OVER THE THIRUVALLUVAR THIRUNAAL VIZHA (VAIKASI ANUSHAM VALLUVAR THIRUNAAL) AT RAJ BHAVAN, CHENNAI, TODAY (24.05.2024)

Thiruvalluvar Thirunal was celebrated today, 24thMay, 2024 (on the Vaikasi Anusham) in a traditional manner at the Raj Bhavan, Chennai carrying forward the legacy of Great - Tamil Scholars Maraimalai Adigalar, T.P.Meenakshisundaram and Thiru.Vi.Kalyanasundaram. He mentioned how our Prime Minister admires Thiruvalluvar and Thirukkural. He often quoting Kurals in his addresses. He would be taking steps to make it a world book. Let us continue to celebrate it as our proud heritage and celebrate it in a traditional manner. As per our thousands years old tradition, the auspicious Vaikasi Anusham is the day to Thiruvalluvar Day.

His Holiness Swami Mahendra, Sri Adhi Sankarar Thirumadam, (Kualalumpur, Malaysia) in his bestowed address applauded Thirukkural for showing flood lights on importance of self discipline, superior than one's live. It helps me a lot in carrying out the Adhi Sankarar's ideologies across Malaysia. Thirukkural highlights hospitality as revealed in our Vedas and Upanishads. Thiruvalluvar advised to feel sense of divine within their own for goodness.
