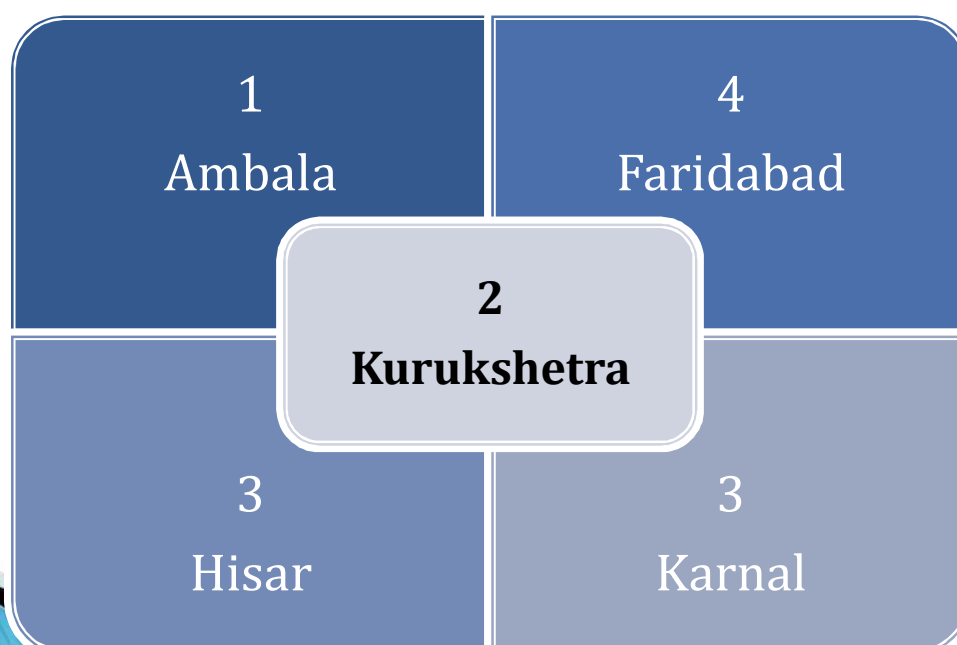


# Court Based Activities

## Filing of Appeals

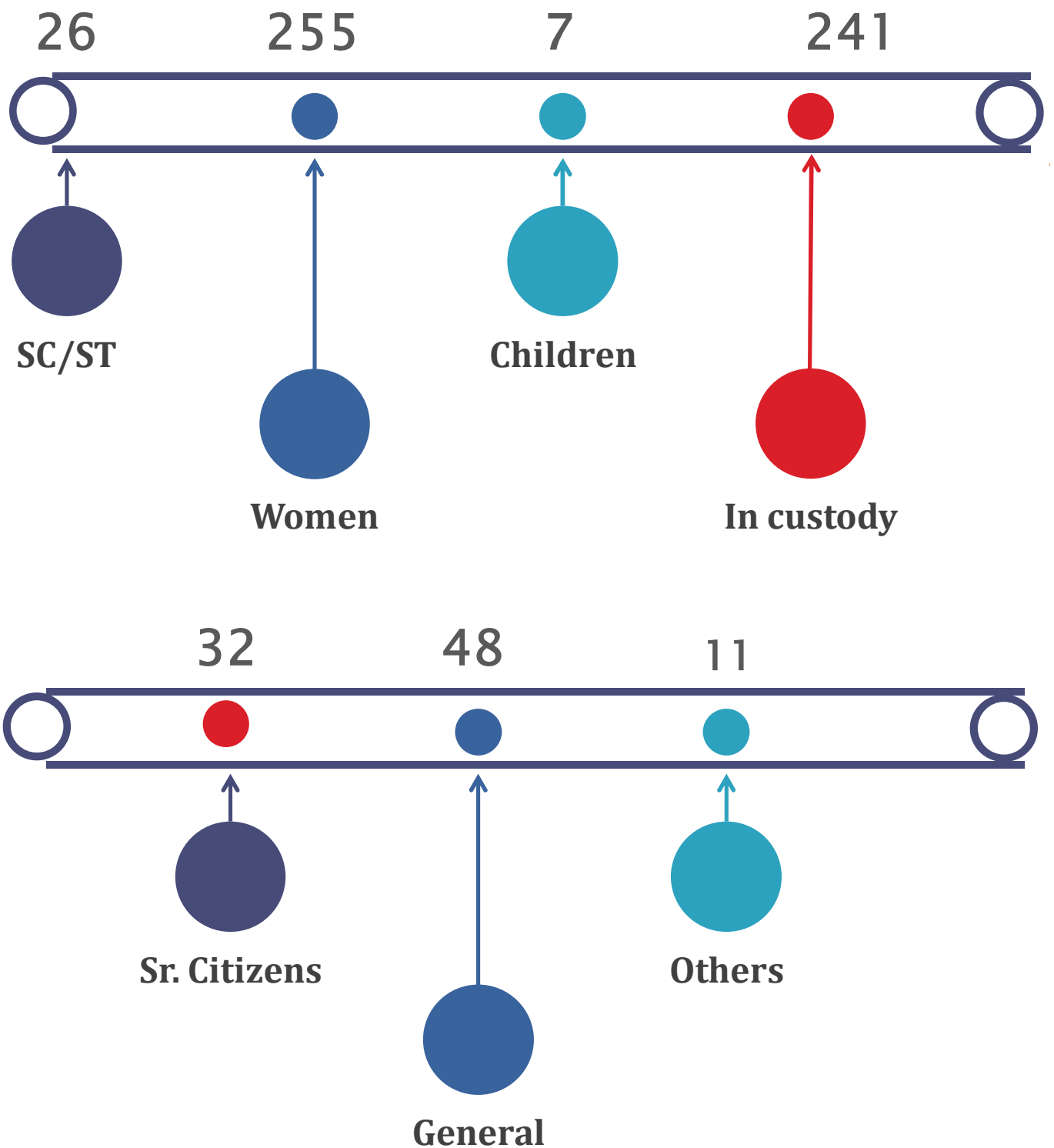

Secretaries were also requested to follow up with the concerned appointed advocates for the latest status of the case and the same be communicated to the concerned person seeking legal aid.

**Since negligible number of cases have been decided in the month of October, 2020 due to Covid-19 pandemic the total Number of appeals filed is 13**



