Subject: Bhed/Bakri (Sheep/Goat) Palak Utthan Yojana (P-01-10-2403-51-104-86-51-N) for the year 2024-25 (N).

Memo

This scheme is proposed to be implemented in the State for the year 2024-25. The scheme in principle stands approved by the Government in the State Revenue Budget for the year 2024-25 for which an outlay of Rs. 401.00 lakh (Four Crore One Lakh rupees only). This scheme is implemented by Managing Director, HLDB. It is a non-staff scheme and will be implemented with the help of the existing staff.

1. Brief Background

Animal Husbandry is an integral part of agriculture along with a major contributor of Agricultural Gross Domestic Product and endowed with a high potential of self-employment opportunities. In present scenario, when growth rate in crop production is stagnating, it is the animal husbandry sector which holds promise for achieving higher growth rates in State Gross Domestic Product as well as providing employment to the unemployed. There exists a vast potential of self-employment generation in Animal Husbandry and Dairying sector. The establishment of Sheep and Goat units can generate substantial employment (direct or Indirect). There is well-knit infrastructure of veterinary institutions catering to the needs of the livestock owners for providing veterinary and breeding services in the State. Further, self-sufficiency in fodder production, available human resources and vicinity of National Capital Region having ample marketing opportunities makes animal husbandry activities an attractive option for self-employment to the unemployed in the State.

With a primary objective of providing self-employment opportunities, the unemployed persons would be assisted by way of establishing Sheep and Goat units. The pattern of assistance would be in the form of providing 10+1 Sheep/Goat units for SC/BPL/Widow and landless General, BC and Other Category families free of cost. Further assistance would also be provided for insurance of the livestock. In addition to this assistance for purchasing of wool from established unit would be done by the department.

All the animals of established unit will be provided deworming, vaccination and treatment free of cost by concerned Veterinary Institution (Animal Husbandry & Dairying Department).

2. Justification of the scheme:

There are 19.29 lac Cattle and 43.68 Lac Buffalo in the State as per the 2019 Livestock census. According to the livestock census 2019, about 16.62 lac families are rearing one or other type of livestock in the state out of which is approximately 20% population of livestock of Schedule caste families which is generally resource poor.

There are 2.89 lakh Sheep, 3.36 lakh goats in the state as per the 2019 livestock census. Out of total Sheep and Goat population 2.0 lac and 2.08 lac respectively is reared by Scheduled Caste families which comprised of 62 to 70% of total Sheep/Goat population. 0.89 lac Sheep and Goat 1.28 lac Goat population is reared by APL and BPL

category in Haryana State. Occupation wise, out of total Schedule Caste families 44% exclusively depends on Animal Husbandry and Agriculture and 56% on other sectors including service sectors. Out of total livestock in the state Scheduled Caste families possess 21% of the livestock. Scheduled Caste families contribute substantively in the Animal Husbandry sector and it is the major occupation these families. BPL, Widow family and landless General, BC and Other Category may also be included under scheme for their upliftment economically.

Therefore, Haryana state has a vast potential of self-employment generation in the animal husbandry sector, the establishment of Sheep and Goat units can generate substantial employment and also increase in livestock products such as milk, meat (Mutton/Chevon), wool etc.

3. Long term objectives of the Scheme:

Long term objectives of this scheme are as follows:

- i. To create self-employment opportunities through Sheep and Goat husbandry activities.
- ii. To upgrade and develop Sheep and Goat breeds/germ plasm available in the State.
- iii. To increase income generation opportunities for economically weaker segment of the society.

4. Strategies:

The beneficiary may get 11 day training for Sheep and Goat Husbandry practices which will be provided by the Department at each Sub Division in the State to the persons desirous for establishing Sheep /Goat units. A total of 572 Sheep and Goat units (286 each) would be established during the year 2024-25 which will boost milk, meat and wool production in the State and also provide gainful self-employment opportunities to 572 beneficiaries in the Animal Husbandry Sector.

5. Implementing agency of the scheme:-

Haryana Livestock Development Board (HLDB), Haryana will be the implementing agencies for this scheme in the state during year 2024-25. the scheme would implement in the entire state and would also be extended for the next year after analyzing outcomes and outputs of the scheme.

6. Roll out plan of the Scheme in terms of Commencement of Activities:-

The Department/Haryana Livestock Development Board (HLDB) would assist the beneficiaries in establishing these Sheep and Goat units in the following ways:-

- i. Imparting 11 days Sheep and Goat husbandry trainings at the concerned Sub Division/ District Level in the State of the desirous persons, if required by applicant.
- ii. Purchase of animals and issuance of Health certificate.
- iii. Providing Veterinary Health and other facilities like free vaccination and management guidance etc.

7. Financial Assistance in form of subsidy for establishment of Sheep/Goat unit under the Scheme:-

- This is a credit linked scheme. Under this scheme back end subsidy would be provided. 100% subsidy for establishment of Sheep and Goat unit of 10 Female and 1 Male would be provided to the SC/BPL/Widow families and landless General, BC and Other Category beneficiaries under scheme. Initially beneficiary has to bear purchase cost of Sheep and Goat unit by there-own for 25% of the unit cost which will be of Rs. 17500/- per unit as margin money (proof for the same should be given by beneficiary), which would be provided to beneficiary account later on as per scheme guidelines. In case of

SC/BPL/Widow category and Landless General, BC and Other Category and rest amount of subsidy i.e. 75% of unit cost would be deposited to the seller account after purchase.

