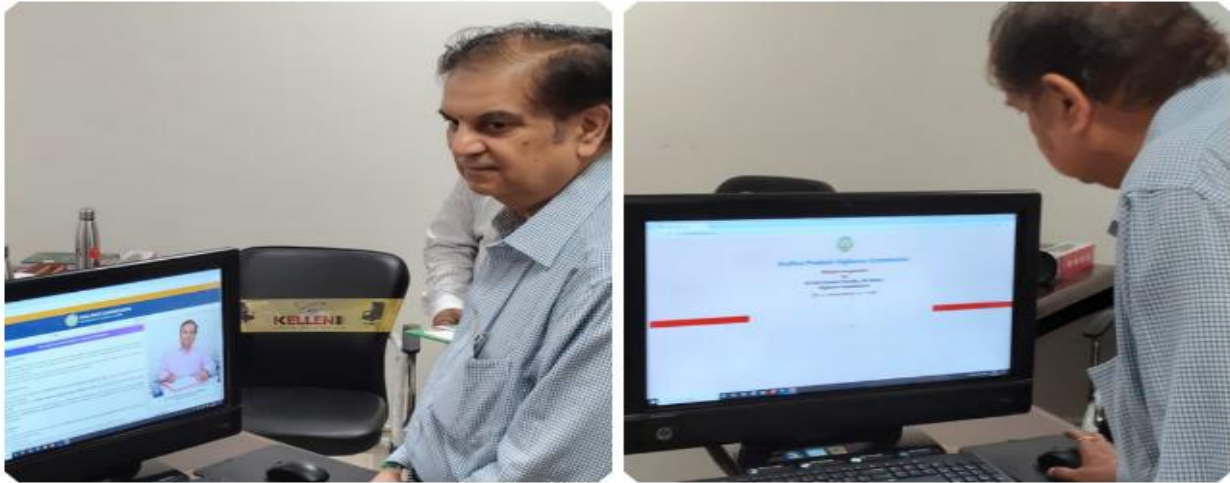
