

Raj Bhavan, Tamil Nadu announces a Competition on “Experience sharing of Kashi Tamil Sangamam 3.0 – 2025” for the Delegates participating from Tamil Nadu

Kashi Tamil Sangamam is an initiative of the Hon’ble Prime Minister of India to rediscover, and strengthen the centuries old cultural connect between the two ancient knowledge centres of the Country, Kashi and Tamil Nadu. Finding the enthusiasm and overwhelming response in the last two editions in both Tamil Nadu and Kashi, the programme has been scheduled this year, in Varanasi (Kashi), from 15th February 2025 to 24th February 2025. Around 1000 delegates from Tamil Nadu in various categories (Students, Teachers, Writers, Farmers, Artisans, Entrepreneurs, Women, Researchers, Professionals, Innovation / Startups etc.) and a batch of 200 students of Tamil origin studying in various Central Universities will be visiting Kashi and other places of interest.

Cultural performances and exhibition celebrating the art, crafts, handlooms, handicrafts, cuisines etc. of Tamil Nadu and Kashi will also be organised during the Sangamam for an immersive experience. This years’ edition is coinciding with another important event namely the celebration of Maha Kumbh at Sangam, Prayagraj. The Main theme in this year’s event is highlighting the significant contributions of Sage Agasthyar to the Siddha System of Medicine (Bharatiya Chikitsa) and his contributions in the field of Classical Tamil literature, Grammar etc. thereby creating a link between the two cultures.

On this occasion, Raj Bhavan, Tamil Nadu announces a competition on **“EXPERIENCE SHARING OF KASHI TAMIL SANGAMAM 3.0 - 2025”** for the delegates attending Kashi Tamil Sangamam’ 3.0 - 2025 from Tamil Nadu.

The “Experience Sharing” competition should be written either in Tamil or in English language; the write up should be only in hand written format (only A4 sheets) with a minimum of 1000 words.

The “Experience Sharing” competition is restricted to the delegates of Kashi Tamil Sangamam 3.0 - 2025 from Tamil Nadu only. The participants should send the “Hard Copy’ to the following postal address:

The write-up on “Experience Sharing” must reach the above postal address on or before 14th March, 2025. Participants should clearly mention their Name, Residential Address, Batch number, Category of their group in Kashi -Tamil Sangamam 3.0 - 2025, with their contact numbers, while sending their write-up. Photos/Videos may also be enclosed along with the write-up, the submission of photo/video is optional.

For each category (Students, Teachers, Writers, Farmers, Artisans, Entrepreneurs, Women, Researchers, Professionals, Innovation / Startups etc.) three best entries in Tamil and in English, will be selected by an independent Committee of experts and will be felicitated by the Hon’ble Governor. Winners from each category will be awarded Cash Prizes (First Prize – Rupees Ten Thousand, Second Prize – Rupees Seven Thousand, and Third Prize – Rupees Five Thousand) and Certificates in a function to be held at Raj Bhavan, Chennai.