- In case of Scheduled Caste/BPL/widow Category and landless General, BC, Other Category, HLDB/Government will provide financial assistance to the tune of 75 % of the unit cost (Rs. 52500/- per unit) on the establishment of livestock unit after the purchase of livestock to the seller within 15 days positively on submission of all requisite documents.
- The financial assistance of balance 25% of unit cost (Rs. 17500/- per unit) in case of SC/BPL/widow and landless General, BC and Other Category Beneficiaries would be provided by the HLDB/Government in form of subsidy to beneficiary **after two months of establishment of unit subject to verification of unit after purchase of all cases** preferably by Deputy Director concerned himself or its representative not below the rank of Sub Divisional Officer/Semen Bank Officer other than purchase committee.
- Beneficiaries shall have to purchase complete/whole Sheep/Goat unit of 10+1 in one slot and only one beneficiary per household could take the benefit of either Sheep or Goat unit under the scheme.
- The financial assistance would be provided to the account of the seller through Concerned Semen Bank officer by Managing Director, HLDB out of head of overall receipt of Milk Cess funds after verification and recommendation of unit established by Deputy Director concerned or its representative not below the rank of SDO/ SBO. The financial assistance may be delayed due to non-availability of budget or any other unforeseen circumstances.
- The beneficiary would be provided veterinary assistance facilities (Treatment, vaccination and consultancy) by concerned area veterinary institutions free of cost. Assistance for purchasing of wool from established unit would be done by the Department.

8. Financial Assistance for Insurance under the Scheme:-

If any Livestock Insurance Scheme is in operation then the insurance of animals purchased for establishment of Unit is to be covered under that Scheme wherever permissible. If no Livestock insurance Scheme is in operation then the beneficiary would have to arrange for the insurance of the animals on own and the insurance premium shall be paid by the beneficiary.

9. In case of death of Animals / Flock:-

As the whole flock will be insured and the policy holder will be concerned beneficiary. The beneficiary will be the custodians of flock. Whenever such case i.e. death of animal/animals arise, post mortem of the same will be conducted by the concerned Veterinary Surgeon and efforts will be made to settle the claim at the earliest by following the claim settlement procedure as per Insurance Scheme.

10. Eligibility Conditions for an Applicant:

- i. The beneficiary should be of 18 to 55 years of age, a resident of Haryana having Parivar Pehchaan Patra (PPP) and must not be employed even in Private Sector/ Govt. /Semi Govt. Organizations.
- ii. There would be no mandatory educational qualifications or training requirements for availing assistance under the scheme. However, preference will be given to the trained beneficiaries.
- iii. Any group/firm/organization would not be permitted to apply under the Scheme, as the Scheme being an individual beneficiary oriented.

- iv. Any applicant who has earlier availed benefit under any Departmental Scheme for establishment of Goat/Sheep unit would not be eligible for availing benefit under the Scheme.
- v. The applicant would have to upload a self-declaration in the format annexed as **Annexure-I** for being unemployed and for undertaking to abide by other conditions as required under the Scheme in form of affidavit.

Note: - In case an applicant lives at a place other than where the animals are kept or - intended to be kept. Then the jurisdiction area will be the place where animals are kept or intended to be kept (within State of Haryana only).

11. Process of submission of on-line application by the applicant:

Any un-employed person should be of 18 to 55 years of age having Parivar Pehchan Patra (PPP) desirous of establishing Sheep /Goat unit under the scheme would have to apply online on the SARAL Portal: <http://saralharyana.gov.in>. While inviting application online endeavor would be made that applicants from each area of the State can apply for establishment of Sheep /Goat units. The applicants may submit themselves on the portal or through Common Service Centers, Antodaya Kendra, Atal Sewa Kendra, e-Disha Centers or any other such center as provided by the Government from time to time. A unit would be distributed per family per household. The applicants shall also be required to upload scanned copy of following documents during submission of their online applications:-

- i. Bank Pass Book/ Cancelled Bank cheque copy of both seller and purchaser
- ii. PAN Card copy if available
- iii. Schedule caste certificate/ Below Poverty Line/Widow belonging to state (in case of SC/BPL/Widow category)
- iv. Aadhar Card
- v. Self-Declaration Certificate in form of affidavit by applicant
- vi. Training of Sheep/Goat Establishment if any
- vii. Photo of Availability of shed/space for keeping animals
- viii. Proof of landless (Agricultural land) in case of General, BC and Other Category component from concerned Patwari

