

A. Fee Types

SRPF: CSAB-Special Round Processing Fee of ₹ 4,000/- (Non-refundable fee towards participation in CSAB-Special Round).

IAF-I: Institute Admission Fee-I of ₹ 40,000/- for GEN/GEN-EWS/OBC-NCL or ₹ 20,000/- for SC/ST/PwD (first installment of admission fee in the allotted institute).

IAF-II: Institute Admission Fee-II of ₹ 32,000/- for GEN/GEN-EWS/OBC-NCL or ₹ 12,000/- for SC/ST/PwD (second installment of admission fee in the allotted institute).

SREF: CSAB-Special Round Enrollment Fee, which is the total amount of SRPF + IAF-I.

Candidates, who have participated in JoSSA Rounds are also eligible to participate in CSAB-Special Round. For such candidates, if they have paid SAF and/or PAF, the same will be adjusted after deduction of JoSAA Processing Fee (₹ 4,000/-) and Withdrawal Fee (₹ 3,000/-), as applicable.

Notes: In addition to the above fees, following two adjustments may be applicable in certain cases:

- Candidates whose categories were changed from SC/ST/PwD to GEN/GEN-EWS/OBC-NCL during online document verification in JoSAA Rounds and have not paid Partial Admission Fee (PAF), are required to pay ₹ 20,000/-, which is the difference of SAF between GEN/GEN-EWS/OBC-NCL category and SC/ST/PwD category candidates.
- IAF-II of ₹ 32,000/- (for GEN/GEN-EWS/OBC-NCL) and ₹ 12,000/- (for SC/ST/PwD) towards second installment of admission fee in the allotted institute have to be paid by all candidates, who have been allocated a seat in the CSAB Special Rounds. However, candidates who have already paid PAF during JoSAA Rounds (*i.e.* Type-6 candidates) will not be required to pay IAF-II in CSAB Special Rounds.

B. Eligible Candidate Types

The details of specific Types of eligible candidates are mentioned below.

Type-1: Candidates who did not register in JoSAA 2023 rounds but are eligible as per the eligibility criteria.

Type-2: Candidates who have participated in JoSAA 2023 but have not been allotted any seat.

Type-3: Candidates who have participated in JoSAA 2023 and have been allotted seats but cancelled due to non-payment of SAF.

Type-4: Candidates who have exercised the EXIT option during JoSAA 2023.

Type-5: Candidates who have participated in JoSAA 2023 and have been allotted seats in any IIT and later

- a. their seats have been CANCELLED after document verification, OR
- b. they have WITHDRAWN from their allotted seats, OR
- c. they have taken admission therein.

Type-6: Candidates who have participated in JoSAA 2023 and have been allotted seats in NIT+ System and have already SECURED ADMISSION at the allotted institute by paying the SAF and PAF.

Type-7: Candidates who have participated in JoSAA 2023 and have been allotted seats in NIT+ system and later they have WITHDRAWN from their allotted seats.

Type-8: Candidates who have participated in JoSAA 2023 and have been allotted seats in NIT+ System but later their seats have been CANCELLED after document verification and have not been allotted any seat in any of the subsequent JoSAA rounds (with their updated credentials provided they fulfill the eligibility).

Type-9: Candidates who have participated in JoSAA 2023 and have been allotted seats in NIT+ System and have paid SAF and successfully completed document verification but their seats have been CANCELLED due to non-payment of PAF.

Note: Type-6 candidates will be participating in CSAB Special Rounds while retaining their seats for which they have already secured admission after JoSAA rounds. In case, a new seat is allotted in CSAB Special round, then their retained seats will **AUTOMATICALLY GET CANCELLED** and candidates **will not have any claim** on the previously secured/retained seats (refer Annexure-1 of CSAB 2023 Special Rounds Information Brochure).

If a candidate fails to register for the CSAB Special Rounds as per the schedule given on CSAB 2023 website, she/he will not be considered in any of CSAB Special Rounds of seat allotment.
