State leads in providing judicial infrastructure, says Hooda

Haryana chief minister Bhupinder Singh Hooda on Sunday said that the state was leading in terms of providing modern judicial infrastructure. "It is the only state that has taken initiative to implement all kinds of judicial reforms," Hooda said while addressing members of the District Bar Association in Bhiwani on Sunday. The country's first traffic court was started in Meerut, the chief minister said, adding that evening courts had also been established in Patiala, Gurgaon, Hisar and Karnal. Apart from this, the state government has recorded approval for setting up of 90 evening courts. "They are constructed in place in the state's benches equipped with the facility of video conferencing. Moreover, Hooda laid the foundation stone of District Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) Centre at Bhiwani at a cost of Rs 14 crore. Such centre would be set up in 14 districts of the state.

LAYING OF FOUNDATION STONE OF HARYANA'S SIXTH DISTRICT ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION (ADR) CENTER AT BHIWANI ON 27.5.2012

Sh. Bhupinder Singh Hooda, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Haryana, alongwith Hon'ble Mr. Justice S.K.Mittal, Judge, Punjab and Haryana High Court and Executive Chairman, HALSA, laid the Foundation Stone of sixth District Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) Centre at Judicial Courts Complex, Bhiwani on 27.5.2012 in the gracious presence of Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.M.S. Bedi, Administrative Judge, Sessions Division, Bhiwani and Hon'ble Mr. Justice N.K. Sanghi Judge, Punjab and Haryana High Court. Sh. Deepak Gupta, Member Secretary, Haryana State Legal Services Authority; Sh. A.S. Narang, ADJ/District and Sessions Judge (Officiating)-cum-Chairman, District Legal Services Authority, Bhiwani; Judicial Officers, Sh. Ashok Kumar Meena, Deputy Commissioner, Bhiwani, Sh. B.Satish Balan, Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani and Bar Members of District Bhiwani were also present on this occasion.

While addressing the gathering, Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mittal told that Haryana State Legal Services Authority will establish District Alternative Disputes Resolution Centers in all the Judicial Districts of the State by the funds provided by 13th Finance Commission. He told that these centers shall be headed by the Judicial Officers of the level of Chief Judicial Magistrate. He also told about the various activities being carried out by the HALSA under the aegis of NALSA. He told that Permanent Lok Adalat for Public Utility Services will be established in all the districts very shortly. He told that the core objective of this Permanent Lok Adalat is to ensure expeditious and effective remedy at pre-litigative stage to the people

regarding disputes relating to Public Utility Services such as Transportation, Telecom, Postal, Telegraph, Public Cleanliness, Hospitals, Banking, Finance, Insurance, Electricity, Water Supply, Housing and Estate Department from both Public and Private Sector. He also told that disputes

relating to the Public Utility Services would be settled on the basis of conciliation and that pecuniary limit of PLA (PUS) is Rs. 25 lacs. Not only that, the order passed by Lok Adalat would be executable like a decree passed by the Civil Court, and no appeal would lie against the orders, as it will attain finality immediately with its pronouncement.

Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.M.S. Bedi enlightened the gathering by expressing his esteemed views. He also told at length about the importance and necessity of ADR Centers.

About 125 people including Panel Advocates, Anganwari Workers, Sarpanches and Panches, Principals and Para Legal Volunteers attended the said camp. Rajender Singh Dhanda, Chief Judicial Magistrate-cum-Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Kurukshetra, Panel Advocates, Programme Officer and Protection Officer, Kurukshetra addressed the gathering on topics of Legal Literacy and Legal Awareness qua the rights and duties and about their role at Grass Root Level. The electronic and Print Media also covered the said Legal Literacy Camp story and press release was issued by the DPRO, Kurukshetra on the said camp.



LITERACY CAMP ORGANISED ON 31.05.2012 ON WORLD ANTI TOBACCO DAY & JAL ADHIKAR ABHIYAN

Special Legal Literacy Camps were organized by various District Legal Services Authorities and Sub-Divisional Legal Services Committees on the occasion of World Anti Tobacco Day. Jal Adhikar Abhiyan was also organised to create awareness in the masses for proper use of water on 31.05.2012. The people were apprised not only about their legal rights but also the bad effects of the tobacco and its product by organising the programmes at public places mainly near taxi-stand, labour areas etc. where the use of tobacco in the community is expected to be the most.

People were asked to refrain not only from the direct use of tobacco but also from its indirect consumption as even the passive consumers are also vulnerable to its bad



effects, which can lead to many diseases like cancer of tongue, throat, lung cancer, TB and even heart attack, which are not only serious in nature but fatal too. They were asked to take oath for not only to refrain themselves from consuming tobacco products but also for making the other's present in their vicinity, aware about the dire effects of the tobacco by not allowing them to consume the same.

Knowledge was imparted in District Kaithal by the District Legal Services Authority regarding the bad effects of the tobacco consumption in children by organising the camps in schools with the active participation of the Chairman of School Administration Council.

District Legal Services Authority, Yamunanagar organised Legal Literacy Camp at Labour Colony, Yamunanagar and gave suggestions as to how the society and its people can be protected by avoiding the use of tobacco.

As a special endeavour, District Legal Services Authority, Faridabad organised literacy camp against the use of tobacco in collaboration with Health Department of the State of Haryana, which was attended by Anganwari Workers, Law Students, Senior Citizens, Doctors and other Administrative Officers apart from panel advocates and para legal volunteers.

Besides, in the Jal Adhikar Abhiyan, people were asked to conserve water which is must for the well being of everybody and to make endeavour to save every valuable drop of it, by keeping in mind not only the present requirement of water but also the necessity of forthcoming generation. In this programme, skits were performed for conservation of water and for discouraging the use of tobacco followed by detailed information regarding

various schemes of National Legal Services Authority and Haryana State Legal Services Authority.

In District Narnaul, various camps were held at grass-root level in villages namely Faizabad, Nizampur, Gahli and Hudina in which members of different youth clubs and Mahila Mandal participated in propagating the bad effects of tobacco in general public. Similarly, camps were also organised in Sirsa, Bilaspur (Yamunanagar), Kurukshetra and various villages of Jind.

They were told that if any person, employ any child below the age of 14 years in Factory, Shop, Dhaba or any other place, then owner can be punished with one year sentence and fine of Rs.20,000/-.
