# **SOME RECENT JUDGMENTS OF THE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA**

## **THE POWER TO AUTHORISE DETENTION IS A VERY SOLEMN FUNCTION**

In **ARNESH KUMAR VERSUS STATE OF BIHAR & ANR.** (CRIMINAL APPEAL NO. 1277 OF 2014 (@SPECIAL LEAVE PETITION (CRL.) No.9127 of 2013) decided on July 2, 2014, the Hon'ble Supreme Court, inter-alia, held as follows:

Before arrest, the police officers should have reason to believe on the basis of information and material that the accused has committed the offence.

The power to authorise detention is a very solemn function. It affects the liberty and freedom of citizens and needs to be exercised with great care and caution.

Before a Magistrate authorises detention under Section 167, Cr.PC, he has to be first satisfied that the arrest made is legal and in accordance with law.

The Magistrate while authorising detention of the accused shall peruse the report furnished by the police officer and only after recording its satisfaction, the Magistrate will authorise detention.

## **RELIGION CANNOT BE ALLOWED TO BE MERCELESS TO THE VICTIM**

In **VISHWA LOCHAN MADAN VERSUS UNION OF INDIA & ORS.** (WRIT PETITION (CIVIL) NO. 386 OF 2005) decided on July 7, 2014, the Hon'ble Supreme Court, inter-alia, observed as follows:

A Fatwa is an opinion, only an expert is expected to give.

It is not a decree, not binding on the court or the State or the individual.

Religion cannot be allowed to be merciless to the victim. Faith cannot be used as dehumanising force.

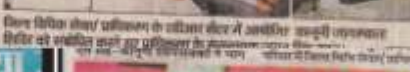
