1. The Para No. "4. Billing in Defective Meter (ADF/IDF), Meter Not Accessible/ Not Read (NA/NR) and Defective Reading (RDF) Cases" under the Annexure 8.1: Rate Schedule Effective from 01.04.2026 reads as under:


"... These charges shall be leviable for a maximum period of two billing cycle in case of bi-monthly billing only during which time the licensee is required to replace the defective meter..."

The same be corrected and read as under:


"... These charges shall be leviable for a maximum period of two billing cycle only and during this period the licensee is required to replace the defective meter..."
