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1. INTRODUCTION

National Testing Agency (NTA) and Central Seat Allocation Board (CSAB) are two different and independent boards. NTA conducts JEE (Main) examination and publishes the Common Rank List (CRL). CSAB-2026 uses the CRL prepared and published by NTA for seat allocation purposes. The same CRL will be used by CSAB- NEUT for admission to Engineering/Architecture courses. CSAB-2026 or CSAB NEUT 2026 will use the candidate's data and CRL of JEE (Main) -2026 as provided by NTA without any modification. **Qualifying in the National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) is mandatory for entry in the five-year Bachelor of Architecture (B. Arch) course. However, Centrally Funded Institutions of India that admit students through JEE paper 2 are exempted from NATA in 2026. Candidates are advised to visit the website of the respective institution to ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility criteria as stipulated by the admitting institution.**

Government of India has an ongoing scheme of reservation of few seats in Engineering/Technology/Architecture/Pharmacy courses conducted at degree level Technical Institutions across the country, for students belonging to 08 North East States (Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura) and 05 Union Territories (Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep and Ladakh) which do not have engineering colleges/polytechnics or have lack of facilities for education in specific field of technical education and for certain categories including foreign students. In order to have maximum possible participation of eligible students with utmost transparency, the Ministry of Education (erstwhile Ministry of Human Resource Development, MHRD) has taken a decision of conducting seat allotment on such seats through a Centralized Seat Allotment Board for North Eastern States and Union Territories (CSAB NEUT-2021). Since 2021, North Eastern Regional Institute of Science and Technology (NERIST), Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh has joined as a participating Institute for admitting students in different courses from the different north eastern states of the country. CSAB NEUT-2026 will allot seats to candidates on the basis of their CRL in JEE (Main)-2026 to the first year of Engineering/Technology, Architecture courses. **Allotment for pharmacy will be on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in class XII.** It is important to note that these seats are **other than those offered** through CSAB-2026, which is for NITs, IIITs & GFTIs.

Candidates are advised to read information brochure carefully and visit CSAB Portal (<https://csab.nic.in>) regularly for updates and for details regarding the entire online admission process as no postal communication will be used.

The entire admission process will consist of two rounds, to be conducted by CSAB NEUT-2026. It may be followed by a spot round, which will be conducted by the respective DTEs of North Eastern States/UTs and NERIST Itanagar.

2. REGISTRATION

2.1 Online Provisional Registration

- i) All **eligible candidates should register** on the CSAB portal (<https://csab.nic.in>) as per the schedule.

First time Log In: For admission to **Engineering/Architecture**, eligible candidates should log-in using Roll Number of JEE (Main)-2026 and Password created during JEE (Main) / JEE(Adv.) registration

- For admission to **Pharmacy**, eligible candidates will be required to create the log-in/password through separate link available on CSAB Portal.
- Candidates are advised to record/remember their password for all future logins and not to disclose or share their password with anybody. Neither CSAB NEUT - 2026 nor NIC is responsible for violation or misuse of the password of a candidate. Candidates can change their password after login, if desired at any point of time.
- Candidates will be permitted to proceed with the registration process, only if the data entered by them match the data as available with the JEE (Main)-2026 database of NTA, for Engg. / Arch.
- In case of any discrepancy the registration is liable to be cancelled.

Subsequent login:

Candidates shall be able to login directly with their JEE (Main)-2026 Roll No. (In case of Engineering/ Architecture) and provided user ID for Pharmacy.

- ii) Arrangement of **Help Centers has been made by all DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST** for guiding the candidates. Candidates may seek guidance from these Centers during working hours (**normally 9.00 AM to 5.00 PM**).

2.2 Eligibility requirements

For Engineering and Architecture:

2.2.1 Candidates must secure a rank in JEE (Main) 2026 Paper-1 for B.E./B.Tech. programs or must secure a rank in JEE (Main) 2026 Paper-2 for B.Arch. programs, as applicable.

2.2.2 Candidates must have passed the Class XII (or equivalent) Board examination in the year 2024 or 2025 or 2026 and must fulfill the following academic criteria as mentioned below.

2.2.3 Academic Criteria: The academic qualifications prescribed (Vide MOE Notification, F. No. 19-1/2019-TC, dated 14/06/2019) are as under:

- i. The candidate should have secured at least 45% marks in the 12th class examination, conducted by the respective Boards.