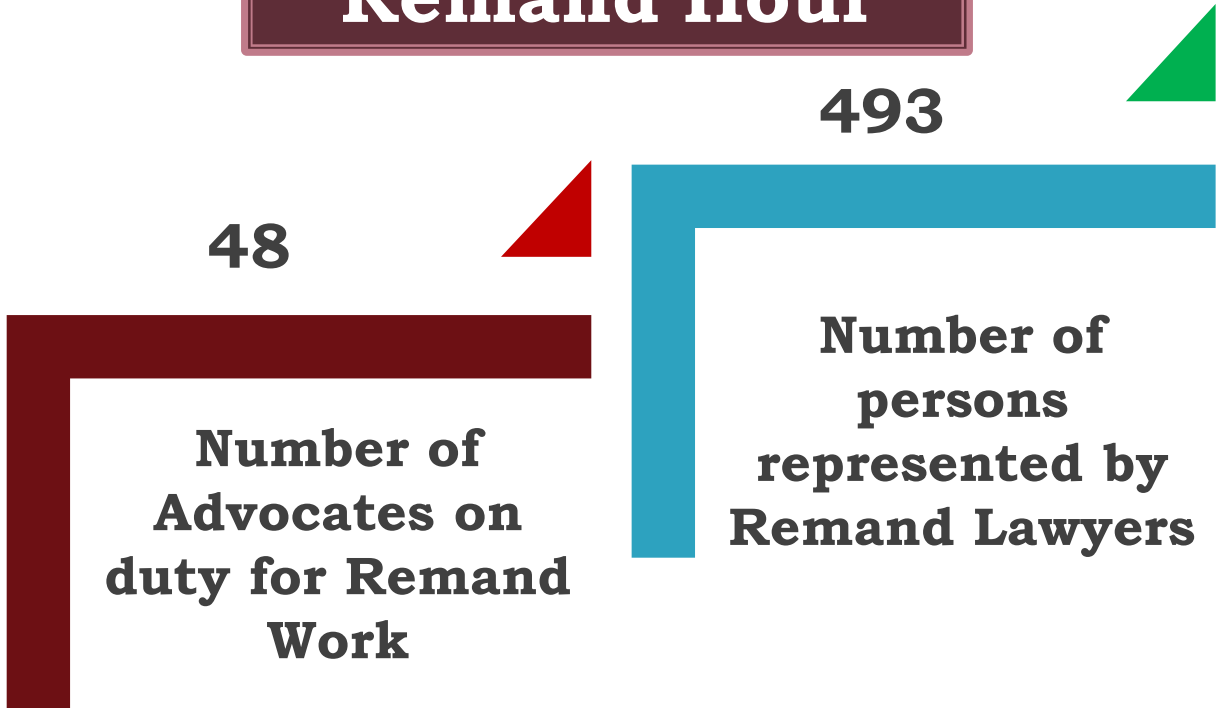


# Legal Aid & Advice

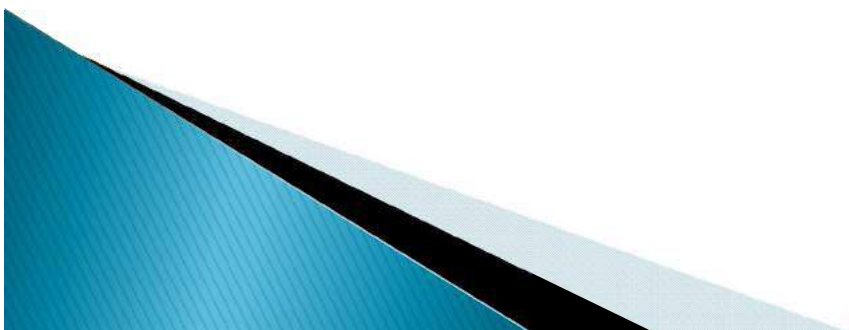
# TRAINING

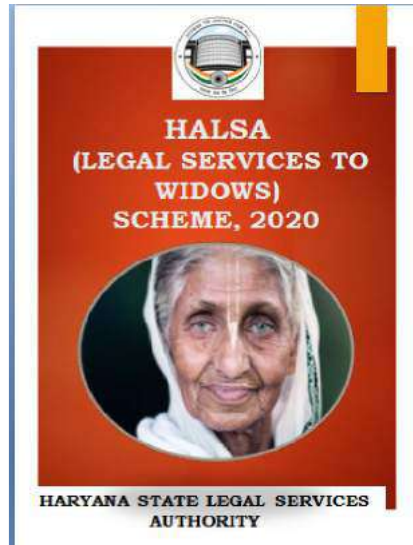
# Launch of Awareness Campaign on COVID

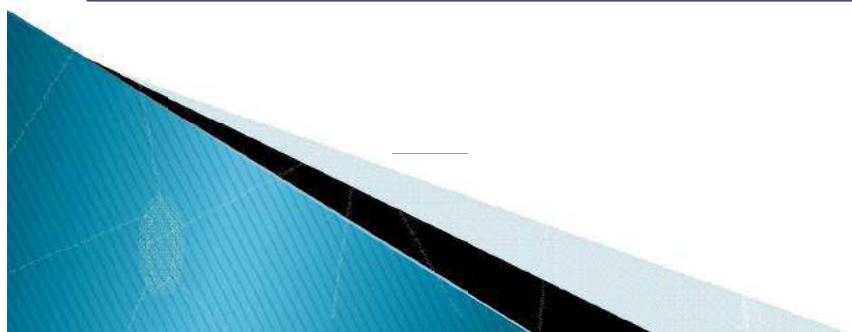
Lordship shared her valuable views and experiences with the orphaned children as well as staff members who were present there. Around 60-70 children were there. Lordship interacted with the children individually and collectively and inquired about their well-beings. Lordship inspected the living areas, kitchen, bedrooms, washrooms etc. to ensure the cleanliness and hygiene inside the homes. Children were also asked about the difficulties/hardships, if any, being faced by them.





