# HIGH POWERED COMMITTEE

**The Committee has been mandated to determine which class of prisoners can be released on parole, or interim bail for such period as may be deemed appropriate.**

## MEETING

On 26.09.2020, Hon'ble High Powered Committee held its 9<sup>th</sup> meeting through video conferencing under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajiv Sharma, Judge, Punjab and Haryana High Court and Executive Chairman, Haryana State Legal Services Authority. Various guidelines were issued by the High Powered Committee in its previous meetings dated 24.03.2020, 30.03.2020, 13.04.2020, 20.04.2020, 05.05.2020, 22.05.2020, 15.06.2020 and 31.08.2020 to the concerned authorities for taking appropriate steps for release of prisoners lodged in different jails of Haryana.

## Steps taken by High Powered Committee

### Restoring prisoners back to jail

HPC has decided to restore **2,399** prisoners who are concerned in serious offences, slowly to their respective jails by taking all precautionary measures and safeguards to protect them and others in jails from COVID infection

### Extension of parole for 6 weeks

Special parole has been extended by six weeks till 16.11.2020. HPC has directed the jail authorities to ask such convicts to surrender from 17.11.2020 instead of 02.10.2020

### Covid Testing for Prisoners

Jail authorities and health authorities have been directed to coordinate with each other and take all necessary steps for testing of 2,399 convicts for their readmission in jails

## Filing of Appeals

All the Ld. Secretaries, DLSAs have been requested to ensure expeditiously filing of appeals by following instructions already issued in this regard by HALSA. They were further requested to make efforts to identify convicts in need of legal aid immediately after filing pronouncement of judgment against such persons. Their request be processes expeditiously and complete paper book for filing of appeal be sent to the counsel on priority basis. Secretaries were also requested to follow up with the concerned appointed advocates for the latest status of the case and the same be communicated to the concerned person seeking legal aid.

**Since negligible number of cases have been decided in the month of September, 2020 due to Covid-19 pandemic the total Number of appeals filed is 12**