For Architecture, should have passed 10+2 examination with at least 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics combined and at least 50% marks in aggregate of 10+2 level examination or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate (Council of Architecture, Gazette of India, Part III – Sec 4, 11th August 2020). Candidates seeking admission in B. Arch courses need to qualify the aptitude examination conducted by NTA [JEE (Main) Paper-2] or CoA (NATA) (Council of Architecture, Gazette of India, 19th July 2023).

- ii. For SC/ST/PwD candidates, relaxation of 5% (five percent) of marks obtained in the qualifying examination for admission shall be considered.

Note: For 2.2.3.i and 2.2.3.ii, the marks scored in the following five subjects will be considered for calculating the aggregate marks and the qualifying marks for fulfilling criterion: (i) Physics, (ii) Chemistry, (iii) Mathematics, (iv) a language (if the candidate has taken more than one language, then the language with the higher marks will be considered), and (v) any subject other than the above four (the subject with the higher marks will be considered).

For Pharmacy:

2.2.4. Candidates must have passed the Class XII (or equivalent) Board examination in the year 2024 or 2025 or 2026 and must fulfill the following academic criteria as mentioned below.

2.2.5 Allotment is to be done on the basis of aggregate percentage of class XII, and the candidates must have passed class XII with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the following subjects: Mathematics, Biology, Biotechnology, and Computer.

Note: *Candidates are also requested to ascertain the minimum academic qualification requirements for Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy courses before filling the choices of various colleges.*

2.2.6 Date of Birth (DOB)

As prescribed in the Information Bulletin and Application Form of JEE (Main)-2026.

2.2.7 List of Qualifying Examinations

- i. The final examination of the 10+2 system, conducted by any recognized central /state Board, such as Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi; Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi; etc.
- ii. The final examination of the 10+2 system, conducted by a Central or State Board recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU <https://www.aiu.ac.in/>).

- iii. Intermediate or two-year Pre-University examination conducted by a Board or University recognized by the Association of Indian Universities.
- iv. Final examination of the two-year course of the Joint Services Wing of the National Defence Academy.
- v. Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Institute of Open Schooling with a minimum of five subjects.
- vi. Any Public School, Board or University examination in India or in a foreign country recognized as equivalent to the 10+2 system by the AIU.
- vii. H.S.C. vocational examination.
- viii. A Diploma recognized by the All-India Council for Technical Education (AICTE <http://www.aicte-india.org/>) or a State Board of Technical Education of at least 3 years duration.
- ix. In case the Class XII examination is not a public examination, the candidate must have passed at least one public (Board or Pre-University) examination earlier.

2.2.8 State of Domicile

Different states/UTs/NERIST have different sets of rules for defining their domicile conditions. Candidates are advised to go through the section of 'Business Rules' for these conditions. They are strongly advised to check the conditions of their domicile states/UTs/NERIST. In case of lack of information or confusion, they should contact the Directorate of Technical / Higher Education of their states /UTs/NERIST (which is also help Centre for CSAB NEUT-2026) for clarification as needed. CSAB NEUT-2026 has no role in defining the conditions of domicile for any participating states/UTs/NERIST.

2.2.9 Reservation of Seats

As per rules of the home state / UT, candidates belonging to various categories will be allotted seats reserved for them. These criteria and conversion rules for various states/UTs are available in Section 12 (State wise Business Rules).

Persons with Disability (PwD)

For candidates coming under persons with disability (PwD) category, a minimum of 40% disability is required subject to the condition that the candidate is capable of carrying out activities related to theory and practical work as applicable to B.E./B. Tech./B. Arch./B. Pharma Courses.

- The certificate not issued by a medical board or invalid/ expired on the date of reporting shall not be accepted in any case. The certificate should remain valid till **31.12.2026**.
- Candidates belonging to Persons with Disability category (PwD) shall upload the PwD Certificate in the proforma given in Annexure-III or Unique Disability Identity Card (UDID). This proforma shall be signed by three members of Medical Authority duly constituted by the State or Central Government under PwD Act. One of the doctors in the Medical Authority shall be a specialist in the

particular field pertaining to the disability. The name, degree, and specialization of all the doctors, date of issue shall be clearly visible in the certificate.

