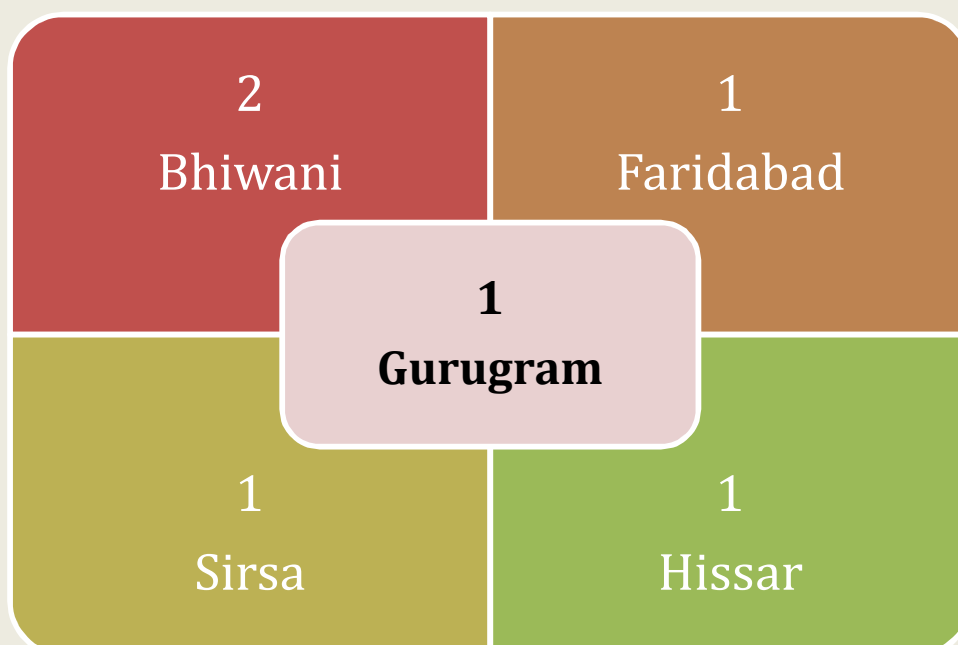

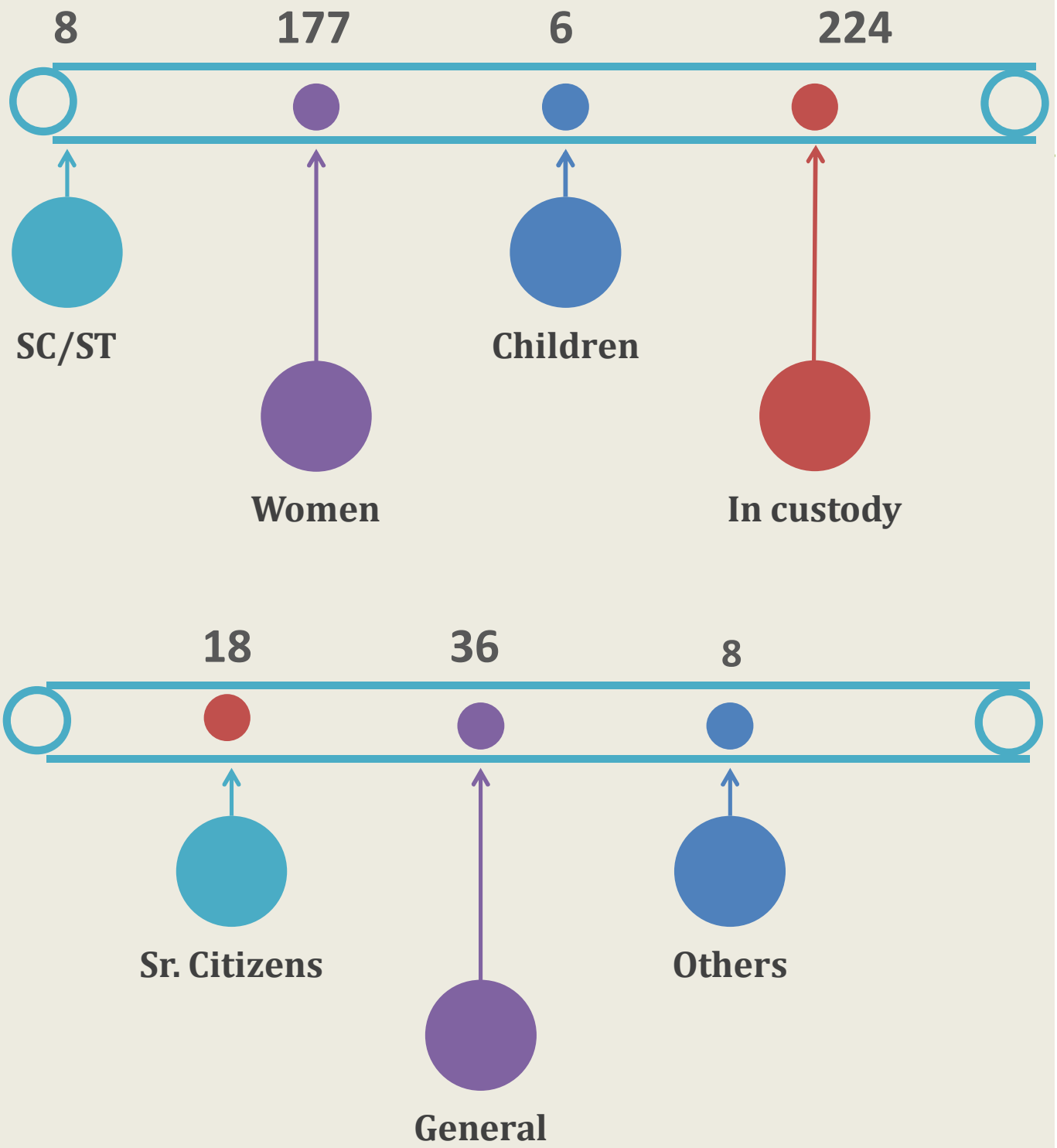
## Filing of Appeals

All the Ld. Secretaries, DLSAs have been requested to ensure expeditiously filing of appeals by following instructions already issued in this regard by HALSA. They were further requested to make efforts to identify convicts in need of legal aid immediately after filing pronouncement of judgment against such persons. Their request be processes expeditiously and complete paper book for filing of appeal be sent to the counsel on priority basis. Secretaries were also requested to follow up with the concerned appointed advocates for the latest status of the case and the same be communicated to the concerned person seeking legal aid.

**Since negligible number of cases have been decided in the month of November, 2020 due to Covid-19 pandemic the total Number of appeals filed is 6**