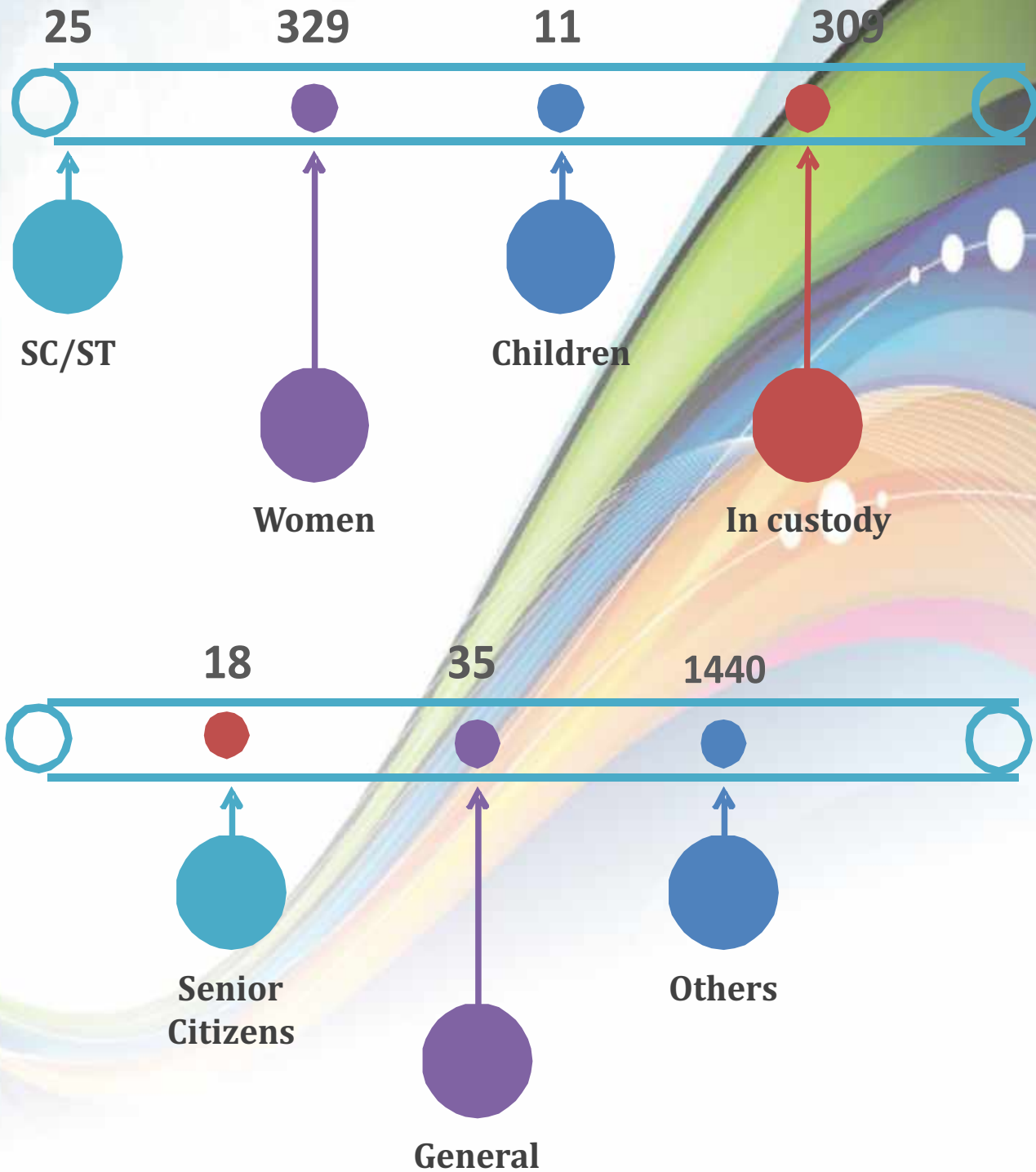

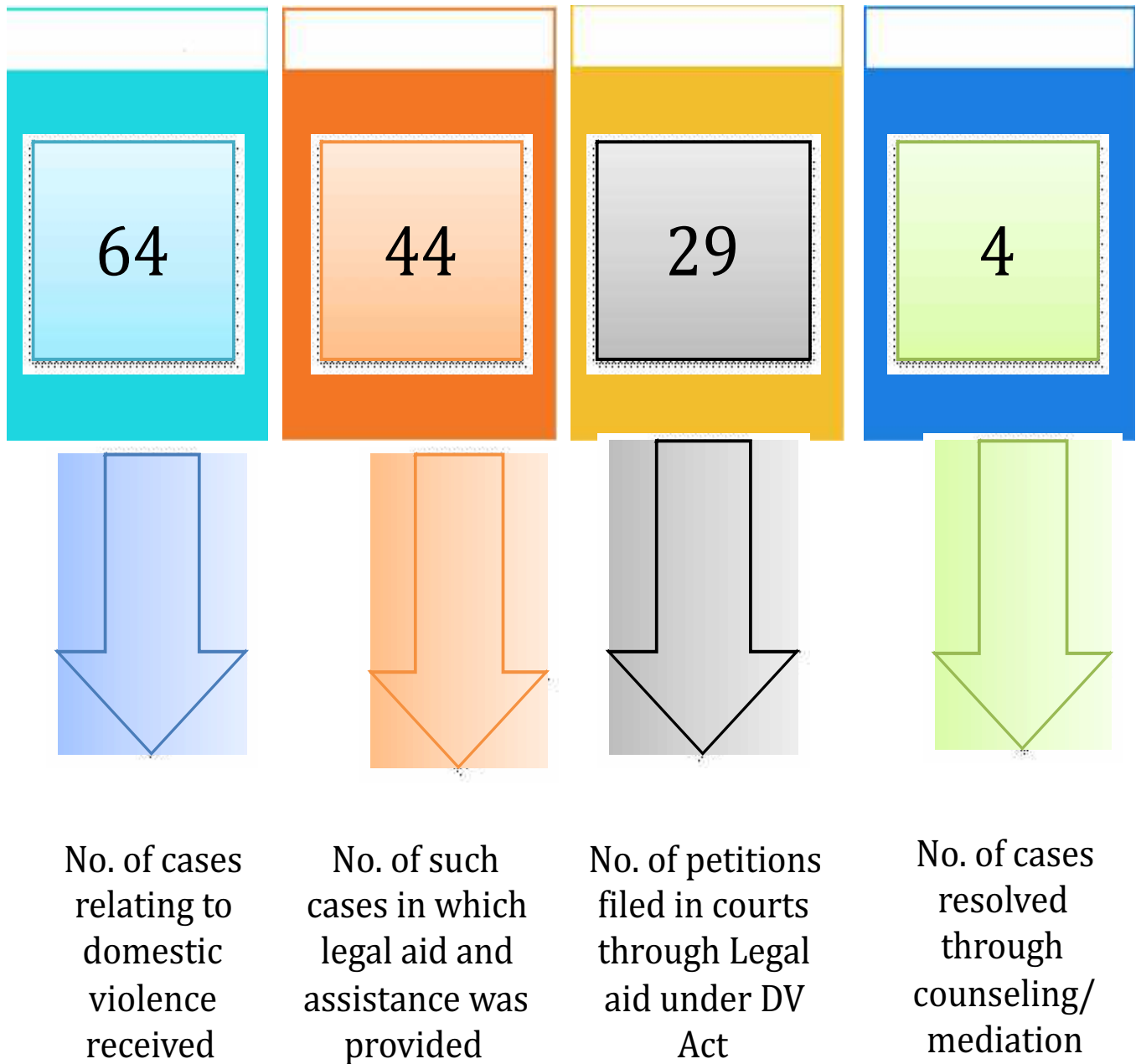

**Despite social and economic hindrance due to Covid 19, around 741 people were provided with free legal aid and advice during the month of September, 2020.**