## **DISTRIBUTION OF SMARTPHONES WITH JIO SIM CARD, WINTER WEAR SWEATERS, SOCKS, MASKS, BLIND MAN'S STICK**

Ms. Manju Bhist and Ms. Bimla Rawat, Para Legal Volunteers, District Legal Services Authority, Gurugram in association with BRINGING SMILES distributed a Smartphone with Jio Sim Card, winter wear Sweaters, socks, masks, Blind Man's stick to 22 visually impaired young Children from Janta Rehabilitation Centre, an NGO devoted to visually impaired persons. As per norms DLSA first scanned them for temperature and sanitised their hands. The smartphone has come as a boon to boost their academic carrier as well as functional knowledge. Most of these young children are studying for Awards like Graduation or Masters. Simple courtesies like breakfast were served by our volunteers in attendance. A Team from NAB in West Delhi also came to demonstrate use of Braille enabled tools for taking notes and reading currency. It was a pleasure to see them using their newly acquired phones to hail Ola Taxis and display the much needed Independence intended for them.



# MEDIA LITERACY WORKSHOP

The District Legal Services Authority, Gurugram in association with School of Law, The North Cap University conducted a media literacy workshop known as factshala by Prof. Umesh Arya today for the law students, teachers of the university and Panel Lawyers and Para legal volunteers of DLSA, GURUGRAM. Prof. Mr. Umesh Arya in his two hours presentation went on interactive mode and conducted 05 real-time activities including information overload, source verification, text verification, website verification, image verification, Facebook verification, and Twitter verification. Prof. Arya mentioned that the misinformation i.e. fake news is spreading fast on the internet through social media and mainly WhatsApp. He said that fake news causes wrong beliefs, confusion, and adversely affects the decision-making habits of the people. Ignorance of the law is of no excuse while forwarding the information intentionally or unintentionally. He emphasized that we should interrogate the incoming information with a few simple checklists. We need to look for the sent message, its source, and about its virality. The message's keywords can be entered into Google and searched for the matching results. Similar, incoming images must be uploaded to Google images to find similar images and decide if it is genuine. The video verification can be done similarly by applying for browser extensions like InVid. Prof. Arya told me that there is no single method of information verification and traditional and digital methods can be employed to verify. FactShala is a news and information literacy initiative launched by Internews in collaboration with Data LEADS and with support from Google.org and the Google News Initiative. The goal is to empower communities across India by building a strong and credible ecosystem of information by helping people to sift facts from the sea of online misinformation. The initiative will help people understand better the nature and characteristics of content published online. The Event was coordinated by Senior Assistant Professor of Law Ms. Pallavi Bajpai.

