AMENDMENT TO GENERAL FINANCIAL RULES, 1963

ANNEXURE TO CHAPTER 8 RULE 102(1)

Substitute the existing para 29 of this Annexure by the following:-

"29- For purchase of value of Rs. 2 lakhs and above, but less than Rs. 5 lakhs
Tender enquiries may be issued in the form of classified advertisements
in the local newspapers. For purchases of value of Rs. 5 lakhs and above,
Open Tenders may be advertised in national dailies in addition to the
Indian Trade Journal. The Indian Trade Journal published by the
Director-General of Commercial Intelligence and Statistics, Kolkata
which is a Government publication should be regarded as the standard
medium for public advertisements in India. As a method of improving egovernance and bringing greater transparency in Administration,
Departments of Central Government Organisations having a website
may use this as an additional medium for publication of the tender
enquiries apart from the newspapers/Indian Trade Journal.
