In the present Writ Petition, the petitioners have called in question the seniority list of Assistant Engineers, issued by the Uttarakhand Power Corporation Ltd. vide Office Memorandum dated 04.06.2025. 7. The submission of Shri Shobhit Saharia, Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioners, is that the present seniority list is in teeth of the directions issued by this Court, vide judgment dated 27.06.2024 passed in Writ Petition (S/B) No. 579/2017 and other

connected matters.

8. The submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that the respondents, on basis of the impugned seniority list, are in a hurry to hold DPC and make promotions on the post of Executive Engineers, which would cause serious prejudice to the petitioners.

9. We observe that some of the private respondents, namely respondent nos. 3 to 7, 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, 27 & 28 are duly represented.

10. Having regard to the nature of the controversy, we permit the petitioners to serve the remaining private respondents by speed post, by taking steps within three days. In addition, these respondents would also be served by the Uttarakhand Power Corporation Ltd., as these private respondents are under its employment.

11. Learned Senior Counsel for the respondent-Corporation states that she has instructions that the Corporation would not hold DPC for two weeks.

12. Having regard to the above, let the instant matter be listed on 26.02.2026.

13. In the meantime, it shall be open to the parties to exchange affidavits.