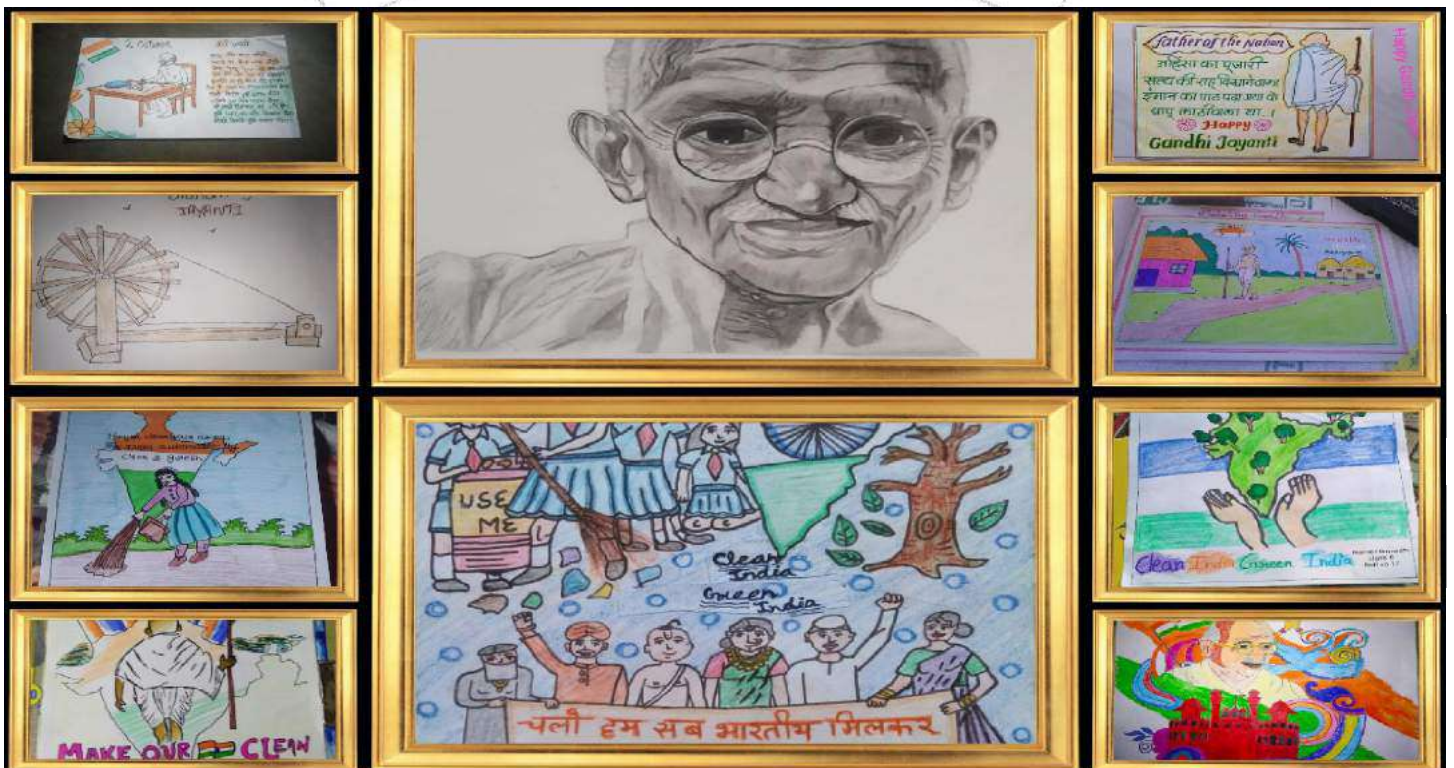






# ONLINE QUIZ COMPETITION & POSTER MAKING COMPETITION

Background

Most conservationists would have heard of the National Green Tribunal (NGT), and some may have already filed applications before it. This short primer explains how, when and where to approach the NGT, and looks at the fundamental difference between courts and tribunals, and the structure and jurisdiction of the NGT.

The NGT was established on October 18, 2010 under the National Green Tribunal Act 2010, passed by the Central Government. The stated objective of the Central Government was to provide a specialized forum for effective and speedy disposal of cases pertaining to environment protection, conservation of forests and for seeking compensation for damages caused to people or property due to violation of environmental laws or conditions.

## DISTRICT LEGAL SERVICES AUTHORITY, FARIDABAD

As rightly said by UNICEF, "Children may be driven into work for various reasons. Most often, child labour occurs when families face financial challenges or uncertainty. The consequences are staggering. Child labour can result in extreme bodily and mental harm. Each year a lot many children are subjected to child labour without their consent and that becomes a normal routine in their life. On one such occasion, in the district of Faridabad, panel advocate Ravinder Gupta and his team of other panel advocates of District Legal Services Authority, Faridabad with the help of officials of Child Welfare Committee and Labour Department along with police rescued two children A & B (name withheld). A - a 13 year old child worked at a dhaba while B - a 12 year old child was working at a tea stall, both residents of Faridabad. Both were rescued on 12.10.2020, after panel advocate Ravinder Gupta found about the two kids. He immediately brought the information in the notice of the Secretary of DLSA, Faridabad, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sh. Manglesh Kumar Choubey, in the notice of the CWC officials and the Labour Department, who then collectively conducted the raid on the two places. Post raid, the children were taken to the CWC office where they were inquired about their situation. Both the children told that their family consisted of a father who was bedridden and their sister, who stayed at home taking care of their father. The reason why they were engaged in such labour was due to financial problems as they two were the only ones who earned for the house. The Child Welfare Committee upon hearing this declared the kids CNCP and tied a system of providing them with a sum of Rs.2,000/- per month for their caretaking and safety so that they don't have to earn anymore. A sum of Rs.5,000 /- was also provided to them by Red Cross Society, Faridabad