- The Medical Authority at Admitting Institute will examine the Persons with Disabilities (PwD) certificate and / or Unique Disability Identity Card (UDID) and submit its recommendations regarding the admissibility of the certificate.
- The JEE (Main) 2026 qualified PwD candidates with a valid **UDID** card indicating disability are **NOT** required to report physically for verification.
- The PWD certificate/UDID card should stand valid up to December 31, 2026.
- Candidates with disabilities are advised to take an informed decision about the branch/discipline they would like to go for, in an institute. Before taking such a decision they are strongly advised to refer to list of identified posts published by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India vide No: 16-70/2004-DD III Dt. 18-1-2007 and amended thereafter from time to time.

2.3 Documents to be uploaded by the candidates

- i. During online registration, candidates are required to provide/verify information viz. Gender, State of Domicile, Category, PwD Status, Special Benefit claim for Manipur, Sub-Tribe Claim for Nagaland, PRC/Domicile, and Aggregate percentage of class XII or equivalent marks on CSAB portal.
- ii. Candidate are required to upload the scanned copy of the original documents (both side in a single file) in PDF OR JPG format against their claims [Photo ID Proof as per GOI, Admit Card of JEE (Main) – 2026 (not applicable for pharmacy candidates), Class X certificate, Class XII Certificate, domicile certificate, category, sub-category, PwD certificate, special benefit, PRC/Domicile certificate etc.]

- i. Any photo ID proof
- ii. Admit Card of JEE(Main)-2026 (Not applicable for **Pharmacy**)
- iii. Class X (High School) Board Certificate as proof of date of birth
- iv. Certificate and Marks sheet of qualifying examination. (See Section 2.2.7 for the list of qualifying exams)
- v. Certificate of category / subcategory / caste / sub-caste as applicable, issued by the competent authority [Annexure -I for **Non-Creamy Layer OBC** (OBC-NCL certificate issued on or after 01.04.2026) and Annexure II for SC/ST].
- vi. Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), (Annexure–III (PWD Forms)) and /or Unique Disability Identity Card (UDID), if applicable. The certificate should be issued from a duly constituted Medical Board. The certificate should stand valid up to December 31, 2026. Certificate not issued by a medical board &/or getting expired before 31.12.2026 shall not be accepted.
- vii. Proof of place of examination center in case of final qualifying examination is from the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) formerly known as National Open School (NOS)
- viii. Permanent Resident Certificate (PRC)/Domicile, if applicable
- ix. Medical Certificate (Annexure–III)
- x. Declaration/Undertaking from the Candidate (Annexure-IV)
- xi. Undertaking by the Parents/Guardian (Annexure-V)
- xii. Special Benefit claim certificate (if applicable)
- xiii. Any other documents as desired by the respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST

Note: If the original certificates are not in Hindi/English, duly certified Hindi/English version translation of such certificates will be required at the time of physical document verification at the Allotted Institute.

Disclaimer: It will be the sole responsibility of the candidate to verify his/her minimum eligibility and / or special eligibility for a particular course/program/Institute and the availability of chosen programs (Course and Institute). CSAB NEUT-2026 or DTEs will not be responsible for any cancellation of seats due to non-fulfillment of minimum eligibility and / or special eligibility conditions or Non-availability of the seats / Programs.

2.4 Document verification

Verifying officials at the respective DTEs of North Eastern State/UTs/NERIST will be verifying the documents online uploaded by the candidates during specified period and will take the decision as follows:

- a) If documents are correct, candidature will be “**Confirmed**” online and a message will be communicated to candidates via SMS/email.
- b) If documents are incorrect, candidature will be marked “**Ineligible**” and a message will be communicated to candidates via SMS/email.
- c) If the verifying officer of respective DTEs/UTs/NERIST finds discrepancy in documents, he/she will raise query and information regarding query will be sent to the candidate by SMS/Email.
- d) Candidates are required to respond to the query raised by the verifying officer by using their login credentials in order to resolve the query in the scheduled time duration.
- e) It is mandatory for candidates to respond to the query. If the candidate does not respond to the query he/she will be declared “**Ineligible**”, accordingly a message will be communicated to them via SMS/email and the candidate will not be considered for the CSAB NEUT - 2026 counseling.
- f) If the query raised by the verifying officer are satisfactorily replied and resolved, the candidature will be “**Confirmed**” online and a message will be communicated to candidates via SMS/email. If the information submitted by any candidate is found to be incorrect, false or fraudulent, the seat allotted (if any) is liable to be cancelled. Moreover, such candidates will no longer be considered eligible for admission and will also be liable for legal action.
- g) After online document verification by respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST, eligible candidates will be able to fill their choices of preference in online mode using CSAB Portal.
- h) If the information submitted by any candidate is found to be incorrect, false or fraudulent, the seat allotted (if any) is liable to be cancelled. Moreover, such candidates will no longer be considered eligible for admission and will also be liable for legal action.