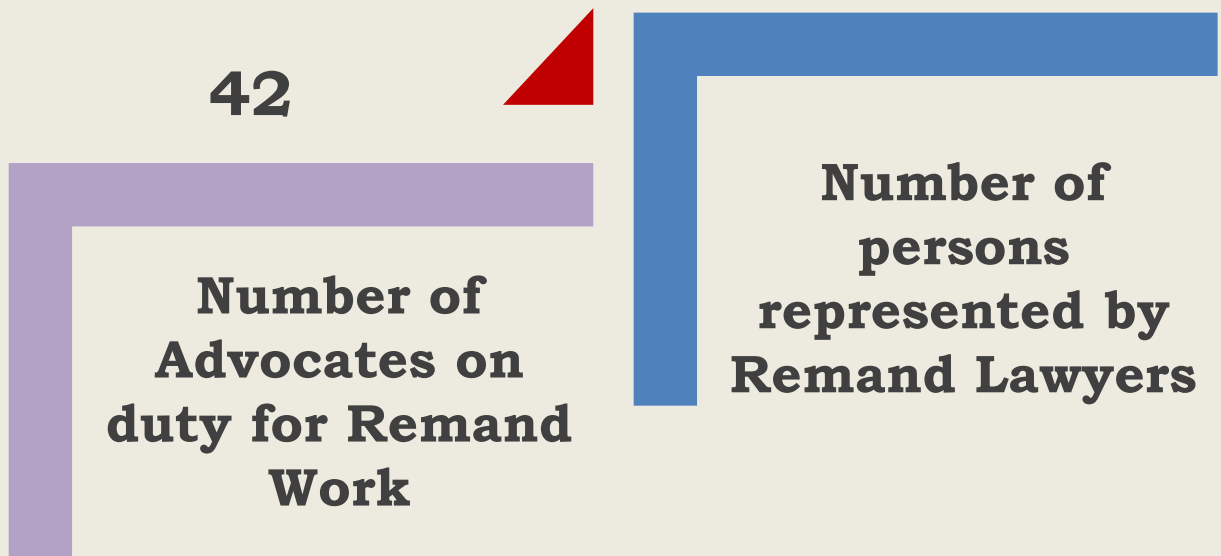

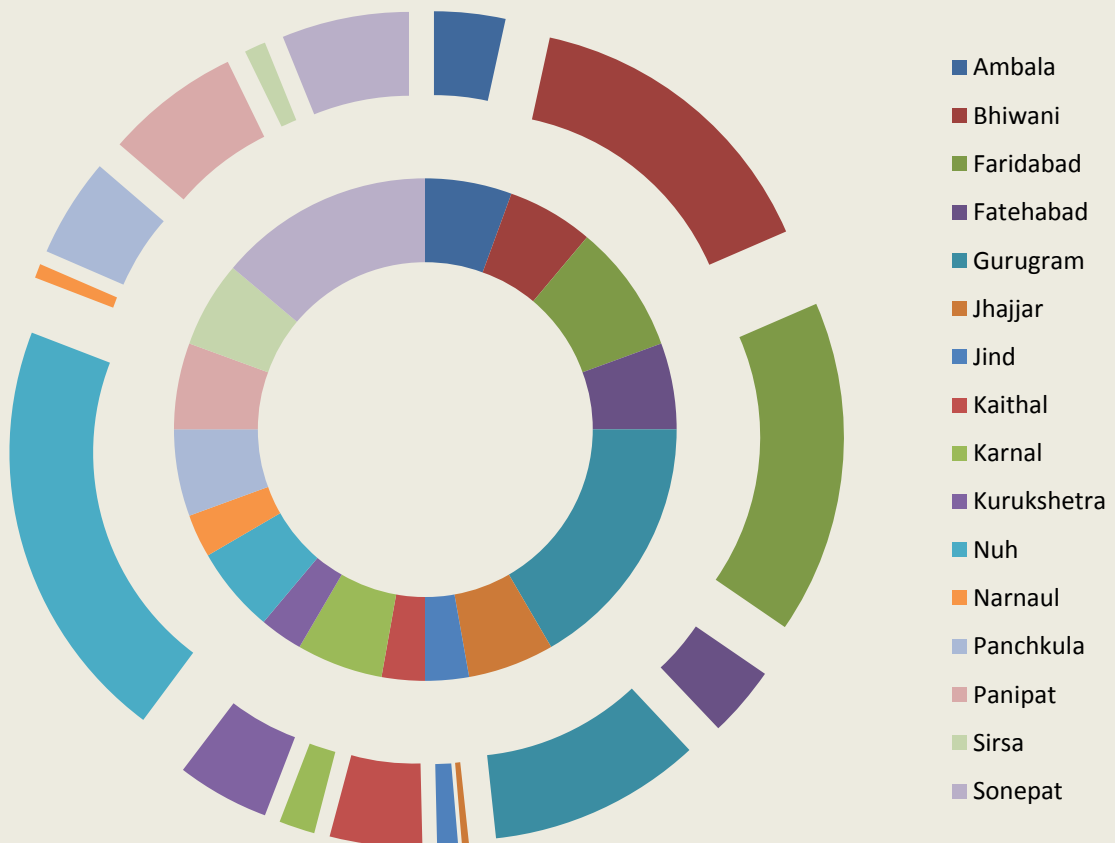


**Despite social and economic hindrance due to Covid-19, around 477 people were provided with free legal aid and advice during the month of November, 2020.**

