

CG-TEAMS developed by NIC inaugurated by Hon'ble CM of Chhattisgarh

Hon'ble Chief Minister of Chhattisgarh, Shri. Bhupesh Baghel on 26.06.2019 launched ambitious Unified Digital System for School education under the name CG-TEAMS at Marra village of Patan. CG-TEAMS (Chhattisgarh Total Education Assessment & Management System) comply of 51 modules for Student, Teacher and Schools under Education Department of CG. Technical support to the project is being provided by NIC Chhattisgarh.

The Chief Minister has also launched the CG MMTB app developed by NIC. Through CG MMTB, students can access Multi Media Text book version of 9th and 10th class subjects. Multi Media textbook is a replica of class text book in multimedia format i.e with audio, animations and personalized assessments. In addition to software development, NIC is also helping the department in the creation of digital content. The digital content is being prepared in the state's six languages, including Hindi, Gondi, Halbi etc.

NIC has introduced gamification in taking assessments by designing 'Cricket As an Assessment Tool' (CaAT). State Informatics Officer, Mr. D.K.Debnath briefed the Hon'ble C.M how students can take assessment while playing cricket and enjoy studies. The project is lead by Mr. AK Somasekhar(STD) with Mr. Manish Kochar(PSA) and Ms. Lalita Verma(Scientist-B) as team members.