2.5 Cancellation due to non-fulfillment of Eligibility of Essential Requirements

- If the candidates fail to satisfy the minimum educational qualifications and special eligibility conditions as mentioned in Section 2.2 and Section 12 (State wise Business Rules), their allotment will automatically be cancelled. Such candidates will not be considered for seat allotment in subsequent round, if any.
- If a candidate is allotted a seat in reserved category/sub-category but fails to produce appropriate category certificate(s), his/her seat allotment will be cancelled.
- It will be the sole responsibility of the candidate to verify his/her minimum eligibility and / or special eligibility for a particular course/program/institute.

CSAB NEUT-2026 or NIC will not be responsible for any cancellation of seat due to non-fulfillment of minimum eligibility and / or special eligibility conditions.

3. FILLING UP OF CHOICES, SAVING AND LOCKING

3.1 Filling up of Choices

All the registered candidates, after successful document verification are required to fill their choices of branches and institutes in order of their preference. The detailed procedure is outlined below:

- i. Candidate must ensure that the pop-ups are enabled on their internet browser before online choice filling.
- ii. All choices (available seat information) relating to institutes, disciplines (Engineering/Technology and Architecture), branches (e.g., Electronics Engineering, Computer Science, etc.) will be displayed. Candidates should check from the websites of the respective Institutes if there are any special restrictions or special criteria, and should fill only those choices for which they are eligible:

For example, in some institutes seats for Mining may not be for female and PwD candidates. Even if these seats are visible in the choice matrix, female and PwD candidates should not fill them as their choice. Additionally, some colleges are exclusively Girls' College. In case these seats are filled by male candidates and allotment to them is made on those seats, CSAB NEUT-2026 shall not be responsible in any manner for any consequences including denial of admission by the college despite issuance of allotment letter. Some Institutes may offer five-year programs. B. Arch. Program is of five-year duration.

- iii. Candidates can, and should, fill in maximum numbers of choices in the order of their preference from the list of available seat choices.
- iv. For **Pharmacy**, separate choice filling has to be done by logging into the portal specific for Pharmacy candidates as mentioned in Section 2.1.

3.2 Saving and locking of choices

- i. Candidates, after filling up their choices must SAVE their choices.
- ii. 'SAVING' a choice is NOT the same as 'LOCKING' a choice. A choice that is only saved but not locked, can be retrieved later on and modified. The modified choice has to be saved again and the previously filled choices will be lost, once the new choices are saved. But a choice that is locked cannot be modified again.
- iii. Candidates are permitted, if they so desire, to change or re-order their choices, delete or edit earlier choices and add new choices any number of times until they lock their final choices. **CHOICES ONCE LOCKED CANNOT BE EDITED/ALTERED**. Choices should be positively locked before the scheduled date and time.
- iv. Candidates **MUST** lock their choices only after they have finalized them but, within the scheduled date and time. **The locking of choices involves a few steps after the LOCK button is clicked. This includes entering the password,**

confirming the locking, etc. Candidate should follow all the steps carefully to complete the locking procedure.

- v. A printable version of the choices along with the terms and conditions agreed by the candidate at the time of registration will be displayed once the choices are locked.
- vi. Candidates must download the PDF of the locked choices, (which also contains terms and conditions), sign it, and keep it for their own records.
- vii. If a candidate fails to explicitly lock his/her choices before scheduled date and time, his/her **last saved choices will be automatically locked** after the deadline. Candidates are therefore strongly advised to lock their choices themselves and secure a print out of these locked choices. Registered candidates who do not fill any choices or fail to save them even once will not be considered for admission and seat allotment. Candidates can login again after locking the choices; **the locked choices will be displayed but cannot be modified or altered.**

4. ONLINE SEAT ALLOTMENT

As per the allotment policy, seat allotment will be done in two rounds.

