Subject: DISPOSAL OF TREES ON LANDS IN THE ACTIVE OCCUPATION
OF THE DEFENCE SERVICES & MILITARY FARMS

Sir,

1. I am directed to say that in keeping with the quasi-commercial status of Military Farms, the responsibility for disposal of trees on land on charges of Military Farms will rest with respective Military Farms.
2. Trees grown on the land of Military Farms shall remain the property of Government and will be disposed off, when dried or otherwise required to be felled by the Military Farms authorities preferably through State Forest Corporation failing which by public auction to the best advantage of the State.
3. Revenue accruing from the disposal of the produce of trees will be credited as receipt of Military Farms in the consolidated fund of Government of India.
4. This issues with the concurrence of Ministry of Finance(Def) vide WD No.1736/DA/2000 dated 28 Dec 2000.