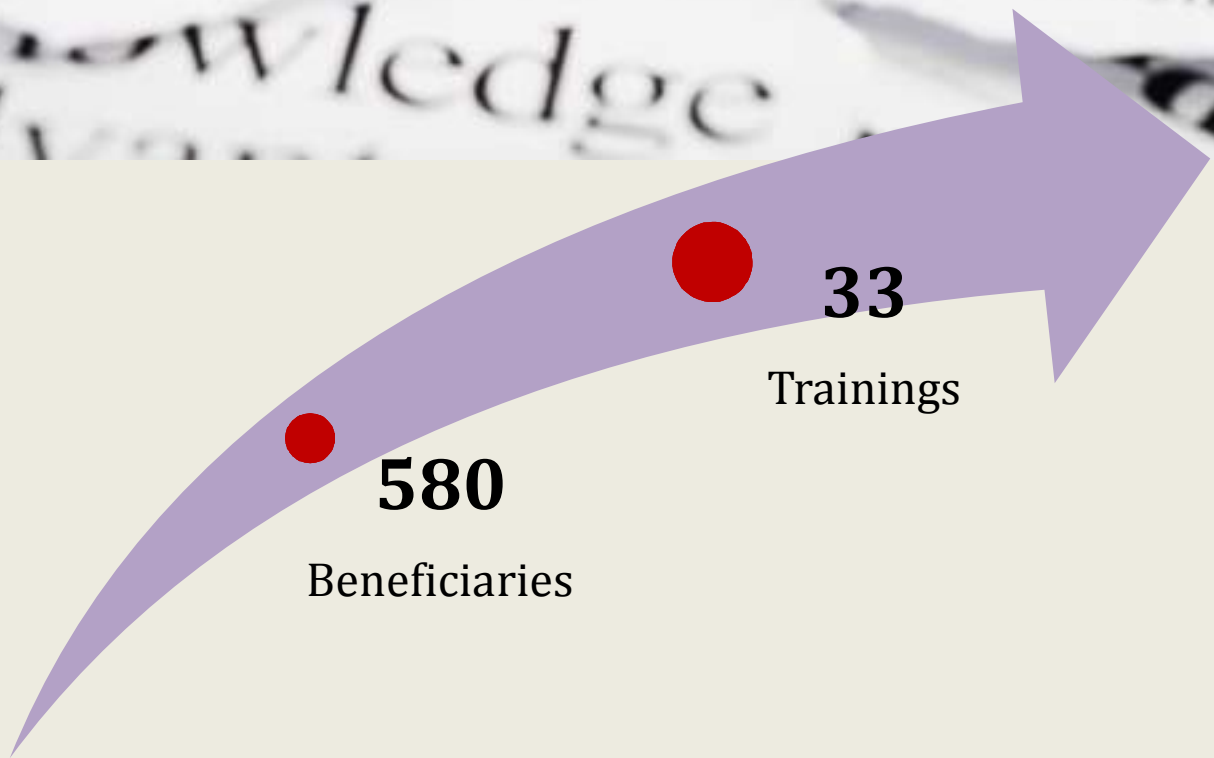

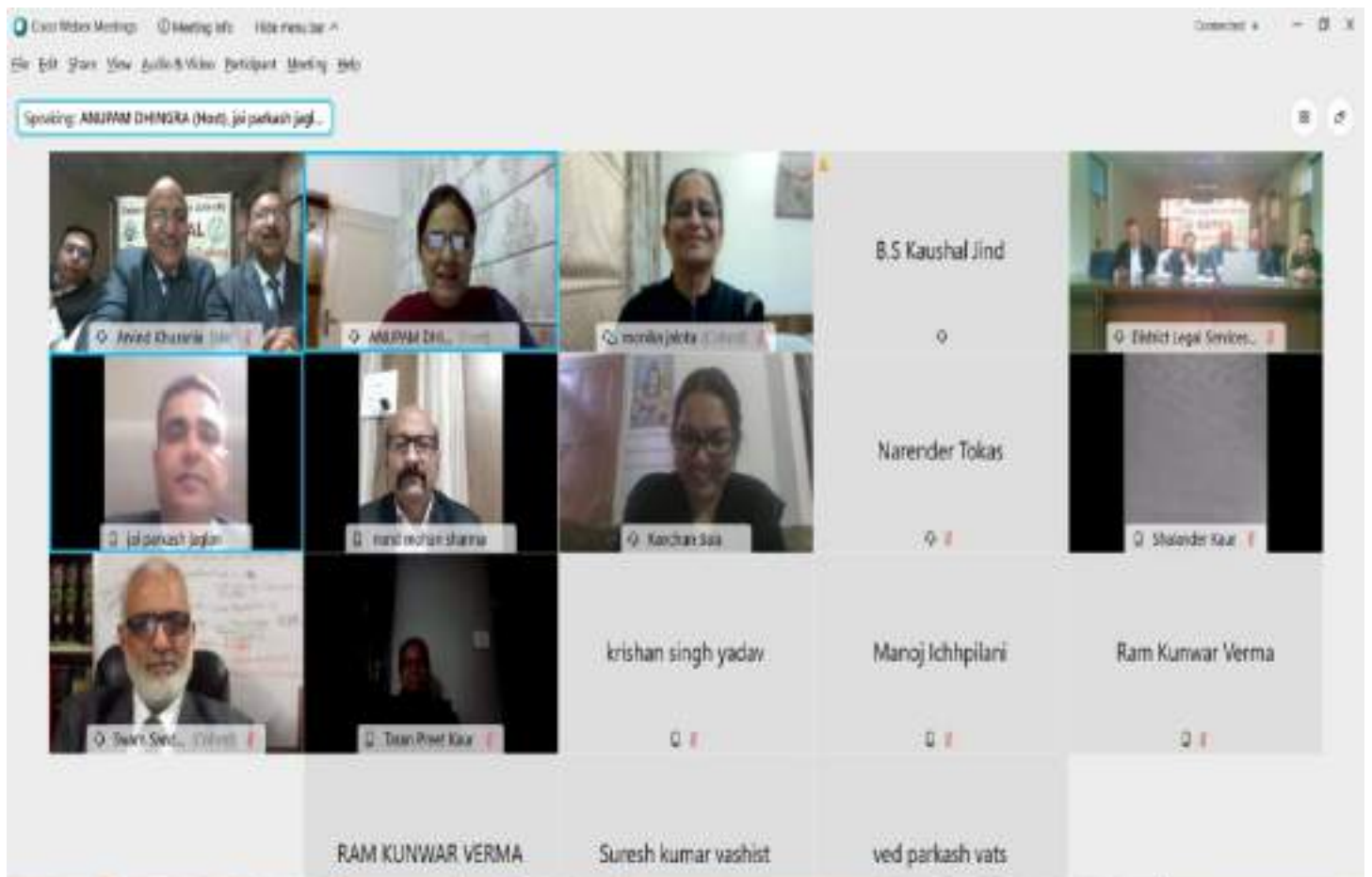

## Workshop for police personnel by DLSA Faridabad

A seminar was conducted by Child Helpline Faridabad to sensitize police personnel of RPF & GRP Faridabad on Juvenile Justice Act, Protection of Children against sexual Offences (POCSO Act) and general awareness while handling children cases. Mrs Sunita Baisla as a distt coordinator child help line faridabad welcomed everyone and informed that crime by the children and against children are on the rise and increasing rapidly. Hence all the stakeholders of Integrated Child protection scheme (ICPS) need to be very proactive to check this and help the needy children. Adv Gola Represent of DLSA briefed on JJ Act. Wing Commander Hari Chand Mann (Retd) Judicial Member Juvenile justice Board shared his experience with audience and briefed on general outline while dealing with the cases of children conflict with law (CCL). Adv Shripal Kharana Chairperson CWC spoke about children who are in need of care and protection (CNCP). Lastly Mrs Aparana spoke on POCSO act and also highlighted the latest amendment to this act to curb the crime rate. Overall it was a very educative and informative session. The seminar was held at RPF conference hall Faridabad Railway station.





## Online awareness on World Epilepsy Day by DLSA Faridabad

The District Legal Services Authority, Faridabad organized an online poster making program on the occasion of Epilepsy Day for the students from Government Girls Senior Secondary School, NIT, Faridabad. The students made posters for the occasion and the posters were sent to the advocates via whatsapp. The posters explained various aspects of epilepsy. The advocates even elaborated the kids about what it is. It is a chronic disorder of brain characterized by recurrent 'seizures' or 'fits'. The posters made by the children explained various symptoms, causes and management tips for handling this illness. The advocates thought it to be a significantly informative and great step in order to keep the students engaged during such times so that they can do something creative and learn through it, that could help in understanding basics of such illness and learn how to deal with them rather than give up on the people suffering from this.





