रक्षा मंत्रालय द्वारा जारी किए गए सांविधिक नियम और आदेश Statutory Rules and Orders issued by the Ministry of Defence

का.नि.आ. 29.—केन्द्रीय सरकार, संविधान के अनुच्छेद 309 के परन्तुक द्वारा प्रदत्त शिवतयों का प्रयोग करते हुए और सैनिक भूमि और छावनी, सहायक सैनिक संपदा अधिकारी सेवा समूह 'ख' भर्ती नियम, 1983 को, उन बातों के सिवाय अधिकांत करते हुए, जिन्हें ऐसे अधिक्रमण से पूर्व किया गया है, या करने से लोप किया गया है, रक्षा मंत्रालय रक्षा संपदा संगठन में सहायक रक्षा संपदा अधिकारियों के पदों पर भर्ती की पद्धति का विनियमन करने के लिए निम्नलिखित नियम बनाते हैं, अर्थात:—

- ा. संक्षिप्त नाम और प्रारंभ.—(1) इन नियमों का संक्षिप्त नाम सहायक रक्षा संपदा अधिकारी, समूह 'ख' भर्ती नियम 2007 है।
 - (2) ये राजपन में प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।
- 2. **पद-संख्या, वर्गीकरण और वेतनमान.**—उवत पदों की संख्या, उनका वर्गीकरण और उनके वेतनमान वे होंगे, जो इन नियमों से उपाबद्ध अनुसूची के स्तंभ (2) से स्तंभ (4) में विनिर्दिष्ट हैं।
- 3. भर्ती की पद्धति, आयु-सीमा, अर्हताएं आदि. उक्त पदों पर भर्ती की पद्धति, आयु-सीमा, अर्हताएं और उनसे संबंधित अन्य बातें वे होंगी जो उक्त अनुसूची के स्तम्भ (5) से स्तम्भ (14) में विनिर्दिष्ट हैं।
 - 4. भारत के किसी भाग में सेवा के लिए दायित्व और सेवा की अन्य शतें :-
 - (1) सेवा में नियुक्त किए गए अधिकारी भारत में या भारत से बाहर कहीं भी सेवा करने के लिए दायी होंगे।
 - (2) अधिकारी, यदि प्रतिनियुक्त किया जाए तो सरकार के किसी अन्य मंत्रालय या विभाग या सरकार के निगमों और औद्योगिक उपक्रमों में सेवा करने के लिए दायी होंगे।
 - (3) ऐसे विषयों की बाबत, जिनके संबंध में कोई उपबंध इन नियमों में नहीं किया गया है, सेवा के सदस्यों की सेवा की शर्तें वहीं होंगी जो साधारणतया केन्द्रीय सिविल सेवा के अधिकारियों को समय-समय पर लागू होती हैं।

- S.R.O. 29.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Military Lands and Cantonments, Assistant Military Estates Officers Service, Group 'B', Recruitment Rules, 1983 except as respects or things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Defence Estates Officers in the Ministry of Defence, Defence Estates Organisation, namely:—
- 1. Short title and commencement,—(1) These rules may be called the Assistant Defence Estates Officers, Group 'B', Recruitment Rules, 2007.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of post, classification and scale of pay.—The number of post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment to said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said schedule.
 - 4. Liability for service in any part of India and other conditions of Service.-
 - (1) Officers appointed to the service shall be liable to serve anywhere in India or abroad.
 - (2) Officers, if deputed, shall be liable to serve in any other Ministry of Department or the Government or Corporations and Industrial Undertakings of the Government.
 - (3) The conditions of service of the members of the Service in respect of matters of which no provision is made in the rules shall be the same as are applicable from time to time, to officers of Central Civil Services, in general.
 - 5. Disqualification.—No person,—
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-servicemen and the special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/or absorption and percentage of posts to be filled by various methods

In case of recruitment by promotion or deputation or absorption grades from which promotion or deputation or absorption to be

- (i) 75 per cent Promotion failing which by deputation failing both by direct recruitment.
- (ii) 25 Per cent direct recruitment.

Promotion:

- (a) Sub Divisional Officer Grade-I of the Defence Estates Organization in the pay scale of Rs. 5500-175-9000 with three years regular service in the grade failing which Sub-Divisional Officer Grade-I of Defence Estates Organization in the pay scale of Rs. 5500-9000 with combined regular service of six years as Sub Divisional Officer Grade-I and Sub Divisional Officer Grade-II in the Pay Scale of Rs. 5000-150-8000 and possessing minimum two years regular service as Sub Divisional Officer Grade-1; and
- (b) Possessing Diploma in Civil Engineering from a recognized University or institution or equivalent.

Note 1:-Officers holding the post of Sub Divisional Officer Grade-I (Rs. 5500-9000) on the date of Notification of these rules and possessing either Diploma in Draughtsmanship or Civil Engineering shall be eligible for promotion. Officers who will be appointed to the post of Sub Divisional Officer Grade-I after Notification of these rules shall have to possess educational qualification as stated above to be eligible for promotion.

Note 2:- Where Juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their

probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

DEPUTATION:-

Officers under the Central Government:-

- (a) (i) Holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or
- (ii) With three years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the scale of pay of Rs. 5500—9000 or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and
- (b) Possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits under column 8.

Note: The departmental-officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of the receipt of applications.
