He remembered Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, who, with his tireless efforts, united all the 560 independent states into the present Bharat. While mentioning Article 1 of the constitution, he said India, that is Bharat, has to be understood, appreciated, and celebrated with the spirit of **Ek Bharat Shreshta Bharat**. We have to regain the sense of familyhood. He further mentioned how people from different parts of India, such as Saurashtra, Bundelkhand, and Kashi, are living in Tamil Nadu. They have embraced the great Tamil culture and have further enriched it. He illustrated how initiatives such as Saurashtra Tamil Sangamam are revitalizing our age-old connect and strengthening unity.

During the function, the artists captivated the audiences with Gujarati folk dance and song performances. Governor, at the function, felicitated the eminent personalities of various Gujarat associations in Tamil Nadu for their service to society. He also felicitated the artists.
