I am directed to say that consequent upon the acceptance of the recommendations of the Fourth Central Pay Commission by the Govt. vide its resolution No. 9-E dated 18th Mar, 1987 in so far as it relates to the rental ceilings for hirings of accommodation for service personnel of the three Services and after further consideration of the issue by the Govt. , the President is pleased to sanction the following rates of rental ceilings for fresh/future hirings of accommodation for service personnel:-

- 2. These rates shall be applicable with immediate effect.
- 3. Existing orders and instructions regarding plinth area entitlements for different ranks and hiring of accommodation will continue to be applicable.
- 4. Rental ceilings for hiring of accommodation for separated families of service officers will be of one class below of their class of entitlement.

5.	The above rental ceilings Should not result in the ceilings being applied in all cases as a