12. Selection of beneficiaries for establishment of the Sheep /Goat Units:

- Once the applicant has applied online on SARAL portal the application would stand submitted to the Deputy Directors of concerned districts who would thoroughly examine the applications received on portal on **first come first serve basis** and if found not in order the same would be rejected with the comments on portal. However, if application is found in order then accepted and forwarded to the concerned Sub Divisional Officers with in a period of three working days, who will again thoroughly examine and verify with in a period of three working days, if not found in order will be returned to the Deputy Director with comments on portal.
- However, if application found in order then application would be processed for selection of suitable applicant by the following Selection committee.
 - i. Concerned Sub Divisional Officer (AH&D) / Semen Bank officer (Chairman cum Co-Nodal Officer)
 - ii. Concerned Veterinary Surgeon, Govt. Vety. Hospital (Member)
 - iii. Block Level Extension Office, Block (Member)
- The concerned Sub Divisional Officer will intimate the selection committee for meeting with date and venue for selection of applicant in format annexed as **Annexure-II** to the selection committee as well as to the applicant.
- The Quorum of the Committee meeting would be three members including Chairman of the Committee (the presence of officials as mentioned at Sr. No. i. and ii shall be

mandatory). The Committee would select suitable applicants by taking into consideration their entrepreneurship skills, attitude towards Sheep /Goat husbandry and availability of Self-contribution with the applicants. The Committee would generally adopt principle of first come first serve basis, however, if the number of applicants are more, then the Committee shall recommend their applications by prioritizing them on following parameters so that actual resource poor/needy beneficiaries are selected:-

1. Applicant belonging to Below Poverty Line of Scheduled Caste Families & Scheduled Caste Families
2. Applicant belonging to Below Poverty Line Families of other categories
3. Applicant belonging to Widow Families
4. Applicant belonging to landless General, BC and Other Category families
5. Applicant belonging to families having no member in Govt./Semi Govt. Job
6. Families having no livestock but having aptitude and housing facilities to rear Sheep and Goat.
7. Applicant having training in Sheep /Goat rearing, if any.

The proceedings of the Committee meeting would be recorded in writing duly signed by the members present in the meeting. If application of any applicant is rejected the reasons for the same would also be recorded in the proceedings. If application of any applicant found in order then accepted and forwarded to the concerned Semen Bank Officer with recommendation on portal within three working days. The exercise of Selection of beneficiaries and sending to concerned Semen Bank Officer should be completed within seven working days. Concerned Semen Bank Officer thoroughly examined the applications and if found in order transfer back application on portal to concerned Sub Divisional Officer for Purchase of Sheep/Goat Unit through Purchase Committee.

13. Purchase of Sheep/Goat Unit through Purchase Committee: -

- The concerned Sub Divisional Officer will intimate the purchase date and venue for purchase of livestock unit in format annexed as **Annexure-III** to the purchase committee as well as to the applicant.
- Keeping in view for the convenience of the beneficiaries, the venue of purchase of animals would be decided by the concerned Sub Divisional Officers/Semen Bank Officer in consultation with concerned Veterinary Surgeon and it would be either the nearest Government Veterinary Institution or any other nearest Government Institution. The Purchase Committee would have following Members and presence of all members would be mandatory at the time of purchase of Livestock Unit: -

1	Sub Divisional Officer (Animal Husbandry)/ Semen Bank Officer	(Chairman)
2	Veterinary Surgeon, Govt. Vety. Hospital	(Member)
3	Veterinary Livestock Development Assistant	(Member)

- Veterinary surgeon of the area will issue Health Certificate cum purchase receipt, as per the format annexed as **Annexure- IV** in presence of Purchase Committee and duly certified by the purchase committee.
- The approximate cost of animals would be compulsorily recorded in the Health Certificate along with other details. The concerned Veterinary Livestock Development Assistant shall be responsible for Ear-tagging of animals, assisting the beneficiary in arrangement of insurance of animals through insurance company and for maintaining complete records of units established under the scheme.

- The Chairman of the Purchase Committee i.e. concerned Sub Divisional Officer (Animal Husbandry)/Semen Bank Officer would be responsible for insurance of the animals purchased. If any Insurance Company has been empaneled by the Department/ Haryana Livestock Development Board would be done by the same Insurance Company.
- If no Livestock Insurance Scheme is in operation then the beneficiary would have to arrange for the insurance of the animals on its own and the insurance premium shall be paid by the beneficiary.
- The Chairman of Purchase committee will upload a photograph on SARAL Portal duly taken at venue of purchase having Tagged animal, Seller, Buyer and members of committee as per scheme.
- At the time of purchase of animals of Chairman of the Purchase Committee i.e. Sub Divisional officer/Semen Bank Officer would be responsible for collection of all necessary documents viz. Health Certificates cum receipt, Insurance Cover Note/Policy etc. The Sub Divisional Officer will upload all the documents on the SARAL portal after purchase for onward transmission to the concerned Semen Bank officer to initiate the process for release of subsidy as per scheme.
(Note: - No unnecessary documents other than uploaded by applicant on SARAL, Health Certificate, Insurance policy/Cover Note, Interest certificate etc. shall be collected from Beneficiary)
- Concerned Semen Bank officer would release the subsidy as per scheme after checking all the requisite documents thoroughly and send a copy of same to Managing Director, HLDB for information. The Sub Divisional Officer would send a copy of all the documents to Deputy Director for information. Final disbursement of subsidy would be done through concerned Semen Bank officer.

14. Cash Flow Requirement as per Roll out Plan:-

For the establishment of Sheep/Goat unit the Deputy Directors concerned/ or its representative not below the rank of Sub Divisional Officer would sponsor applications through Concerned Sub Divisional Officer after its scrutiny along with recommendation to Haryana Livestock Development Board. Thereafter, financial assistance would be provided by HLDB to the account of the seller/beneficiaries through Concerned Semen Bank officer as per financial assistance of the scheme.

