Under the 'Social Service' category (Institution), 'Idhayangal of Coimbatore District' and 'Hope Public Charitable Trust of Chennai

**District'** will receive a cash prize of Rs. 5 lakhs and a citation. 'Idhayangal' is serving poor children who are in need of diabetic care. Hope Public Charitable Trust is working towards providing special education, vocational training and rehabilitation services for children existing with Autism and intellectual disability.

Under the 'Social Service' category (Individuals), the awardees are Thiru. S.Ramalingam of Chennai District, Tmt. Swarnalatha J of Coimbatore District and Thiru. A.Rajkumar, of Madurai District. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 2 lakhs each and a citation. Thiru. S.Ramalingam has dedicated himself for the past three decades to serving and assisting differently abled children. Tmt. Swarnalatha J, was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis in 2009, she works to support accessibility and rehabilitation of differently abled people. Thiru. A.Rajkumar is rendering service to the elderly people, destitute individuals and those with mental health issues by arranging shelter, food and medical aid for them.

Under the 'Environmental Protection' category (Institution), 'Chitlapakkam Rising Charitable Trust', Chennai District the winner of the award, which carries a cash prize of ₹5 lakhs and a citation. Chitlapakkam Rising is a volunteer organization. This organization is making outstanding contributions for spreading awareness on environmental degradation and volunteering to rejuvenate water bodies, improving green cover and waste management.

The awardees will receive their awards from the Hon'ble Governor of Tamil Nadu during 'AT HOME' Reception on Republic Day on 26.01.2025 at Raj Bhavan, Chennai.
