Dear friends, I greet you all on this historic celebration of Swachhata Diwas.

On 15th August 2014, Hon'ble Prime Minister gave the momentous call for swachhata through jan bhaagidari. Thereafter, this Jan Andolan for cleanliness has become the world's largest movement of this kind.