15. Types/Sizes of Sheep /Goat Units to be established under the Scheme:

The details of financial requirement for establishing the units is given as under:-

- i. Only those breeding animals should be purchased which are ready to bred or in prime age of production.
- ii. Sexual maturity age in Female Goat / Sheep is 8-12 months. While in case of Male Goat /Sheep it is 11-12 months. So, female and male Goat and Sheep should be purchased between 12-18 months if age.

16. Description of Sheep /Goat Units for purchasing

1. Only those breeding animals should be purchased which are ready to bred or in prime age of production.
2. Age of puberty in case of female Goat and Sheep is 5-8 months and 7-9 months respectively while in male it is 6-10 months and 8-10 month respectively.
3. Sexual maturity age in case of Female Goat & Sheep is 8-12 months. While in case of Male (Buck and Ram) it is 12-15 months. So, Male and Female can be purchased accordingly.

17. Publicity of the Scheme:

Concerned Deputy Directors, Sub-Divisional Officers and Semen bank officer shall be responsible for wider publicity of the Scheme in concerned District and Sub-Division respectively. Veterinary Surgeons & Block Level Extension Officer (B.L.E.O.) shall be responsible for wider publicity of the Scheme in the concerned block. The Veterinary Surgeon/VLDA and B.L.E.O. shall identify and encourage interested unemployed Scheduled Caste/OBC/BPL/Widow persons for applying under Scheme through SARAL portal and also assisting them in application submission.

Veterinary Surgeon and Veterinary Livestock Development Assistant of the area will also be responsible for publicity of the Scheme in areas under their jurisdiction. The livestock owners would be provided information and encouraged during various Health Care Camps, Kisan Gosthies etc. for self-employment by establishing Sheep /Goat units.

Publicity and Extension Branch at the level of Headquarter shall be responsible for wider publicity and extension of the Scheme in the State through pamphlets, booklets and other extension materials.

18. Verification of Sheep /Goat Units:

The verification of the Sheep /Goat Unit to check physical existence of flock with farmers would be done by a team preferably by team comprising of Deputy Director concerned himself or its representative not below the rank of sub divisional officer/Semen bank officer and Veterinary Surgeon other than purchase committee. Veterinary Surgeon and VLDA of concerned Institution would assist the team. This verification will be done after two months from establishment of the unit for the purpose of disbursement of final financial assistance and further verification will also be done after every six month up-to two years and further reporting to Managing Director, HLDB for final disbursement financial assistance with copy to Director General, Animal Husbandry & Dairying Department Haryana through Deputy Director concerned.

Software related work viz. API generation, uploading of scheme on Saral Haryana portal etc. will be done by IT cell, Department.

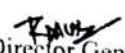
20. Timeline of implementation of program and target date of completion.

SCHEME OF 'POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP' FOR STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE MINORITY COMMUNITIES

1. BACKGROUND

The Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities was announced in June, 2006. It provides that a post-matric scholarship scheme for meritorious students from minority communities would be implemented.

2. OBJECTIVE

The objective of the scheme is to award scholarships to meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority community so as to provide them better opportunities for higher education, increase their rate of attainment in higher education and enhance their employability.

3. SCOPE

The scholarship is to be awarded for studies in India in a government or private higher secondary school/college/university, including such residential institutes of the Government and eligible private institutes selected and notified in a transparent manner by the State Government/Union Territory Administration concerned. It will also cover technical and vocational courses in Industrial Training Institutes/ Industrial Training Centres affiliated with the National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) of classes XI and XII level.

4. ELIGIBILITY

Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardian from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh.

5. DISTRIBUTION

Muslim, Christian, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain and Zoroastrians (Parsis) have been notified as minority communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992. The distribution of scholarship among the States/Union Territories will be made on the basis of population of the above notified minorities in the States/ Union Territories of Census 2001.

6. EARMARKING FOR GIRL STUDENTS

30% of scholarship will be earmarked for girl students. In case sufficient number of eligible girl students are not available, then the balance earmarked scholarships may be awarded to eligible boy students.

7. SELECTION PROCEDURE

Unlike scholarship for SC and ST, there are a fixed number of scholarships for minorities is small and limited. Students from BPL families, having the lowest income shall be given preference in the ascending order. The renewal applications would be fully exhausted before the new applications are considered.

8. DURATION

Scholarship will be provided for the entire course. However, maintenance allowance will be given for a period not exceeding 10 months only in an academic year.

9. RATE OF SCHOLARSHIP

Actual financial assistance will be provided for admission & course /tuition fee and maintenance allowance as given below subject to a maximum ceiling indicated against item concerned:

10. IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES

The scheme will be implemented through the State Government/ Union Territory Administration.

11. CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- (i) Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardian from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh. Unlike scholarship for SC and ST, there are a fixed number of scholarships for minorities and hence preference for selection has been laid down. Students from BPL families, having the lowest income shall be given preference in the ascending order. The renewal applications would be fully exhausted before the new applications are considered.
- (ii) The award will be discontinued if a student fails to secure 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination. Scholarship will not be awarded for more than the normal period of time taken to obtain Certificate/Degree/M. Phil Degree/Doctorate Degree.
- (iii) Scholarships will not be given to more than two students in a family.
- (iv) The students should be regular in attendance for which the yardstick will be decided by the competent authority of the school/college/university.
- (v) Migration of students from one Institution to another would not normally be allowed during the course of the academic year except under exceptional circumstances and in the interest of the student's academic career.
- (vi) If a student violates any other term and condition of the scholarship, the scholarship may be suspended or cancelled. The State Government/Union Territory Administration can also directly cancel the award if duly satisfied of the reasons of violation of these regulations governing the scheme.
- (vii) If a student is found to have obtained a scholarship by false statement/certificates, his/her scholarship will be cancelled forthwith and the amount of the scholarship paid shall be recovered, at the discretion of the concerned State Government/Union Territory Administration.
- (viii) Course fee/tuition fee and maintenance allowance will be credited directly to the students' bank account.
- (ix) The State Government/Union Territory Administration will maintain a separate account and records relating to the funds received from the Ministry and they will be subjected to inspection by the officers of the Ministry or any other agency designated by the Ministry.
- (x) The student obtaining benefits under this scholarship scheme shall not be allowed to avail of benefits under any other scholarship scheme implemented by State Government/UT Administration, for the same purpose.
- (xi) The State Government/ Union Territory Administration shall constitute a Committee of the departments implementing such scholarship schemes to ensure that the students from the minority community, who may also belong to SC/ST/OBC category, does not avail scholarship from other sources for the same purpose and avail only from one source.

- (xii) The fund for distribution of scholarships in subsequent years will be released after receiving the utilization certificate for the previous year.
- (xiii) The scheme will be evaluated at regular intervals by the Ministry or any other agency designated by the Ministry and the cost of the evaluation study will be borne by the Ministry under the provision of the scheme.
- (xiv) The State/Union Territory shall place all relevant details of financial and physical achievements on their website.
- (xv) The regulations can be changed at any time at the discretion of the Government of India.
- (xvi) The concerned State Government/Union Territory Administration will be responsible for processing and scrutinizing the applications submitted by the students (as per the work flow opted) and send the proposal of eligible students online to this Ministry for sanction of the scholarships as per timelines.

12. ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES

As the magnitude of data to be entered and processed would be enormous as the scheme gets implemented over the years, there would be a need to engage qualified skilled personnel right from the beginning to ensure that the data based computerised systems are operational. Qualified skilled personnel possessing requisite expertise to operate computer programme designed for this purpose, enter, process, analyse, monitor, retrieve and transfer data should be engaged on contract basis as per need. Data provided by the States/Union Territories will be maintained and managed by the Ministry with personnel of similar expertise to be engaged on contract basis.

A provision not exceeding 2% of the total budget will be made to meet the administrative and allied costs viz. expenditure of the States/Union Territories and the Ministry for office equipments including computers and accessories, furniture, printing of application forms, advertisements, engagement of personnel, etc. This provision will also be used for evaluation and monitoring of the scheme, through outside reputed institutions/agencies engaged by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India and the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations.

13. RENEWAL OF SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship, once awarded, may be renewed during the next academic year of the course on the production of certificate that the student has secured 50% marks in the examination.

14. ANNOUNCEMENT OF SCHEME

The scheme will be announced by the concerned State Government/Union Territory Administration well in time, through advertisements in the leading language newspapers and local dailies and by using other suitable publicity media.

16. PATTERN OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

100% funding will be given by the Central Government to the State Government/Union Territory Administration.

17. MONITORING & TRANSPARENCY

The States/Union Territories implementing the scheme shall monitor the financial and physical performance of the scheme at the State/Union Territory level. For this purpose, an IT enabled monitoring mechanism shall be in place. The State/Union Territory will be required to furnish quarterly financial and physical progress reports to the Ministry. The State/Union Territory shall maintain year-wise details of the students receiving scholarship, indicating school/college/institute, location of school/college/institute, government or private, class, gender and new or renewal. The States/Union Territories shall place relevant physical and financial details in their official website.

18. EVALUATION

The monitoring of the financial and physical performance of the scheme will be evaluated by assigning evaluation/impact studies to reputed institutions/agencies by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India.

19. PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING

(i) The scheme is implemented through National Scholarship Portal (NSP). It is mandatory for all students to apply online on the website of this Ministry i.e. www.scholarships.gov.in.

(ii) The list of documents to be scanned & uploaded for both Fresh and Renewal Scholarships as under:

- a) Student Photo. (Mandatory).
- b) Institution Verification Form. (Mandatory).
- c) Self declaration of Income Certificate by the student. (Mandatory).
- d) Self declaration of community by the student. (Mandatory).
- e) In case of Fresh: Self Attested Certificate of 'Previous Academic Mark sheet' as filled in Form. (Mandatory).
- f) In case of Renewal: Self-Attested Certificate of Previous Year Marksheet as filled in the Form. (Mandatory).
- g) Fee Receipt of current course year. (Mandatory).
- h) Proof of Bank Account in the name of student. (Mandatory).
- i) Aadhaar Card (optional).
- j) Residential Certificate. (Mandatory).

Guidelines of Dr. Ambedkar Central Sector Scheme of Interest Subsidy on Educational Loans for Overseas Studies for Other Backward Classes (OBCs) and Economically Backward Classes (EBCs)

(With effect from 01.10.2017)

1. Background

The scheme of Interest Subsidy on educational loans for overseas studies will promote educational advancement of students from Other Backward Classes and Economically Backward Classes.