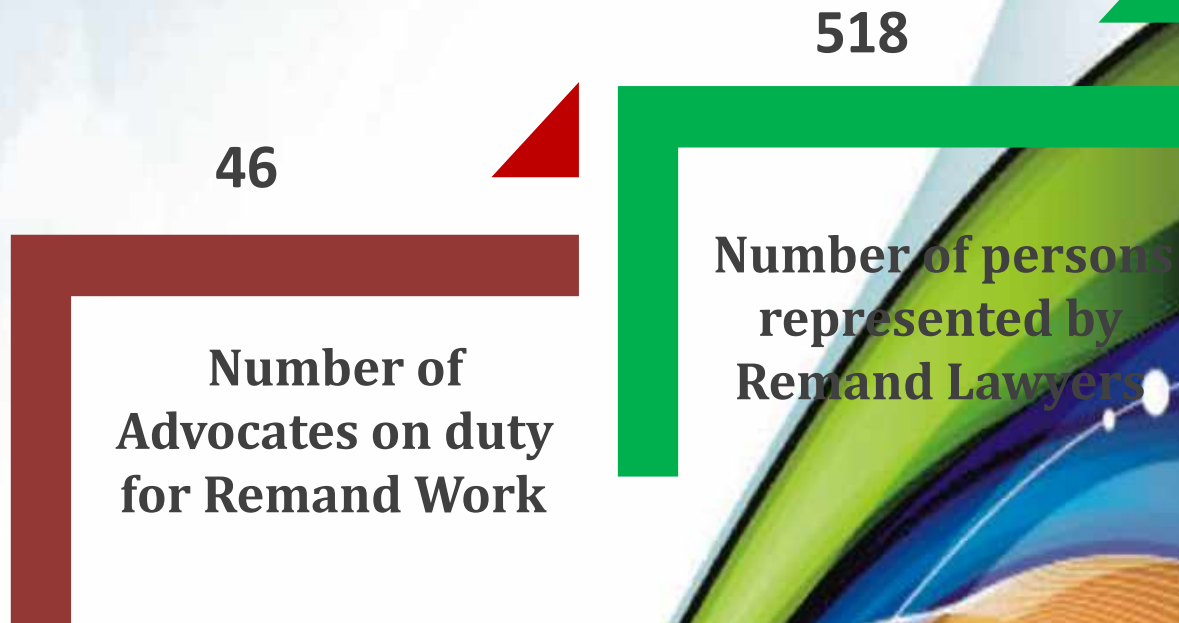

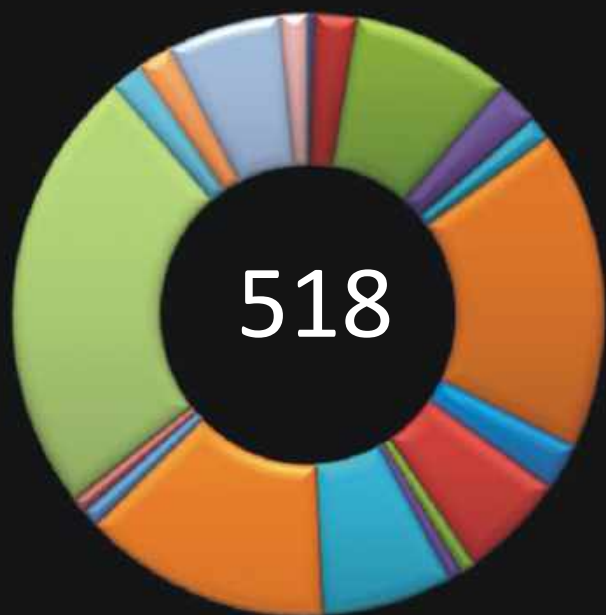

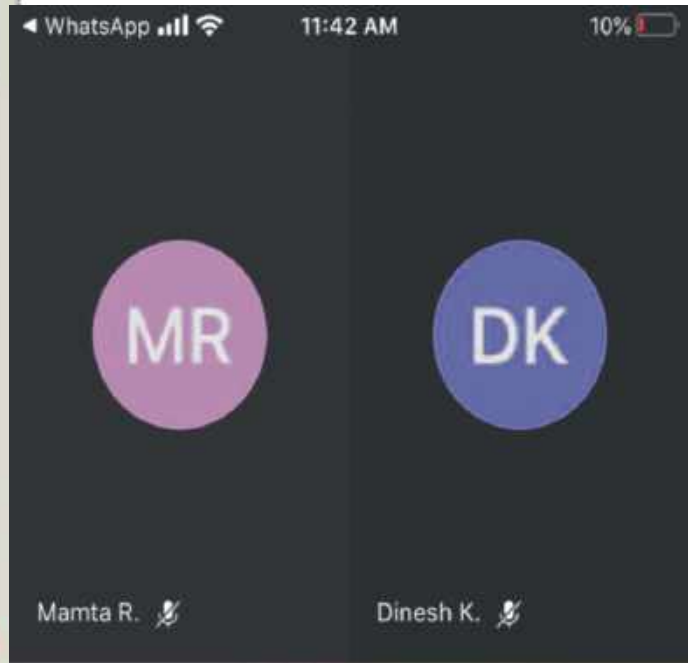