4.1 First Round of Seat Allotment and Online Reporting

- During this step, the choices submitted by the candidates will be processed centrally and seats will be allotted in the order of merit as per JEE (Main)-2026 CRL (for **Engineering/Architecture**) or % marks of class-XII (for **Pharmacy**) and on the basis of the locked choices. The seat allotment result will be displayed on CSAB Portal. Individual allotment letters will not be sent to the candidates. Therefore, candidates are advised to visit the CSAB Portal for seat allotment. A general message *via* email or SMS will be sent to the candidates who are allotted a seat. ***No individual allotment letters will be sent to candidates who get a seat allotted.***
- After the declaration of **First Round** of seat allotment, all the candidates who have been allotted a seat, will require to do the following activities ***failing which their seat allotment shall stand cancelled. Also, they will not be considered for second round of seat allotment.***
- Online payment of seat allotment/acceptance fee (SAF) of an amount of **Rs 5,000/-** (Rupees five thousand only) in favour of **CSAB-2026 using Net Banking/** Debit card / Credit card or State Bank of India e-challan.
- Candidates are required to exercise **one of the following three options** to indicate their willingness:
 - i. **Option-I (Float)**, if they wish to be considered in the next round for all of their higher preference choices (i.e., across institutes).
 - ii. **Option-II (Slide)**, if they wish to be considered in the next round for their higher preference choices only within the institute allotted to them.
 - iii. **Option-III (Freeze)**, if they are satisfied with the currently allotted seat;

therefore, their higher preference choices will not be considered in the subsequent round i.e. Second Round.

- If a candidate opted for **Option-III (Freeze)** then, his/her allotment will be automatically communicated to the respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST for their approval. The respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST, after online verification of candidate's eligibility of admission to the allotted Institute, State of Domicile, PwD status (if any), PRC (if applicable) will approve the allotted seat to the candidates in the scheduled duration. After approval of the respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST, candidates will be able to download and print **Provisional Admission Letter (PAL)**. Candidate should **report to the allotted Institute for admission** as per schedule along with the **PAL** and other **necessary documents in original**.
- Candidates should be aware of the fee structure of the institutes where they are interested to take admission. The fee structure of different participating institute may be different. For details about the infrastructure, hostel facility, fees, placement record etc., candidates are advised to contact the respective institute or to visit their website. CSAB NEUT-2026 is confined only to allotment of the seats in the participating institute and will not be responsible for any claim made by any particular institute.
- Moreover, if a student reports and joins at the allotted Institute and makes the payment of fees etc. but subsequently quits the college, the fee etc. deposited at the Institute may or may not be refunded by the Institute. CSAB NEUT-2026 will not be responsible for this in anyway.
- If candidates opted Option-I (Float) or Option-II (Slide) then, he/she has to **wait for 2nd and final round** of seat allotment.

4.2 Second Round of Seat Allotment and Online Reporting

- Second round of seat allotment will be processed as per business rules and result will be displayed on the CSAB portal. A general message will be sent to the candidates who are allotted a seat via email/SMS.
- All registered candidates who have not been offered a seat in the 1st round as well as those who have opted for Option-I or Option-II will be eligible for 2nd and final round of seat allotment.
- Second round of seat allotment will be made against vacant seats available after the first round of allotment and online reporting i.e., number of candidates not reported after first round OR not paid seat acceptance fee and not submitted willingness.
- Seats thus falling vacant (**vacant seats**) will be considered for allotment in the second round of allotment, which involves sliding of allotted seats to higher choices (if opted by the candidates) and allotting seats to other candidates on the seats becoming vacant due to sliding, as per their choices, merit and as per the business rules of the respective States/UTs/NERIST. However, only those

candidates are considered in second round who are already registered before the first round (i.e., no fresh registrations are allowed in the second round).