## Wall painting and designing course for inmates in observation home by DLSA Faridabad

On 19.11.2020, a course of Wall Painting and Designing through AkzoNobel Pvt. Ltd.'s scheme, namely Saksham, was inaugurated by the District's & Sessions Judge cum Chairman of District Legal Services Authority, Faridabad in the Observation Home, NIT along with the efforts of the Supdt. Observation Home and panel advocates Ravinder Gupta, Rajinder Gautam and Rambir Tanwar. The aim of this scheme, according to the Global Hunt Foundation, was to train 15 such children properly and aid them in providing jobs after coming out from the Observation Home. The foundation would provide for with the training sessions while the company would provide with the paints, brushes and the other necessary materials required for this course to the Observation Home. The Districts and Sessions Judge cum Chairman, Sh. Deepak Gupta and Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Secretary, Sh. Manglesh Kumar Choubey of DLSA, Faridabad were welcomed with a bouquet by the Superintendent of Observation Home, Sh. Dinesh Yadav. Sh. Deepak Gupta congratulated him for taking such initiatives and encouraged him to do more in the future for the betterment of the children there. Sh. Deepak Gupta also told the children that they should take part in such initiatives as this would definitely help them get up on their feet once they get out from the Observation Home and would provide them a respectable place in the society.

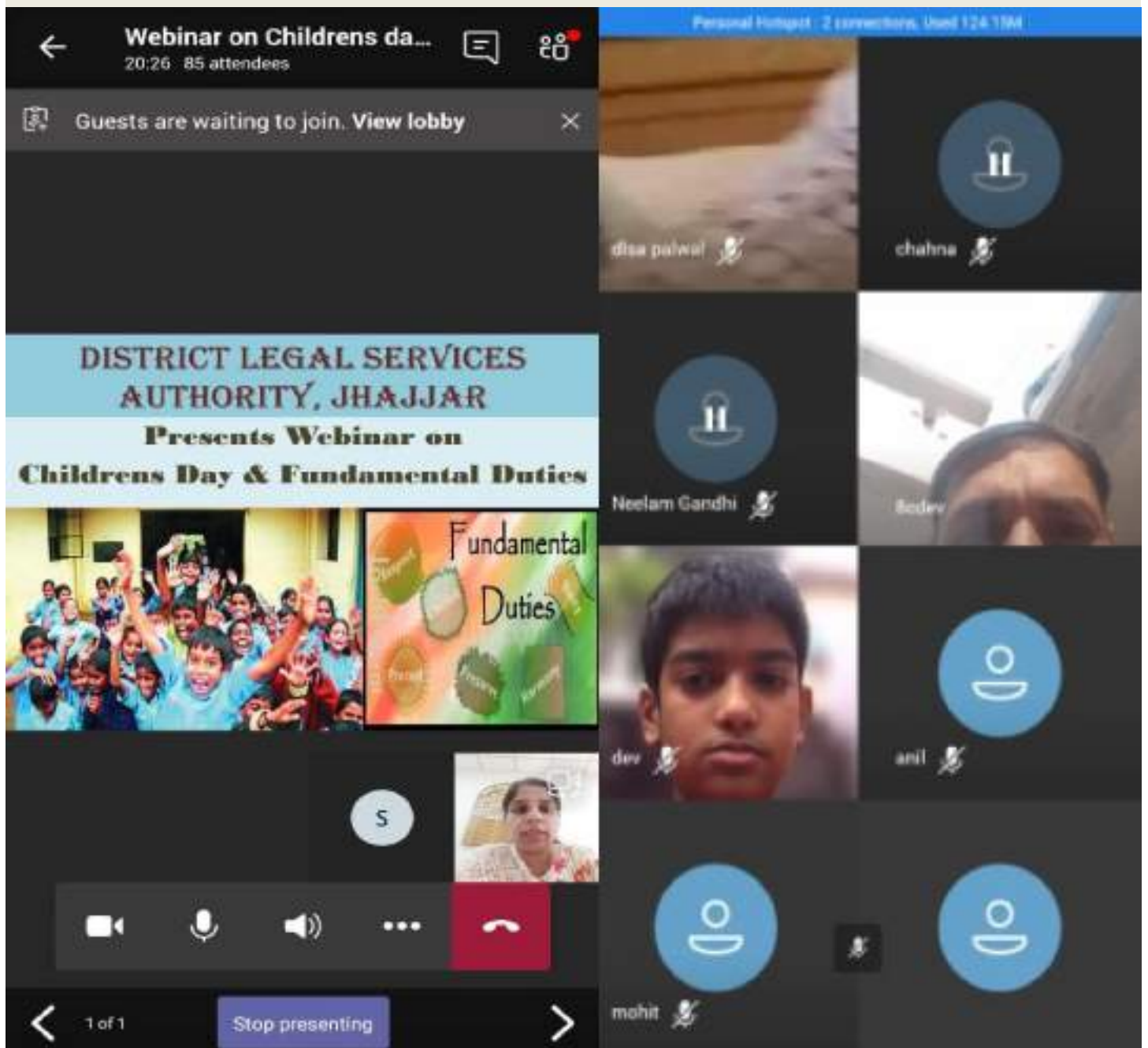

# Children's Day Camp

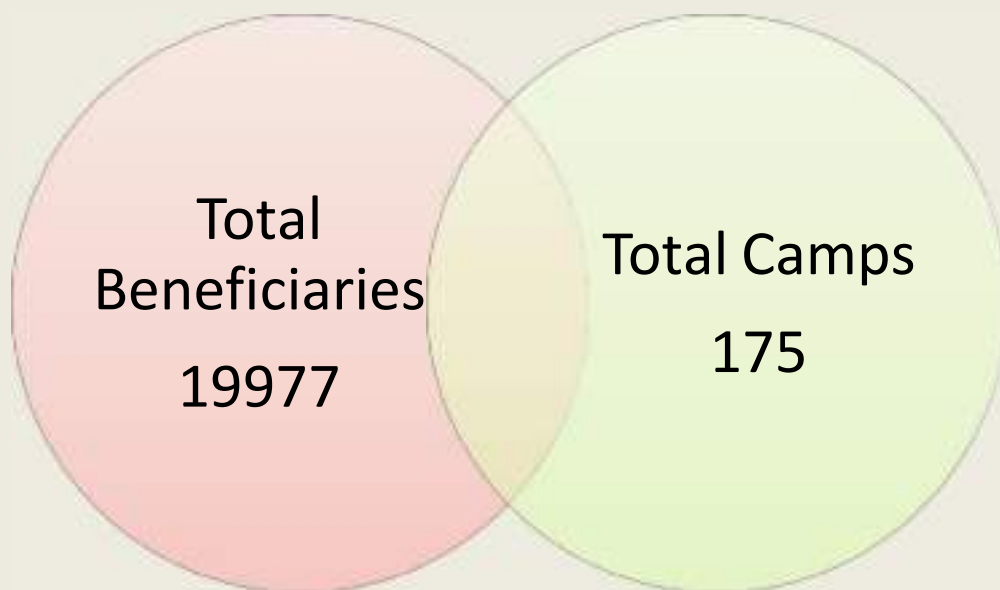

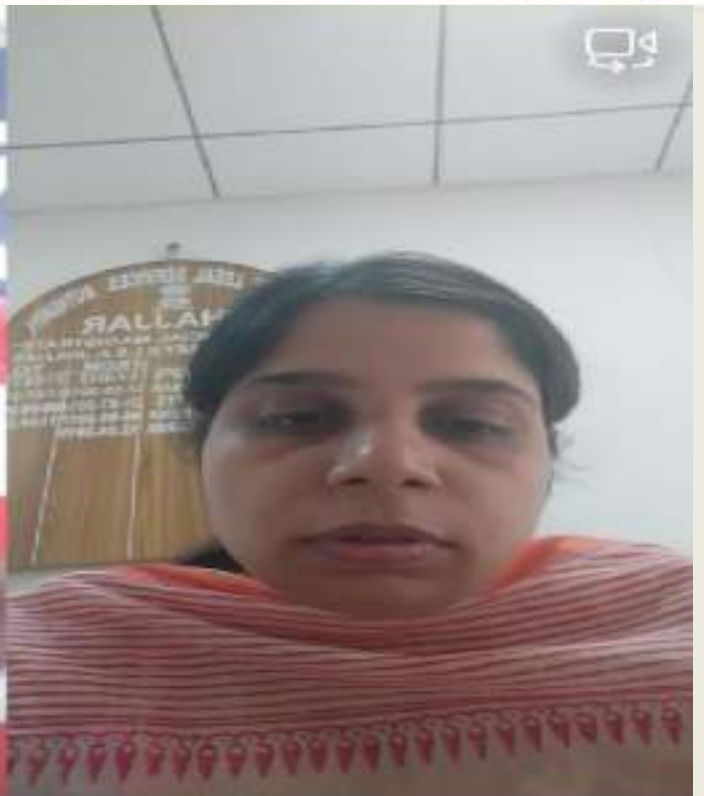
# World Diabetes Day

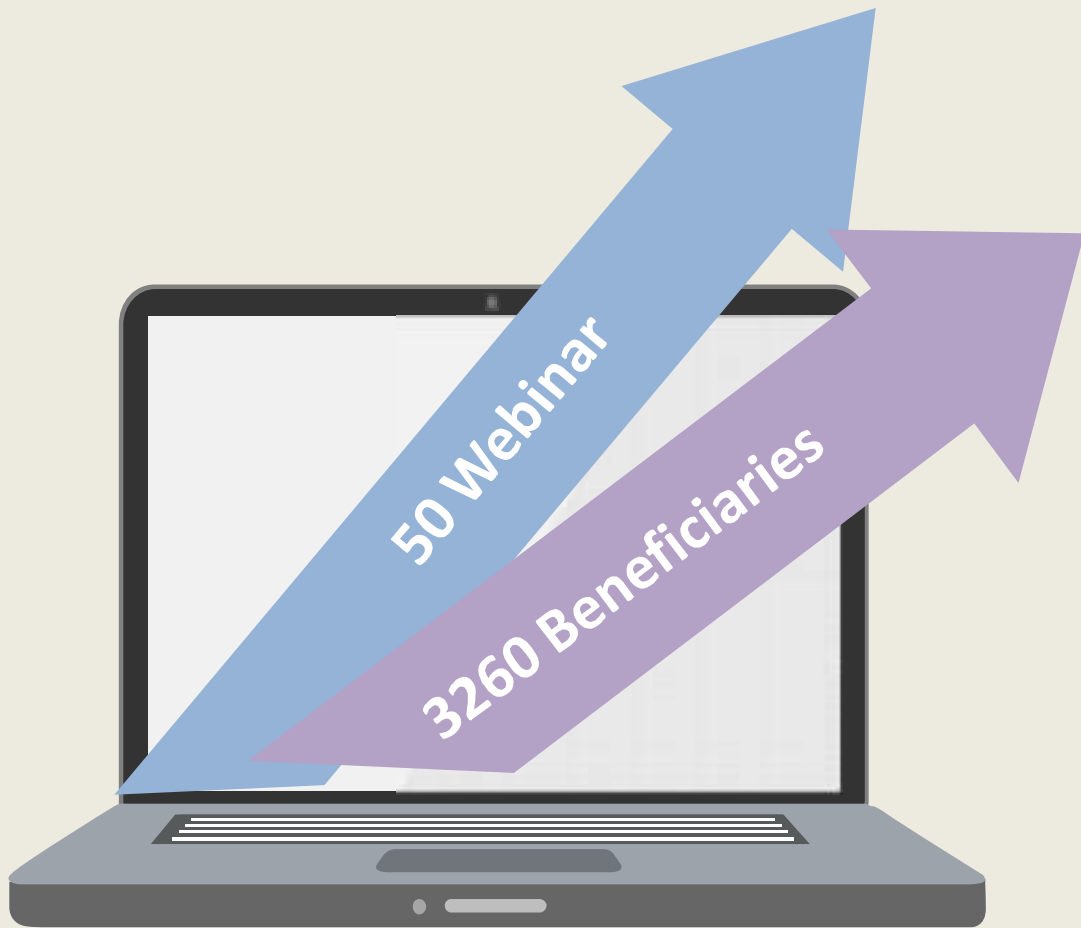
## **Awareness camps through Mobile Van!!!**