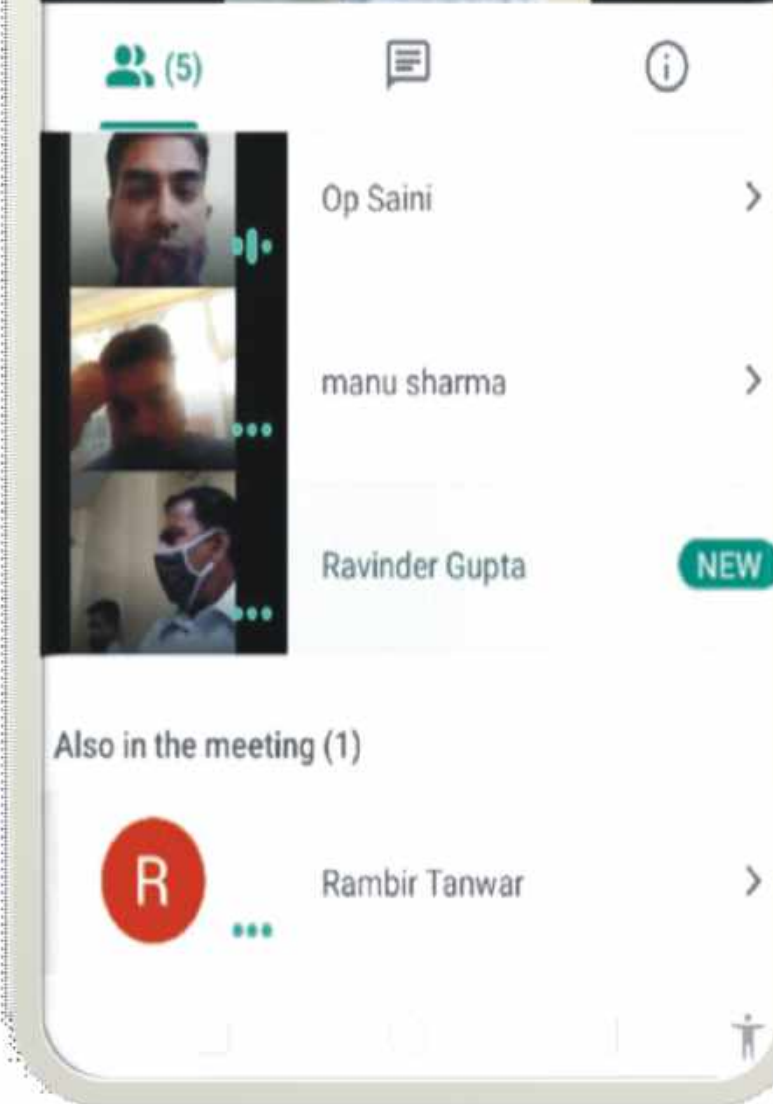
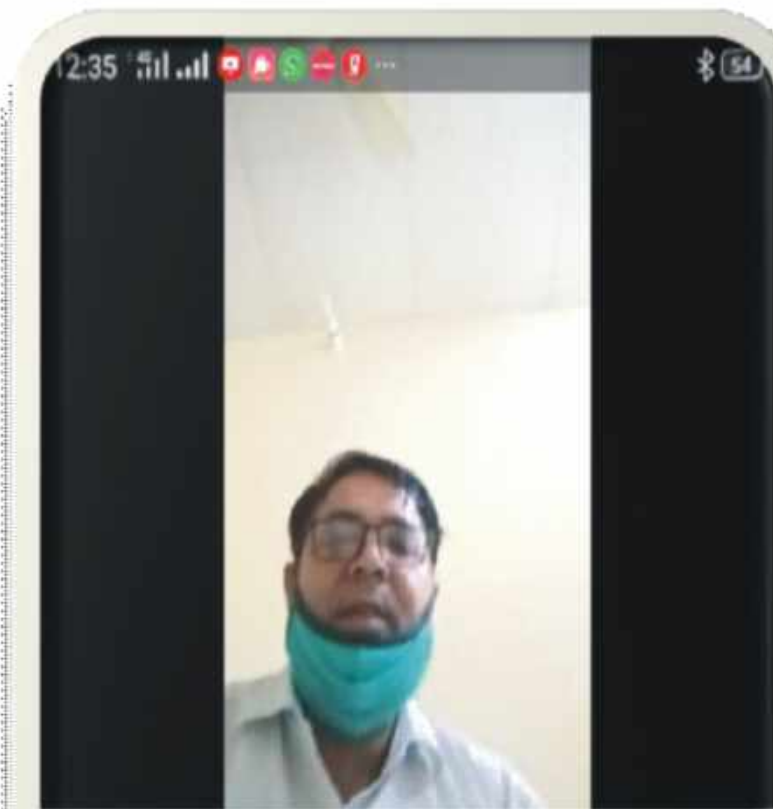
## Other Beneficiaries

