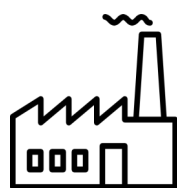

Issue of License to Contractors for **New License Registration** (Category – A & B). Extension for license is provided on expiration of the existing license through **Renewal of Contractor's License** (Category – A & B).

Revenue is collected in the form of **Inspection fee, Electricity duty (e-duty) and Energy Development cess; via. e-kosh** through e-challan.

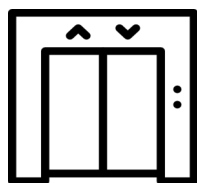

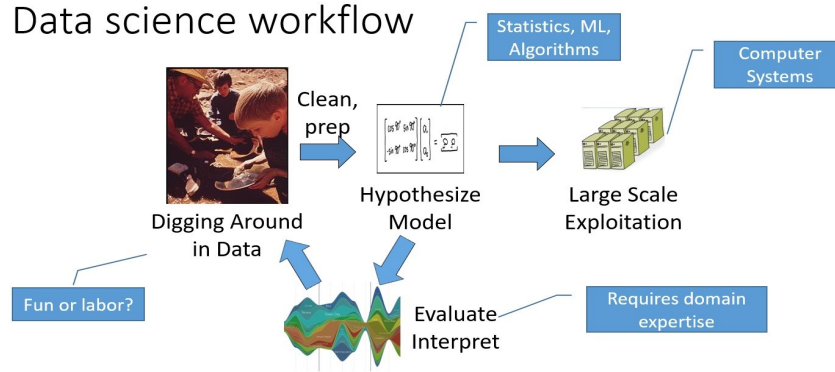

## Data Analytics for citizen friendly Governance –

Dr. Gagan Raj Gupta, Associate Professor, IIT-Bhilai had delivered a talk on 'Data Analytics for Citizen friendly Governance' on 21<sup>st</sup> Apr 2022 during the Two-day technical development program for DIOs. The summary of his talk shows how data can be the new oil to run Citizen friendly government. Data Analytics shall provide descriptive analysis of performance, often in visual form, to show how a government scheme or policy is working in the field or can give casual analysis to identify the variables that effect each other. One can do exploratory data analysis to find out new relationships between different variables, can do predictive data analysis to predict the future learning from past. Machine Learning (ML) models are the auto generated algorithms that ingest data and learn a model of that data to detect patterns / structures / themes / trends or make predictions about future data. ML doesn't require to predefine

or hard code all the rules, as programmers were doing from earlier. The rules will automatically be built in from data and also the rules are not static as the model can adapt with more and more data. Prominent components of ML include data, features and algorithms. Some of the ML applications

include Virtual personal assistance like Siri and Alexa, Fraud detection, prediction in finance, 'People You may Know' or 'Pages You may Like' in social media, Product recommendations, etc. ML with automated feature learning from the raw inputs is deep learning.

## Birth Registration from Orphanages and Registration Monitoring Mobile App Launched on Statistics Day 2022 in Rajasthan

On the occasion of 16th National Statistics Day state level celebration at Jaipur, Hon'ble Minister Statistics, Rajasthan, Shri Govind Ram Meghwal and Hon'ble Minister of State Statistics, Rajasthan, Shri Ashok Chandna launched two new services developed by NIC Rajasthan.

1. Facility of online Birth Registration of the Orphan child from all Orphanages of the state is launched. This will facilitate orphanages to timely register the orphan child for birth registration and download the digitally signed certificate from the Pehchan portal.

2. New feature in Pehchan Mobile App is launched which will enable all Registrars and

administrative users to use the Mobile App for monitoring purpose. The facility will be useful for 14,500+ Registrars and Sub Registrars, all District Registrars and all Block officers to monitor the Birth, Death and Marriage registrations through the App. Facilities includes Citizens, eMitra and Private hospitals applications details with their pendency, Registration status and approval of the updation requests. This will ease and speedup the registration process in the state.

Pehchan Mobile App is available on Google download the Birth, Death and Marriage Play store and Apple Store for citizen's registrations through the Mobile App. App services which includes apply, search and has about 5.5 lacs downloads.

## ICT Initiatives in the District

**1. District Web Site:** The Bastar district website is redesigned by implementing the S3WAAS platform. The official website of District Bastar (<https://bastar.gov.in>) is providing information such as profile of the district, key contacts of administration, circulars, recruitment notification, tourism places, news, events etc.

**2. Bastar Noni Nigrani App:** The objectives of Bastar Noni Nigrani app are-

- Active surveillance and monitoring of Quarantine people (family member of home isolated positive patients and people visited other city/state) violating quarantine protocol.
- To check multiple testing by Covid-19 positive patients by IDSP/Testing team
- Active surveillance and monitoring of Covid positive patients violating home isolation protocol

## Other Key Initiatives in the District

- The development and implementation of Time Limit Letters Monitoring System, Online Quarter allotment system and Guhaar app.
- Under iRAD (Integrated Road Accident Database) Project more than 250 official users (Police, Highway, Transport and Health) had been trained.