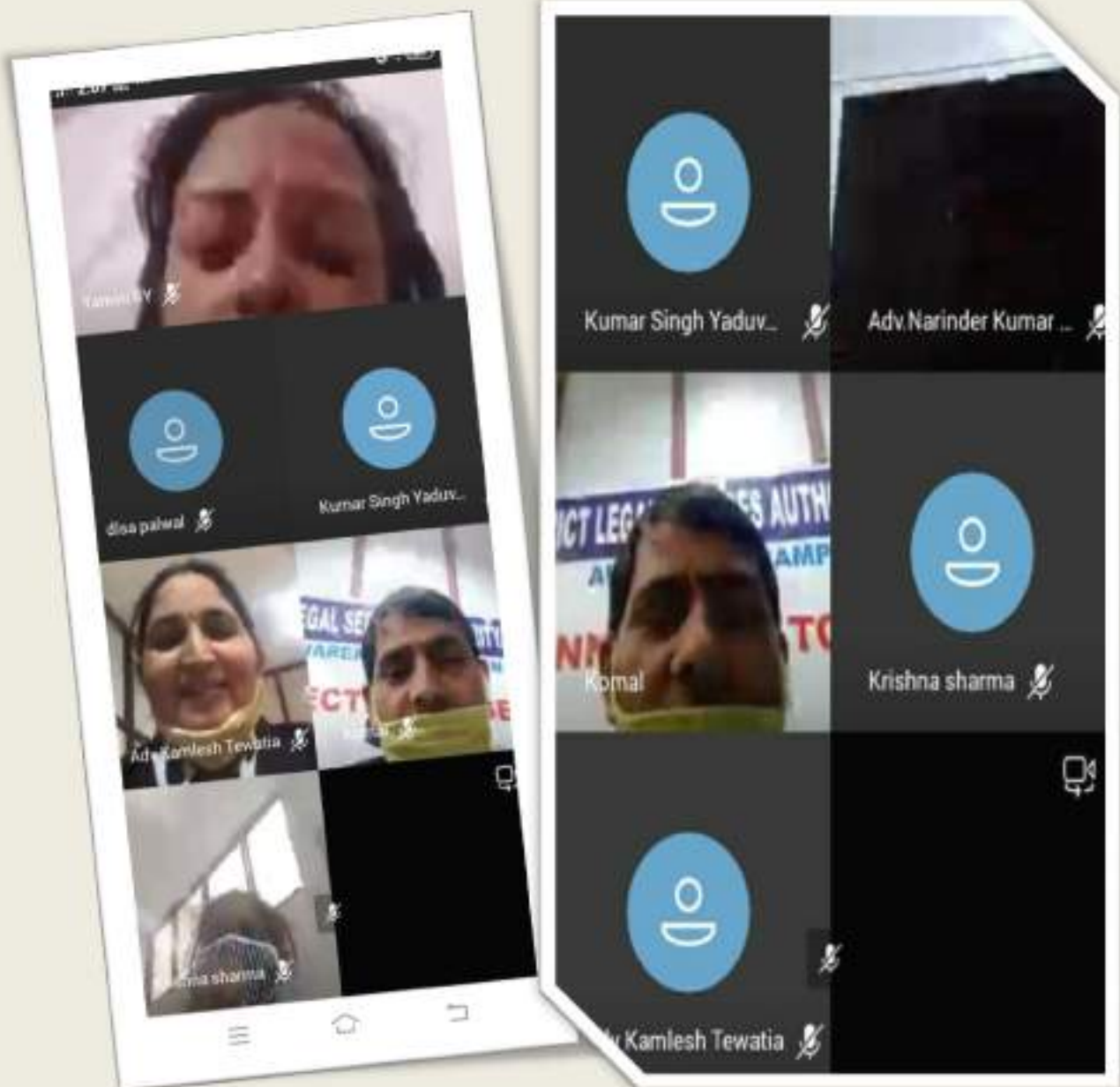

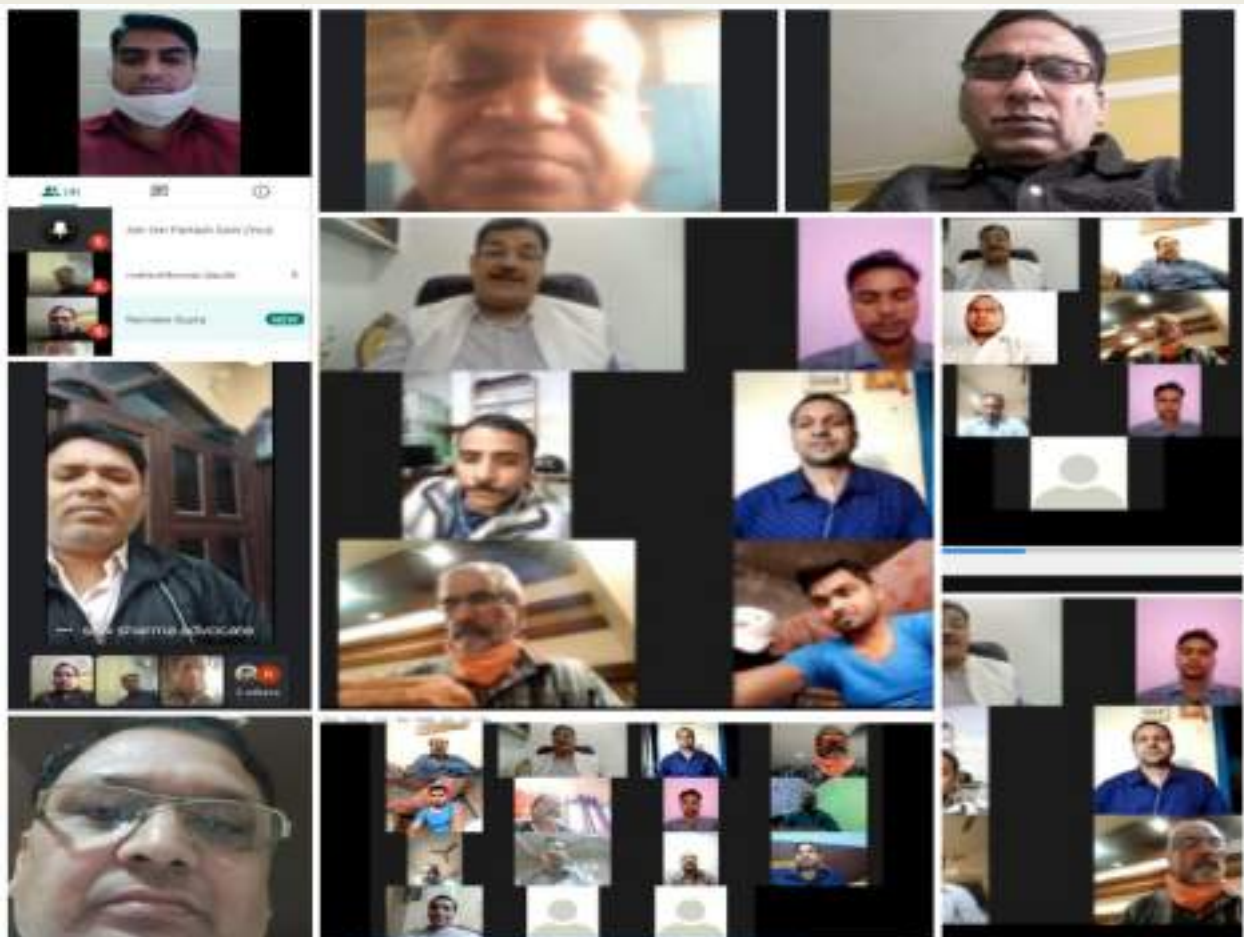
## WEBINAR ON STUBBLE BURNING

On enquiry by the advocate, it was found that she was subjected to physical violence for no particular reasons. She got married on 09.03.2003 and was ever since not properly maintained by her husband. Her husband had kicked her out, kept the children and had filed for divorce.

The case of the lady was then discussed with Id. Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Faridabad. Ld. CJM then constituted a team of panel advocates and guided them the further course of action.

Accordingly, the team so constituted with panel advocates namely Sh. Ravinder Gupta, Sh. Rajinder Gautam, Sh. Rambir Tanwar, Sh. Om Prakash Saini, Sh. Shiv Kumar and Sh. Gagan Kumar called her husband to the office where he was asked to tell his side of the story.

Thereafter the team counseled both the parties and after conducting mediation among both the parties, a mutual settlement was arrived at.
