Subject: - RECOVERY OF AMOUNTS FROM CYCLE STAND CONTRACTORS


Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President that amounts received from contractor as consideration for the licence to run a cycle stand/shed on Government premises may be credited to Regimental Funds. A nominal licence fee of Rs. 1.50 p.m. will also be recovered from the contractor for the use of Government premises and credited to Major Head LXII - Sub-Major Head I - Army Sub Head D - other Miscellaneous Receipts.

2. The contractor will, however, be responsible for the running/maintenance of cycle stand/shed to the satisfaction of the Government at his own expense.
