of vehicles sold in the expo.

The implementation of Auto Expo flow has prevented exemption of Tax to ineligible vehicles and enabled speedy process of registration. It has been widely appreciated by the public, participating dealers and the administration alike.

eDetection system implemented

eDetection module developed by NIC Odisha has been customized for Chhattisgarh and implemented in the State since 03/05/2023. Vehicles passing through 22 Toll gates are scanned by cameras installed at Tolls. All the Registration Numbers of the scanned vehicles are uploaded by the Toll staff to the eDetection system where each Number is verified against details in VAHAN to detect offences viz. Invalid fitness certificate, invalid PUC Certificate, Pending Tax and invalid permit. With the help of linking with eChallan system Challans are generated against offending vehicles. The owners of the offending vehicle are intimated through SMS regarding Challan with payment link. This system helps catching vehicles moving around, without valid documents. Introductory demonstration and training has been provided to the Transport department staff and Toll gate employees by Shri P. K. Nayak, Sr. Director (IT), BNIC, Bhubaneshwar through Video conferencing.

Mission Vatsalya Monitoring System (MVMS)

Mission Vatsalya Monitoring System (MVMS) is a web-based Management Information System developed by the NIC Chhattisgarh State Centre Raipur. It serves as an efficient tool for monitoring and supervising the Mission Vatsalva scheme.

The primary objectives of Mission Vatsalya are: (a) Ensuring children's rights to survival, development, protection, and participation. (b) Establishing essential services, strengthening emergency outreach, noninstitutional care within families and communities, and providing institutional care, counseling, and support services at all levels. (c) Facilitating the restoration, rehabilitation, and mainstreaming of children in the state. (d) Ensuring selfsufficiency for children supported under

Mission Vatsalya after turning 18 years old and organizing appropriate assistance for them.

To monitor and promote the implementation of the scheme, a State Level Monitoring and Review Committee, led by the Chief Secretary, is in place. Additionally, the State Child Protection Society (SCPS) oversees the implementation and planning of the Mission Vatsalya scheme.

https://missionvatsalya.cg.gov.in, caters to all stakeholders of the scheme. It offers various features, including capturing child basic details, admissions, development plans, counseling, discharges, transfers, monitoring, and report generation. The system provides a using Google TOTP. customized user interface for different



stakeholders such as the state nodal officer, state child protection society, The MVMS, accessible at district child protection units, child welfare committees, juvenile justice boards, specialized adoption agencies, juvenile police units, and child care institutions. The MIS is dynamic, responsive, userfriendly, and secure, offering role-based access and multi-factor authentication

High Risk Pregnancy Monitoring System (HRPMS)

A high-risk pregnancy monitoring system is a medical solution developed for the department of Health & Family Welfare & Medical Education, Govt. of Chhattisgarh designed to closely monitor and manage pregnancies that are deemed high risk due to various factors.

The primary goal of a high-risk pregnancy monitoring system is to ensure the wellbeing of both the mother and the developing fetus by closely monitoring their health parameters and providing timely intervention if necessary.

A high-risk pregnancy is distinguished by any fetal or maternal condition that can adversely affect the successful outcome of the pregnancy or at increased risk of morbidity or mortality before, during, or after delivery. By identifying pregnancies that are high risk, extra attention is taken care of mothers who need the most medical care, close monitoring and sometimes referral to a perinatal centre.

In HRPMS, ANM collects details of eligible couple along with first ANC details. HRP cases are mapped of First Referral Unit for expected delivery health centre. ANM captures outcome entry, i.e. type of delivery, details of infants. After



outcome details, ANM collects PNC Details of pregnant woman minimum four times within 45 days after delivery. Line list is tracked by PHC, CHC, DH and state level health professionals for HRP Monitoring.

The system also generates sample slips and facilitates online forwarding of samples to seed testing laboratories, streamlining the certification process.

The benefits of SATHI are manifold. It enhances seed quality and purity, increases accountability through seed traceability, and improves the efficiency of Seed Certification Inspectors. The GIS-based MIS reports powered by Bharat Map Interface aid in data-driven decision-making and resource

optimization. Moreover, the system reduces transactional time, expediting the certification process and providing farmers with certified seeds promptly.
