Subject: Promotion of Private Secretary (PS) Group-B (Gazetted) the post of Senior Private Secretary (SPS) Group-B (Gazetted) in the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 9300-34800 with grade Pay of Rs. 4800 (now Level-8 of the pay matrix as per 7th CPC).

The meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) was held to consider the promotion of eligible Private Secretary (PS) of Defence Estates Organization to the post of Senior Private Secretary (SPS) in the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 9300-34800 with Grade Pay of Rs. 4800/- (Level-8 of the revised pay matrix as per 7th CPC) for the vacancy years 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022. Considering the above facts, the above named Private Secretary (PS) are granted promotion to the post of Senior Private Secretary (SPS) Group-B (Gazetted) in the prerevised pay scale of Rs. 9300-34800 with Grade Pay of Rs. 4800/- (Level-8 of the revised pay matrix as per 7th CPC), in order of seniority given year-wise panels, with effect from the date of assumption of duties in the promoted grade.

- 5. The above named officials shall submit their acceptance / refusal of promotion to this Directorate General within 07 days of receipt of this order. In case, no intimation is received within the prescribed time limit it will amount to be deemed refusal by the official concerned, and promotion orders will be cancelled forthwith. If any of the above named officials refuse their promotion as SPS, he /she will be debarred from promotion for one year and will not be entitled for financial upgradation under MACP Scheme 2009 as per extant rules. This may please be brought to the notice of the concerned officials. Further, it may be ensured that the communication regarding acceptance/ refusal of promotion must reach this Directorate General within 07 days of issuance of this order on the official website of DG DE.
- 6. <u>The Directorates/concerned offices are also advised to ascertain that the concerned official is clear from vigilance angle before placing them in the promotional post of SPS.</u>