- **Only the fresh allottee of second round will be required to pay the SAF of Rs. 5,000/- online** [Four thousand rupees only] in favour of **CSAB-2026 using Net Banking / Debit card / Credit card/State Bank of India e-challan** (Failing which their seat allotment shall stand cancelled). The respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST, after online verification of candidate's eligibility of admission to the allotted Institute, State of Domicile, PwD status (if any), PRC (if applicable) will approve the allotted seat to the candidates in the scheduled duration. After approval of the respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST, candidates will be able to download and print **Provisional Admission Letter (PAL)**. Candidate should report to the allotted Institute for admission as per schedule along with provisional admission letter and other necessary documents in original.
- Candidates who opted for **Option-I** or **Option-II** in the first round, will finally be allotted seats (either an upgraded choice OR already allotted seat after first round) after the declaration of the second round of seat allotment. The respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST, after online verification of candidate's eligibility of admission to the allotted Institute, State of Domicile, PwD status (if any), PRC (if applicable) will approve the allotted seat to the candidates in the scheduled duration. After approval of the respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST, candidates will be able to download and print **Provisional Admission Letter (PAL)**. Candidate should report to the allotted Institute for admission as per schedule along with the **PAL** and other necessary documents in original.

4.3 Consequences of not reporting online

If any candidate, after being allotted a seat (in either first or second round) does not report ONLINE in stipulated time period, will lose the allotted seat and will not be considered for allotment. Hence, they will be out of CSAB NEUT - 2026 allotment/admission process. They may however participate in the spot round, if conducted by the respective states/UTs/NERIST.

5. SEAT WITHDRAWAL

Those candidates, who have a seat allotted to them either from the first round or from the second round, can withdraw their seat in the stipulated time frame after the second round if they want so, through the CSAB Portal. Such candidates will be re- funded Rs.4000/- out of Rs. 5000/-. **This refund will be made by CSAB-2026 after the counselling process is over.** Such candidates will forfeit their claim on the allotted seat. They may still participate in the spot round (if any) conducted by the respective DTE/NERIST.

6. PHYSICAL REPORTING FOR ADMISSION

- Candidates, who have downloaded the PAL should directly report to the allotted Institute for admission along with all the necessary documents in original as per **CSAB NEUT- 2026 schedule**.
- Candidates with downloaded PAL after the first round of seat allotment need not to wait for the declaration of second round of results and they can directly report to the allotted Institute for admission.
- Candidates are required to carry **following original documents** in order to verify their credential at the time of admission to the allotted Institute:
 1. Printout of Provisional Admission Letter (PAL).
 2. Undertaking by the candidate (if applicable).
 3. Photo ID proof
 4. Admit Card of JEE (Main)-2026 (For Engg./Arch. candidates)
 5. Score Card of JEE (Main)-2026 issued by NTA (downloaded score card is acceptable) (For Engg./Arch. Candidates).
 6. Class X (High School) Board Certificate as proof of date of birth.
 7. Certificate and Marks sheet of qualifying examination
 8. Proof of fee paid
 9. Certificate of category / subcategory / caste /sub-caste/PRC as applicable, issued by the competent authority [Annexure -I for **Non-Creamy Layer OBC** (OBC-NCL) and Annexure II for SC/ST]
 10. Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), if applicable (**Annexure– III**). The certificate should be issued from a duly constituted Medical Board. The certificate should stand valid up to **31.12.2026**. *Certificate not issued by a medical board &/or getting expired before 31.12.2026 shall not be accepted.*
 11. Proof of place of examination center in case of final qualifying examination is from the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) formerly known as National Open School (NOS).
 12. One passport size photograph identical to the one pasted on the JEE (Main) 2026 application form.
 13. Permanent Resident Certificate/Domicile (Required for NERIST)
 14. Medical Certificate (Annexure–IV)
 15. Any other documents as desired by the admitted Institute.

