Following the deeply distressing incident of sexual assault reported within the campus of the Anna University, Chennai, Hon'ble Governor-Chancellor visited the University today (28.12.2024) at 12.30 P.M to review the security measures, interact with the students and to ensure that immediate and decisive action is taken to safeguard our students.

During the visit, Hon'ble Governor-Chancellor met the Registrar and other senior faculty members, interacted with them and reviewed the security measures within the University campus. He interacted with the students (girls and boys separately) and patiently listened to their perspectives, recommendations and suggestions in order to make the campus a more safe and secure place.

Hon'ble Governor has stated that the safety and well-being of our students are non-negotiable and has instructed the University administration to take immediate action on the safety and security issues raised by the students.

Hon'ble Governor has also advised the students and their parents not to panic and has directed the University administration to ensure a culture of safety and accountability.