2. Objective

The objective of the scheme is to award interest subsidy to meritorious students belonging to the Other Backward Classes and Economically Backward Classes so as to provide them better opportunities for higher education abroad and enhance their employability.

3. Scope

This is a Central Sector Scheme to provide interest subsidy to the student belonging to the OBCs and EBCs on the interest payable for the period of moratorium for the Education Loans for overseas studies to pursue approved courses of studies abroad at Masters, M.Phil. and Ph.D. level.

4. Conditions for Interest Subsidy

- i. The Scheme is applicable for higher studies abroad. The interest Subsidy shall be linked with the existing Educational Loan Scheme of Indian Banks Association (IBA) and restricted to students enrolled for course at Masters, M.Phil and Ph.D level.
- ii. The interest subsidy under the scheme shall be available to the eligible students only once, either for Masters or Ph.D levels. Interest subsidy shall not be available to those students who either discontinued the course mid-stream due to any reason, or those who are expelled from the institutions on disciplinary or academic grounds.
- iii. If a student violates any condition of the scheme, the subsidy will be discontinued forthwith.
- iv. If a student is found to have obtained the subsidy by false statement/certificates, the subsidy will be withdrawn/ cancelled forthwith and amount of the subsidy paid shall be recovered with penal interest, apart from taking criminal action as per law.
- v. The students obtaining benefits under this Scheme shall not be given the interest subsidy if he gives up Indian citizenship during the tenure of the loan.
- vi. The nodal bank will maintain a separate account and records relating to the funds received from the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and these will be subject to inspection/audit by the officers of the Ministry, or any other agency designated by the Ministry and C&AG.
- vii. The Nodal Bank shall place all relevant details of financial and physical achievements on its website and implement the scheme as per the Memorandum of understanding to be signed between the designated Banks and the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.
- viii. The Nodal Bank will lay down the detailed procedure for processing and sanctioning of interest subsidy to eligible students in consultation with the Ministry.

- ix. The Scheme will be evaluated at regular intervals by the Ministry or any other agency designated by the Ministry and the cost of the evaluation study will be borne by the Ministry.
- x. The term and conditions of the Scheme can be changed at any time at the discretion of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment to improve procedure and achieve more effective implementation. However, there should not be financial implications.
- xi. The scheme be available on preferential basis for the professional courses first.

5. Eligibility

- i. The students should have secured admission in the approved courses at Masters, M.Phil or Ph.D levels abroad for the courses listed at Para14.
- ii. He/She should have availed loan from a scheduled bank under the Education Loan Scheme of the Indian Banks Association (IBA) for the purpose.
- iii. For the candidate applying under the OBC category, OBC Caste certificate in the prescribed Performa (as per Annexure) issued by the competent authority must be taken by the Banks.

6. Income Ceiling

- i. For OBC candidates, total income from all sources of the employed candidate or his/her parents/guardians in case of unemployed candidate shall not exceed present Creamy Layer criteria.
- ii. For EBC candidates, total income from all sources of the employed candidate or his/her parents/guardians in case of unemployed candidate shall not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh per annum.
- iii. Under this Scheme, Income certificate produced by the student for availing Educational Loan viz. ITR/Form 16/Audited Accounts/Income certificate issued by the authority of State Government/UT Administration is acceptable to determining Income ceiling.

7. Recommendatory Committee

- i. Recommendatory Committee headed by Joint Secretary in-charge of Backward Classes Division with representatives of Finance Division, representative of Nodal Bank and concerned Director/Deputy Secretary as convener will examine and recommend the applications for award of interest subsidy on quarterly basis.
- ii. Out of the total outlay in a year, a minimum of 50% amount will be earmarked for Interest Subsidy to the girl candidates.

8. 'FUNDS-LIMITED' Nature of the Scheme

Due to budgetary constraint, in practice, it has not been possible for the Central Government to provide assistance for giving subsidy on interest to all eligible students. The funds will be released to the applicants on first- come first-served basis, subject to a maximum amount to be worked out every year based on total budget made available that year, under the scheme. At the beginning of the each financial year, region-wise notional allocation of funds should be made by the Ministry.

9. Rate of Interest Subsidy

- i. Under the scheme, interest payable by the students availing the education loans of the IBA for the period of moratorium (i.e. course period, plus one year or six months after getting job, whichever is earlier) as prescribed under the Education Loan Scheme of the IBA, shall be borne by the Government of India.
- ii. After the period of moratorium is over, the interest on the outstanding loan amount shall be paid by the student, in accordance with the existing Educational Loan Scheme as may be amended from time to time.
- iii. The candidate will bear the Principal installments and interest beyond moratorium period.

10. Implementing Agencies

The Scheme will be implemented by the Nodal Bank as per MoU between the Banks and the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment.

11. Administrative Expenses

- i. A provision not exceeding 2% of the annual budget allocation for the scheme will be made to meet the administrative and allied costs viz. expenditure for office equipments, including computers and accessories, advertisements, engagement of personnel, third party evaluation etc.
- ii. This provision will also be used for evaluation and monitoring of the scheme, through outside reputed institutions/agencies engaged by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India. Administrative cost of the Banks will be shared as per provision in the MoU.