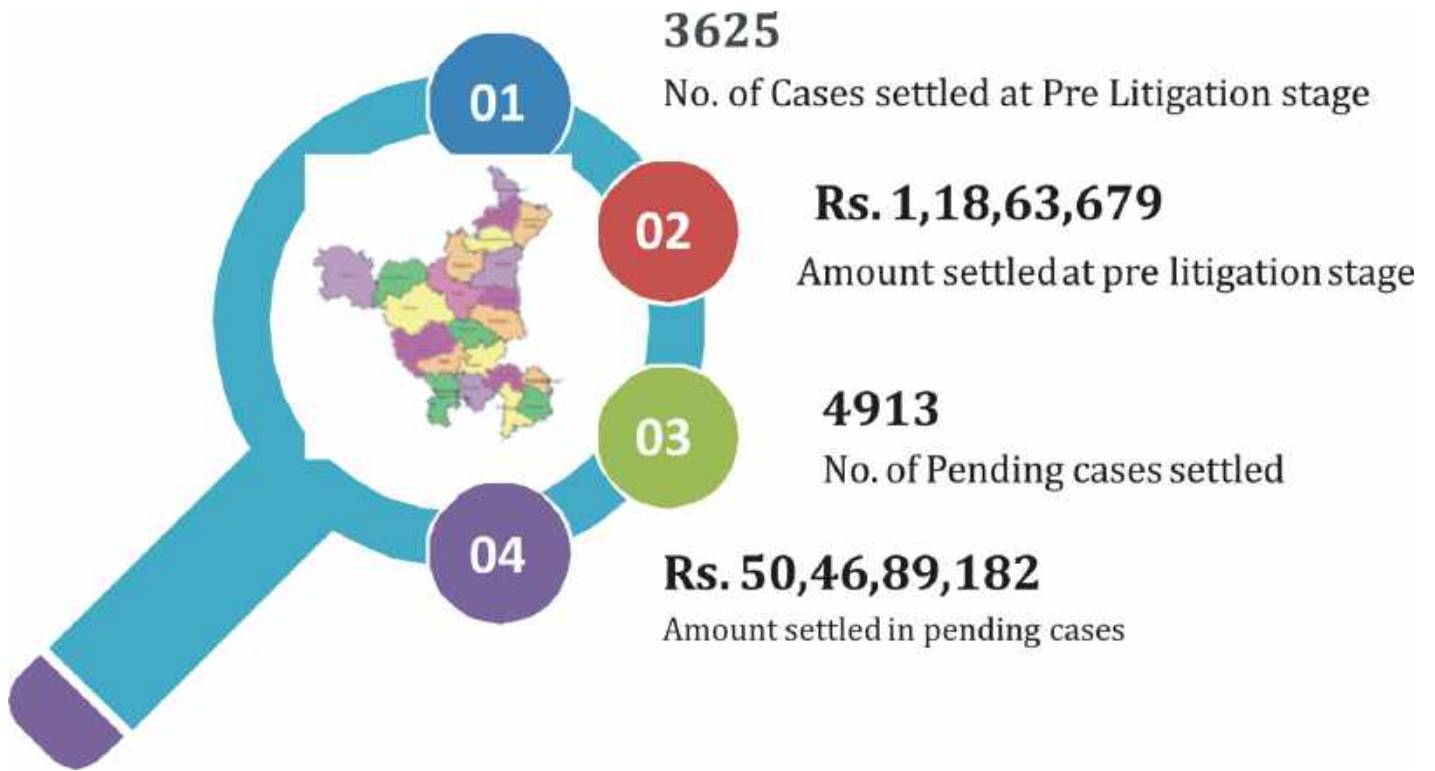

After the success of E-Lok Adalat, Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajiv Sharma, Executive Chairman, HALSA widened the scope of E-Lok Adalat to Daily e-Lok Adalat which has the potential to provide thousands of people a single platform to settle their grievances. Nevertheless holding Effective e-Lok Adalats will reduce the stress on courts by settling cases at different stages. Accordingly, daily e-lok adalat was inaugurated by Hon'ble Executive Chairman, HALSA on 25.09.2020.

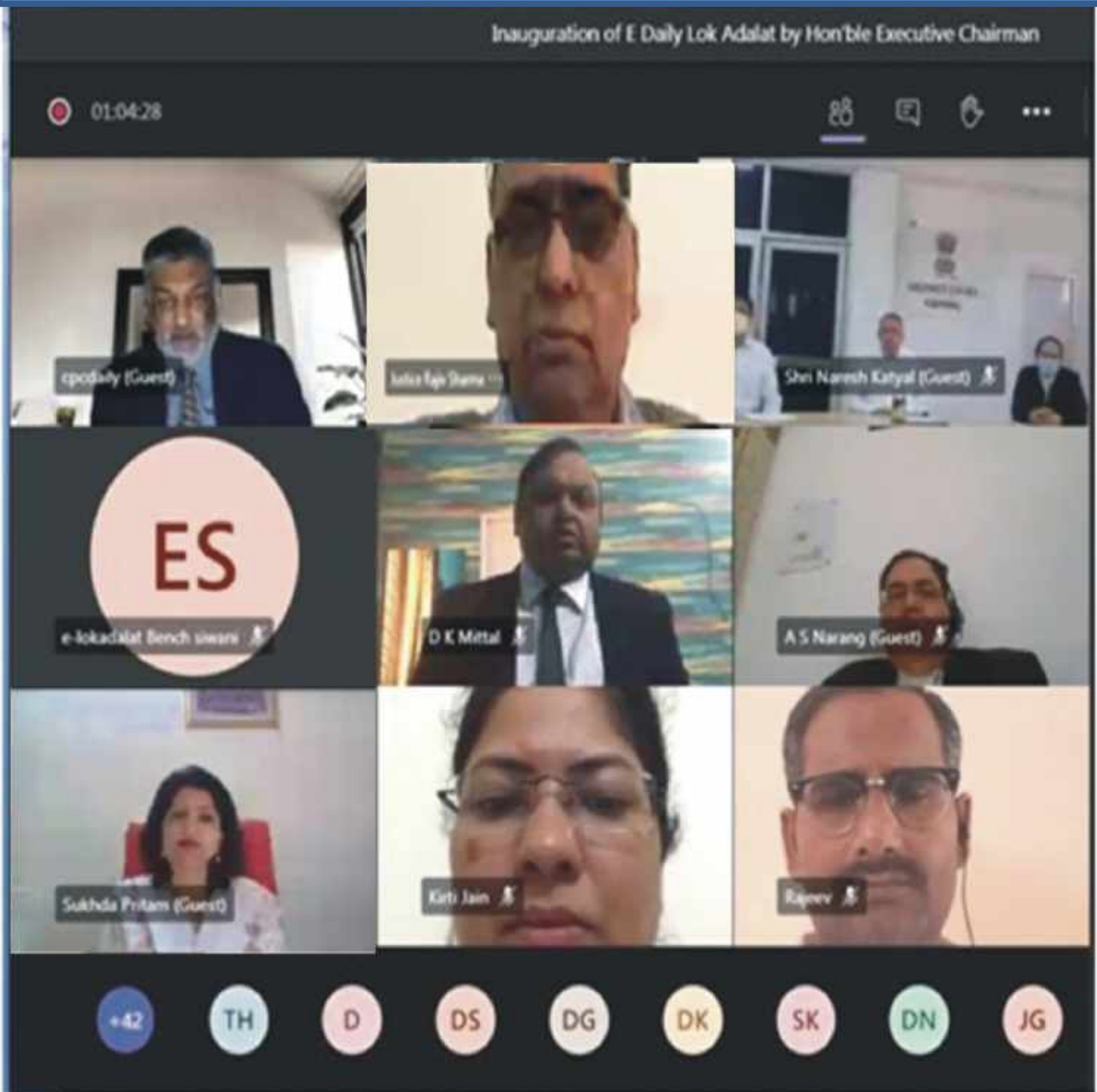

During his address Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajiv Sharma, said that owing to success of the E-Lok Adalat and for regular benefit of the litigants, daily e-Lok Adalats is started from 25.09.2020 wherein cases will be taken up by the Courts in the state of Haryana on daily basis by use of Electronic Platform. His lordship highlighted the success of E-Lok Adalat in which 8538 cases were settled and recognised the efforts put in by all the Stake holders. The daily e-Lok Adalat is an another step forward to build on the foundation already laid.