Sponsorship for a time span of 1 year was provided by Rajesh Tyagi and Associates (Industrialists) for their food and educational needs and medicinal needs for their father. A complaint was logged in the police station against the owners of the dhaba and the tea stall for hiring and using children for labour. The kids thanked the officials of DLSA, Districts and Sessions Judge cum Chairman, Sh. Deepak Gupta and Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Secretary, Sh. Manglesh Kumar Choubey, the CWC and Labour Department officials, and the panel advocates, Ravinder Gupta, Rajinder Gautam, Rambir Tanwar, Om Prakash Saini and Shiv Kumar for helping them for getting out of this vicious cycle and providing financial and other necessary aid during such times of distress.



## DISTRICT LEGAL SERVICES AUTHORITY, FARIDABAD

Shelters provide secure accommodation for people who are abandoned or have been subjected to violence, although they contribute far more than just a safe place to stay. Shelters provide essential aspects of protection, services and resources which enable people who have experienced abuse to recover from the violence, to rebuild self-esteem, and to take steps to regain a self-determined and independent life. With proper resources, shelters have the capacity to provide the range of protection and support necessary services. On one such occasion during the COVID 19 pandemic in India, on 20.10.2020, Mr. Ravinder Gupta, panel advocate, District Legal Services Authority, Faridabad, encountered a man by the name of Mr. Sundarlal, aged 66 years, s/o Sukhram, r/o village Nariyala, Ballabgarh, in an unclaimed state, crying out in vain near B.K. Hospital, Faridabad. It was found that in the morning of 20.10.2020, he was beaten and kicked out of his own house by one of his three sons, who were living under the same roof along with his daughter-in-law and grandkids. Sundarlal was left to wander in the streets on 20.10.2020 after being subjected to physical violence for a long time. His son was sick and tired of taking proper care of his father, had not treated him fairly for several years now and had finally thrown him out of their own house. The information was brought into the notice of the Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Faridabad, Mr. Manglesh Kumar Choubey, who then instructed him and his team to do the needful. The panel advocate responded immediately to the information and along with



other panel advocates, Rajinder Gautam, Rambir Tanwar, Om Prakash Saini, Shiv Kumar and Gagan Kumar & the manager of Tau Devi Lal Old Age Home Faridabad, Mr. Kishan Lal Bajaj took him to the shelter home and informed the nearest police station about the man. Where on, he was taken care of properly and was inquired by the panel advocate about the incident and the rest of his details so as to help him out. Though upon being taken into the shelter home he was welcomed and made to feel the place homely. He was assured that he will be taken good care of and was accommodated comfortably in the Old Age Home and it was also assured by the panel advocate that due care and constant follow up shall be done in regards to his case and if he needed any kind of legal action he should contact them at the DLSA office and on behalf of the DLSA, help would be provided to him free of cost. The old man was happy to see the District Legal Service Authorities and the Old Age Home come to his aid at such a time when his own son had backstabbed him and kicked him out of the house. The efforts of the quick and unswerving nature of the panel advocates made it possible for this person to find shelter in Tau Devi Lal Old Age Home and it was indeed a success for the District Legal Services Authority, Faridabad which, under the chairmanship of Districts and Sessions Judge, Sh. Deepak Gupta and under the supervision of Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Secretary, DLSA, Sh. Manglesh Kumar Choubey, helped find this person some peace and a place to live during such stressful times.







# DISTRICT LEGAL SERVICES AUTHORITY, JHAJJAR

Sudesh W/O Mukesh R/O Beri through PLV Nita sought help from DLSA Jhajjar. Prior to COVID- 19 Pandemic husband of Sudesh used to sell " Prasad" outside temples but as temples were closed he could not carry out his work.