12. Monitoring and Transparency

- i. The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment shall monitor the performance of the scheme.
- ii. For this purpose, a web enabled monitoring mechanism shall be put in place by Nodal Bank.
- iii. The Nodal Bank will be required to furnish quarterly financial and physical progress reports to the Ministry.
- iv. The Nodal Bank will maintain year-wise details of the students receiving interest subsidy, indicating institute, location of the institute, course, gender, new or renewal, permanent address and parents address.
- v. The Nodal Bank will place relevant physical and financial details on their official website.

13. Minor Modifications/Changes

Minor Modifications/Changes in the Scheme with no financial implications may be made by the Competent Authority.

14. Evaluation

The monitoring of the financial and physical performance of the scheme will be periodically evaluated by the assigning evaluation/impact studies to reputed institutions/agencies by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q-1. Are the candidates included in the State/UT List are eligible for interest subsidy under the scheme?

Ans. Applicants belonging to OBC category means, those whose communities/castes are included in the Central list of OBCs. Hence, respective state lists/UT lists will not be followed for this scheme. The Central List (state-wise/UT-wise) is available in the National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC) website (www.ncbc.nic.in).

Q-2. If any student has availed Education Loan subsidy under CSIS OR New CSIS scheme for under graduate Or Graduate courses, whether he/she will be eligible for Subsidy under proposed Dr. Ambedkar Central Sector Scheme of Interest Subsidy.

Ans. The benefits under the scheme is available for:

- a. Studies abroad
- b. Courses leading to Masters (i.e. Post-Graduation, including PG Diploma), M.Phil and Ph.D.
- c. One time only (and not allowed even if similar benefit has been availed under different scheme).

Q-3. What is meaning of Economically Backward Classes?

Ans. Applicants belonging to EBC (Economically Backward Classes) category means, those whose communities/castes are not included in SC/ST/OBC categories, and whose annual income does not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh.

Q-4. What is meaning of moratorium period?

Ans. As per the scheme guidelines, the meaning of Moratorium period is, course period plus one year, OR course period plus six months after getting the job, whichever is earlier.

Q-5. If the moratorium period is increased at the request of the student/borrower on genuine reasons, in such cases, whether the subsidy can also be provided for the extended period of moratorium?

Ans. If the moratorium period is extended with the approval of the competent authority, subsidy can be provided during that period, subject to the condition that, fees are paid during the extended period of Moratorium.

Q-6. In case of employed candidate, whether Income of employed candidate & his/her parents/guardians income to be clubbed for deciding income criteria eligibility for the proposed subsidy scheme?

Ans. Parental income for eligibility will be considered only when the student is unemployed or the student is employed but on sabbatical (not receiving salary).

Q-7. What are the documents acceptable for income certification under the scheme?

Ans. For Income Certification, the certificate produced by the student for availing Educational Loan viz. ITR/Form 16/Audited Accounts/Income certificate issued by the authority of State Government/UT Administration is acceptable under the scheme.

Q-8. In case of employed candidate, whether income of employed candidate & his/her parents/guardians income to be clubbed for deciding income criteria eligibility for the proposed subsidy scheme.

Ans. Parental income for eligibility will be considered only when the student is unemployed or the student is employed but on sabbatical (not receiving salary).

Q-9. Whether income level at the time of sanctioning of loan only to be considered (OR) whether subsequent increase/decrease in parental income level will affect the eligibility of the student under the scheme?

Ans. Income certificate submitted during loan application shall be treated as proof of annual income. Subsequent increase /decrease will have no effect on the eligibility.

Q-10. Is there any reservation for girls students under the scheme?

Ans. As per the guidelines, a minimum of 50% of the total allocation under the scheme every year shall be reserved for female students. However, in case of non-availability of adequate demands from female students, same can be utilised for male students.

Q-11. What would be the amount of eligible loan component admissible for interest subsidy?

Ans. For a student, the eligible loan component shall be the actual loan taken subject to a maximum of Rs.20.00 lakh for purpose of Interest subsidy claim.

Q-12. As per guidelines, who are meritorious students?

Ans. Meaning of Meritorious students under the scheme means, those who have already taken admission in the accredited Universities/Institutions abroad, subject to fulfilment of other eligibility and conditions. However, due to the funds-limited nature of the scheme, while selecting beneficiaries under the scheme, priority will be given to those students who have completed their qualifying education in a Government University/Institution before taking admission abroad.

Q-13. Will a student pursuing a course which is partly in India and partly abroad, be eligible for interest subsidy?

Ans. If the course pursued by the student is partly in India and partly abroad, the course will be eligible for interest subsidy, if the Degree is awarded by Foreign University.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO NON-SCHOOL GOING DISABLED CHILDREN (< 18 YEARS)

Under this scheme mentally retarded and multiple disabled children who are in the age group of 0-18 years who are not able to attend formal education, training etc. due to their disability is given financial aid. They are totally dependent on their parents and relatives and need constant supervision and care of their families. Financial Assistance shall be admissible under the scheme to every such disabled child in the family of the applicant.