# HALSA in Coordination with HSACS

It is quite clear that COVID 19 pandemic is a grave area of concern these days but at the same time, other health issues like HIV/AIDS cannot be alienated as it is a hard fact that this disease is equally potent and malignant. HALSA in coordination with Haryana State Aids Control society has started a process to create a resource bank which will be deterrent in educating masses. A roadmap has been chalked out through which resource persons from DLSAs and AIDS control society will conduct Webinars for Panel Advocates and PLVs of all the Districts of Haryana. The expert guidance shared by the resource persons will be used to educate person at Ground level.

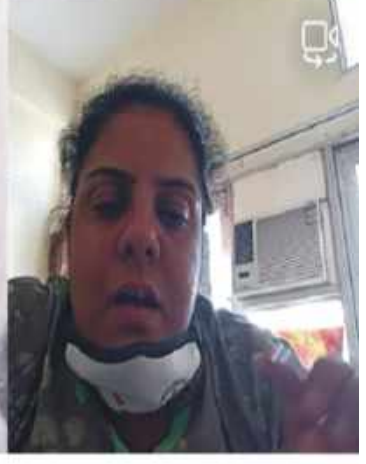

# Random Covid-19 testing

A campaign for Rapid test of COVID19 was organised by Doctors team through mobile van deputed by Civil Surgeon, Karnal in association with DLSA, Karnal on 14.09.2020 in ADR Center, Karnal.

Sampling of general public, litigants and officials of district Courts, Civil Secretariat and other departments were got collected by the doctors team randomly. In the said camp 85 persons got checked by the team of doctors out of which 05 persons were found positive.

They were also apprised about the management protocols issued by the Union Health Ministry for patients who have recovered from covid-19 and suggested the use of alternative medicinal system that includes intake of Chyawanprash, and Ayush medicines and practicing yoga asanas to boost immunity.

Recovered patients may continue to report wide variety of signs and symptoms including fatigue, body ache, cough, sore throat, difficulty in breathing, etc, it said. A holistic approach is required for follow up care and well-being of all post-covid recovering patients, the ministry said.



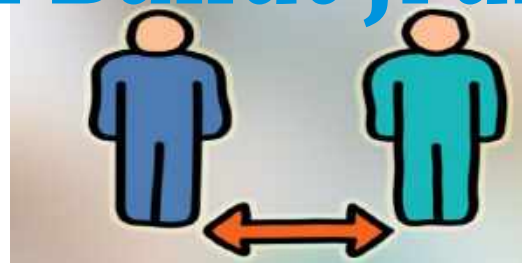

The camps were held through Virtual Platforms and a total of 441 persons benefitted from the camp