7. SPOT ROUNDS

- i. The allotment in spot round will be done by respective DTEs/NERIST as per their approved business rules, available in the Brochure at CSAB Portal under CSAB NEUT section. The conversions (de-reservation) of seats from one category to another (if permitted in the Business Rules) will be done as per the prescribed norms during the Spot round only (if seats remain vacant after 2nd round). Candidates are advised to get in touch with respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST for dates of spot round.
- ii. The spot round is an offline process and no online registration is required by the candidates. They have to report to the DTE/RC as per the schedule to be notified by respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST along with all necessary documents (original and self-attested photocopy) mentioned in the Brochure and as asked by DTE.
- iii. All eligible candidates, whether they registered or not (i.e. new candidates) for CSAB NEUT 1st round, whether any seat allotted or not from 1st/2nd Round, whether reported online or not, can participate in the spot round (although it is not mandatory for students who have been allotted a seat in round 1 or 2 to participate in spot round). However, those candidates who have a confirmed seat allotment under CSAB NEUT 2026, with admission letter issued by respective DTEs of States/UTs/NERIST from 1st/2nd Rounds, cannot participate in Spot Round unless they Withdraw their currently allotted seat. (Withdrawal must be done in the dedicated time frame as mentioned in the Table 1) through the CSAB Portal under NEUT section). Once the currently allotted seat is withdrawn / surrendered, the claim of the candidate on the withdrawn seat will be lost, irrespective of whether a seat is subsequently allotted in the Spot round or not.

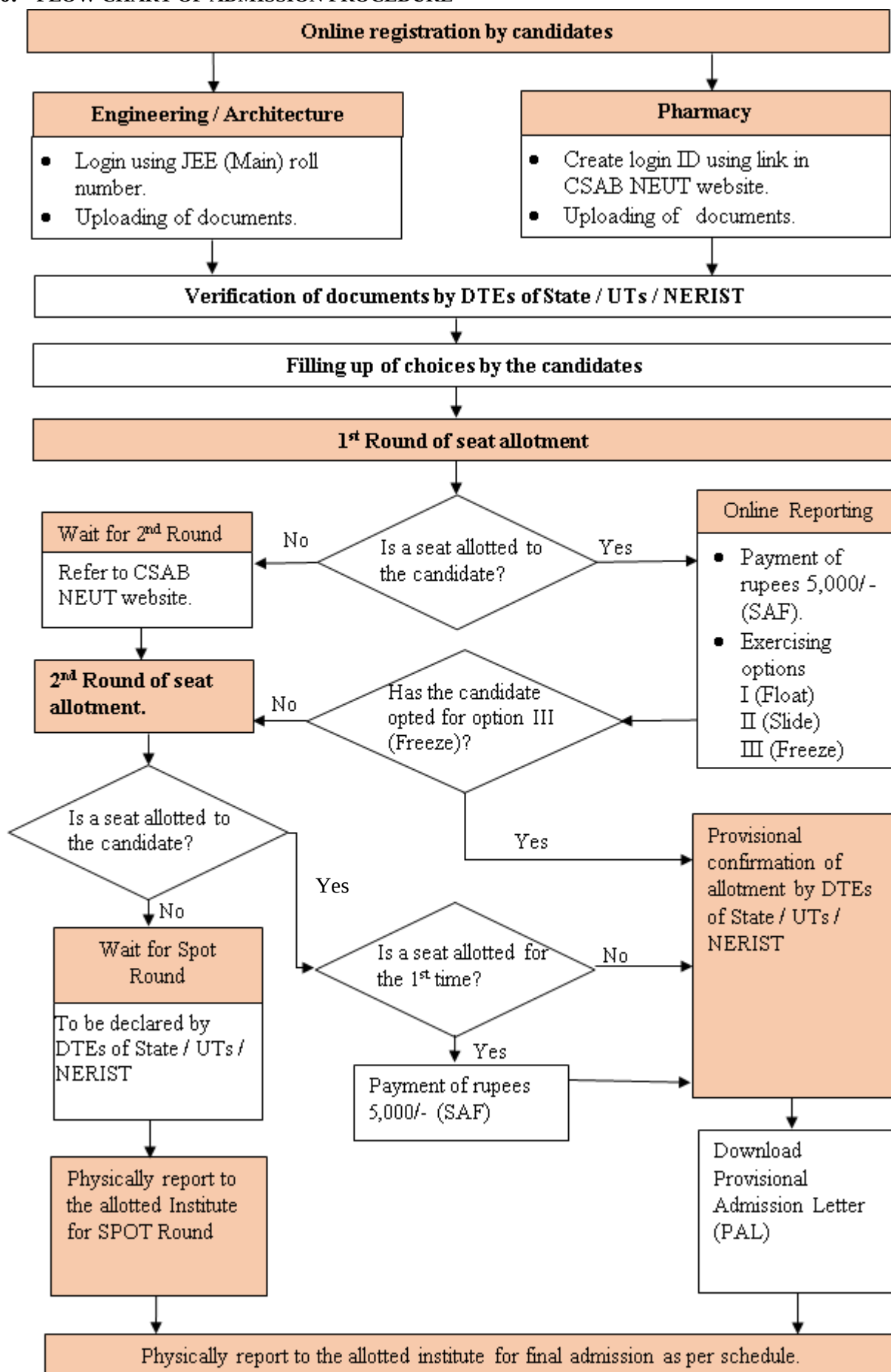

 - c) If there are no candidates in category 2 PWD then seat will go to category 3 PWD.
 - d) If there are no candidates in category 3 PWD, then seat will go to UR.