Rate of Allowance: ₹ 1,200 per month (w.e.f 01-11-2017)

Eligibility Criteria:

- i.) Domicile of Haryana.
- ii.) Mentally retarded children with IQ <50 or 70% disability or above
- iii.) With cerebral palsy, autism, multiple disability of 70% or more.
- iv.) Orthopaedic disability of 100%.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO DESTITUTE CHILDREN SCHEME (FADC)

This is a State Scheme under which parents/guardians of the children upto the age of 21 years who are deprived of proper care because of the death or long imprisonment of their parents, long illness or mental retardation, are paid financial assistance subject to the maximum for two children of one family as per eligibility criteria laid down in the scheme.

Rate of Allowance: ₹ 900 per month per child subject to the maximum for two children of one family (w.e.f 01-11-2017).

Eligibility Criteria:

- i.) Child under twenty-one years of age who has been deprived of parental support or care by reason of death, continued absence from the home of his father for the last 2 years, or father/mother has been sentenced imprisonment for a period not less than one year or physical or mental incapacity of a parent.
- ii.) Income of parents/guardians should not exceed ₹ 2,00,000 per annum;
- iii.) Benefit up to two children of a family only

ALLOWANCE TO EUNUCHS

Eunuchs who are living in various parts of the State, should not be less than 18 years and provide certificate from the Civil Surgeon in support of being an Eunuch.

Rate of Allowance: ₹ 1,800 per month (w.e.f 01-11-2017)

Eligibility Criteria

डा0 बी0 आर0 अम्बेडकर मेधावी छात्रवृत्ति योजना के तहत जिला करनाल में वर्ष 2024-25 में अलॉट बजट 3 करोड़ में से अब तक कुल 2,99,93,000/- रुपये खर्च किया जा चुका है। जिसमें 3596 छात्रों को स्कीम का लाभ दिया गया है।

4. अत्याचार निवारण स्कीम (SC/ST Act 1989)

इस विभाग द्वारा एक्ट के अधीन गैर अनुसूचित जातियों के लोगों के अत्याचारों से पीड़ित अनु0जाति के लोगों को आर्थिक सहायता प्रदान की जाती है। प्रार्थी गैर अनु0जाति के व्यक्तियों के अत्याचारों जैसे भूमि का अनाधिकृत कब्जा, कत्ल, डकैती, बलात्कार व नर संहार से पीड़ित हो तथा इसकी सम्बन्धित थाने में अनु0जाति/जन जाति (अत्याचार निवारण अधिनियम) 1989

के अन्तर्गत एफ0आई0आर0 दर्ज हो तथा ऑनलाईन आवेदन एफ0आई0आर0, मैडीकल रिपोर्ट, बैंक खाता, आधार कार्ड आदि दस्तावेज www.saralharyana.gov.in पर ऑनलाईन किये जाने चाहिए। विभिन्न प्रकार के अत्याचार होने पर अनु0जाति के व्यक्तियों को 85,000-रु0 से 8,25,000 /-रु0 तक की आर्थिक सहायता प्रदान की जाती है।

अत्याचार निवारण स्कीम (SC/ST Act 1989) के तहत जिला करनाल में वर्ष 2024-25 में अलॉट बजट 59,23,542 रु0 में से अब तक कुल 58,43,750/- रुपये खर्च किया जा चुका है। जिसमें 46 पीड़ितों को स्कीम का लाभ दिया गया है।

5. कानूनी सहायता (नागरिक अधिकार संरक्षण अधिनियम, 1955) :-

अनुसूचित जाति के व्यक्तियों को नागरिक अधिकार संरक्षण अधिनियम 1955 के अंतर्गत दर्ज मुकदमों, भूमिपतियों द्वारा अत्याचार और भूमि से बेदखली, रास्तों का प्रयोग न करने देने सीरी/सांझी का हिस्सा न देने तथा आरक्षण आदि के मुकदमों में पैरवी के लिए 22000 रु0 की कानूनी सहायता दी जाती है। आवेदनकर्त्ता को स्कीम अनुसार आवश्यक दस्तावेजों सहित www.saralharyana.gov.in पर ऑनलाईन आवेदन करना होगा।

6. डिबेट एवं सेमीनार :-

उक्त स्कीम के तहत अस्पृश्यता – एक अभिशाप पर स्कूलों/कॉलेजों में भाषण एवं लेखन प्रतियोगिता का आयोजन करवाया जाता है।

7. पंचायत प्रोत्साहन योजना :-

उक्त स्कीम के अनुसूचित जाति के कल्याण हेतु सराहनीय कार्य तथा स्वच्छ भारत अभियान में भागीदारी करने वाली पंचायतों को प्रोत्साहन स्वरूप यह राशि प्रदान की जाती है।

8. अनुसूचित जाति व पिछड़े वर्ग से संबंधित संस्थाओं व समितियों हेतु वित्तीय सहायता :-

अनुसूचित जाति व पिछड़े वर्ग से संबंधित संस्थान/सोसाइटी को आर्थिक सहायता स्कीम के अन्तर्गत उन सामुदायिक भवनों में जो सामाजिक व शैक्षणिक उद्देश्य के लिए प्रयोग किये जाने हैं। उनके नये भवन निर्माण, भवन को पूर्ण करने, मरम्मत करवाने, टी0वी0 व अन्य उपकरण खरीदने तथा पुस्तकालय में पढ़ने की पुस्तकें तथा शिक्षा सम्बंधी सामान खरीदने हेतु 2.00 लाख रु0 की आर्थिक सहायता देने का प्रावधान है।