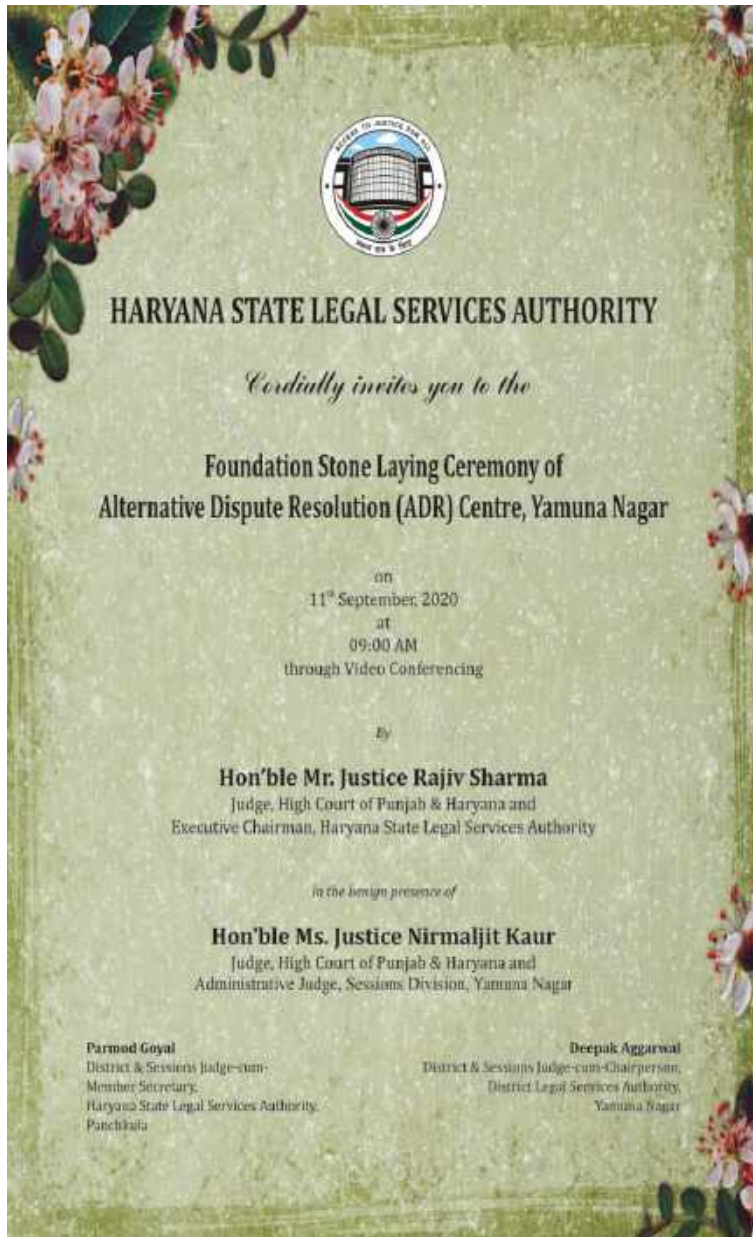

In the year 2012 Haryana State Legal Services Authority had set up its 1<sup>st</sup> District ADR Centre at District Sonapat and till date we have 13 ADR Centres set up at Ambala, Bhiwani, Fatehabad, Hisar, Jind, Jhajjar, Karnal, Kaithal, Kurukshetra, Narnaul, Rohtak, Sirsa and Sonapat. The impressive and the splendid structure of ADR Centres is being built up in 2 categories on a size of 72' X 72' and 60' X 60'. The ADR Center will house: Front Office manned by retainer and plvs, Office of District Legal Services Authority, Office of Chairman and Secretary, DLSAs, Court rooms for Permanent Lok Adalats (Public utility services), Staff room for PLA, PUS, Mediation rooms, Kidszone, Library etc.**

ADR Centre, Yamuna Nagar was inaugurated on 11 September, 2020 through Video Conferencing by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajiv Sharma Judge, High Court of Punjab & Haryana and Executive Chairman, Haryana State Legal Services Authority in the benign presence of Hon'ble Ms. Justice Nirmaljit Kaur Judge, High Court of Punjab & Haryana and Administrative Judge, Sessions Division, Yamuna Nagar. His Lordship directed PWD Officers to expedite the work for creation of class infrastructure and timely completion of project.

From businessman to the daily wage workers, everyone has suffered a lot during this pandemic and has struggled to survive it. There have been many people who have been surviving at the brink of the vessel.

On one such occasion Districts Legal Services Authority, came across 4 people (3 men and a lady) in the Labour Court :-

1. A technician named Raju Biswas s/o Munender Biswas r/o Nav Jeevan Complex, Govind Puri, Delhi working since 31.12.2002 with current salary 25045/- per month

2. A welder named Nizamuddin s/o Shahzad r/o Gaddha Colony, Naharpar, Faridabad working since 15.02.2006 with current salary 15000/- per month,

3. A Turner named Vikas Singh s/o Raghbar Singh r/o 98, Madanpur Khadar, JJ Colony, New Delhi working since 26.06.2010 with current salary 19415/- per month

4. A Helper named Geeta w/o Ravinder Paswan r/o Dayal Nagar, Faridabad working since 10.04.2016 with current salary 8000/- per month ☐ They had been working in the company, M/S Vishwakarma Enterprises at Plot No. 23, Gali No. 3, Gurukul, Industrial Area, Faridabad under the proprietorship of Mr. Anil Lamba and required legal assistance of sorts from the DLSA.

Upon hearing this, panel advocate, Ravinder Gupta, put forth the problem of all four in front of the CJM, Sh. Manglesh Kumar Choubey, who instructed him and few other panel advocates, namely Rajinder Gautam, Rambir Tanwar and Om Prakash Saini, to provide them necessary help. It was found that all four of them had been unemployed for the past 3 months. They were only called on for work for a day or two in a month and were paid like daily wage workers. The lady was also not getting her PF and ESI facility from the company. The panel advocates along with the four employees of the company went to the company and spoke to the owner and adviced the owner to give them their jobs back.

After proper counseling, the owner agreed to put them back on duty with full back wages