12.13.5 Other instructions

- (i) State domicile declaration to be obtained while registration
- (ii) Status of PWD candidate is to be captured at the time of registration
- (iii) Gender to be captured during registration since there are some exclusive girl's colleges/seats

As per state rule

Category-1: Schedule Tribe candidates of Lakshadweep

Category-2: Native of Lakshadweep, not Scheduled Tribe (ST), but father or mother ST, passed Board Examination from an Institution in Islands or from the Institution where his/her parent posted.

12.14.1 Reservation of seats for admission

Reservation of seats (see Annexure-I: Reservation of seats with its description) is put under four different categories. A candidate seeking / claiming admission against a seat under any of the categories shall have to produce relevant certificate(s) at the time of counselling

/ admission. The categories are as under:

- (i) State-quota: For candidates who belong to any of the 8(Eight) North Eastern States as per the reservation policy of the respective State Government;
- (ii) All India-quota: For candidates who belong to any of the States of India; and
- (iii) PD-quota: For candidates with 40 to 75% Physical loco-motor Disability (PD) belonging to any of the NE of India.
- (iv) EWS quota: For candidates who belong to EWS category of any State of India, 10% of total seats are reserved as per GoI rules.

The distribution of seats is made as under:

Out of the total number of seats for direct admissions,

- 80% of seats are reserved for candidates of the 8(Eight) North Eastern States (10% for each State) as State-quota.
 - 7% of the total seats are filled up with Permanent Residence Certificate (PRC) holders of these 8 (Eight) North Eastern States on Merit basis.
 - 3% of the total seats are reserved for Physical Locomotor Disabled (PD) persons under PD-quota. In case of non-availability of PD candidate, the seat will be filled up from PRC holders on merit basis.
 - 10% of the total seats are filled up with candidates under All India-quota.
 - Over & above ,10% of total seats are reserved for EWS category as per GoI rules.
- Reservation of Seats with its description (Annexure-I): Admissions in B. Tech courses are on the basis of total seats allotted to the four different categories. So, an applicant must choose an appropriate reservation category based upon his/her eligibility amongst the description of reservation of seats.
- Reservation of seats under All India is open to all applicants (Indian Nationals), if they desire so, for a seat under such categories.

Important Note: Any deviation in documentary proof for the reservation category mentioned / chosen by an Applicant in his/her Application shall lead to summarily rejection of his/her candidature. Proof of eligibility against a reservation category, other than All India General category candidates, must be produced at the time of counseling/admission.

1. The state of Nagaland provides 15% reservation of the total no of seats in each level of entrance examination to tribes mentioned in Table II based on the entrance Merit. Also 5% reservation to the People with Disabilities (PWD) for candidates mentioned in Table I & Table II.

2. The 5% PwD Candidates is drawn from both 85% reservation & 15 % reservation respectively ie there are two types of PwD candidates, one for the tribe mentioned in Table I and the other for the Tribes mentioned in Table II.

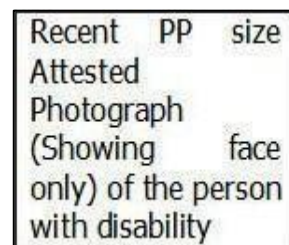

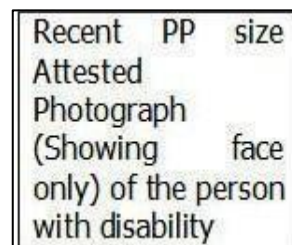

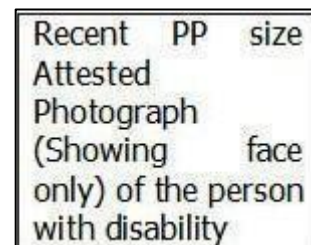
