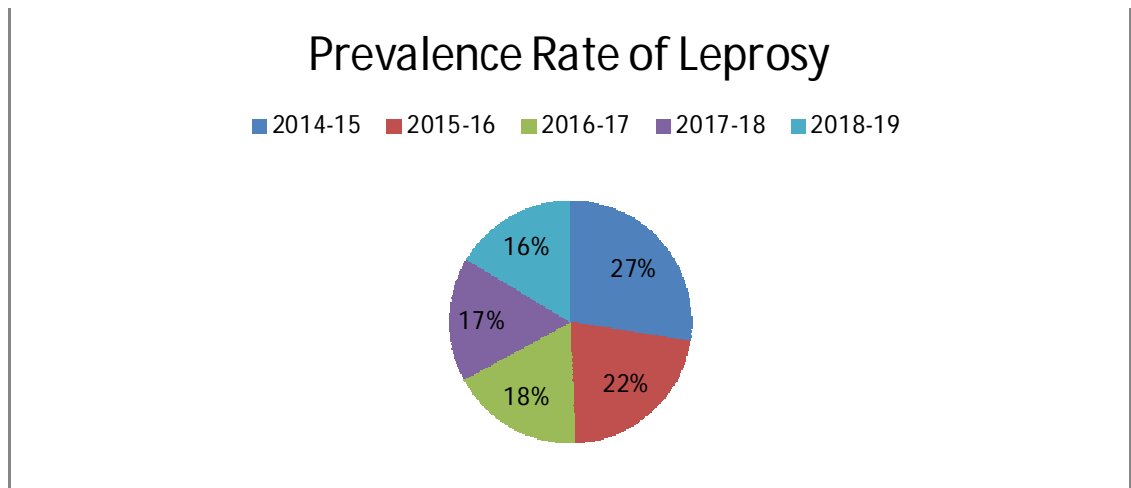


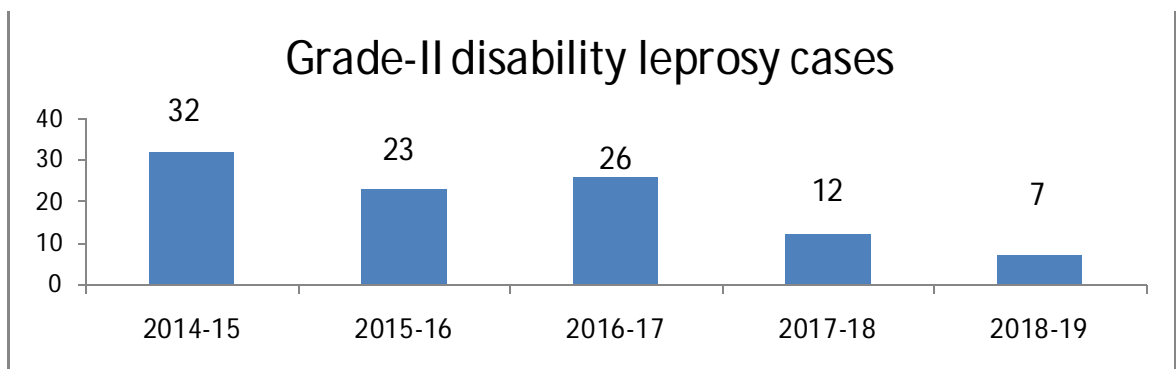
National Leprosy Eradication Programme

Ø Performance of Haryana under NLEP

- The State of Haryana has already achieved the status of “Elimination of Leprosy” i.e. less than 1 case per 10,000 of population fixed by WHO.
- Presently 440 leprosy cases are under treatment in Haryana.
- Prevalence Rate (PR) per 10000 population of leprosy in Haryana has decreased from 0.25 in 2014-15 to 0.15 as on 2018-19.



- Number of grade-II disability leprosy cases reduced from 32 in 2014-15 to 7 in 2018-19.



State has initiated focused action in mission mode towards eradication of leprosy in the State. The following activities/innovations are being conducted in the State:-

1. Leprosy Case Detection Campaign is conducted in high prevalence district/where numbers of grade-II cases are more.
2. Urban leprosy Control Programme in non LCDC districts.
3. Regular Focused Leprosy Campaign is done in hot spot areas of Grade-II disability and child leprosy cases.
4. ASHA based surveillance of leprosy suspects (ABSULS) in rural areas has been started.
5. Post Exposure of Prophylaxis (PEP) with single dose of rifampicin to contacts of leprosy patients has been implemented.
6. Sparsh Leprosy Awareness Campaign (SLAC) to generate awareness and remove stigma and discrimination of leprosy.
7. Regular screening of school children for leprosy through RBSK is being done.
8. Screening of slum population through National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) centers is being done.
