Minutes of 99th Executive Council meeting of NILD, Kolkata held on 18th June, 2019 in the Conference Room of Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities at New Delhi.

99th EC meeting of NILD, Kolkata was held on 18thJune, 2019 at 3 p.m. under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary and Chairman EC-NILD at Dept. of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, New Delhi.

Director welcomed the Chairperson and Members and with the permission of Chair point wise discussion on the agenda was taken up.

99.01 Confirmation of the Minutes of the 98th Meeting of EC.

Decision: It was informed to the EC that the minutes of the 98th Meeting of Executive Council of NILD, Kolkata, held on 20th August, 2018 in the Conference room of Dept. of EPwD, at New Delhi, were circulated to the Members vide letter no-NILD/98th EC/Dir/45(2) dated 03.9.2018. It was also reported that no comments have been received on the minutes. Accordingly, the minutes were confirmed.

99.02. Action Taken Report on the decisions taken in 98th meeting of EC held on 20.8.2018

Decision: Actions taken on the decisions taken in the 98th meeting of the EC were noted with the directions that with regard to item no. 98.11, reminder letter may be sent to the Director, Social Welfare, Govt. of Tripura. Director, CRC-Tripura will follow up the letter.

99.03 To consider the proposal for 5% annual enhancement of remuneration of contractual employees of NILD, Kolkata along with the RCs & CRCs under administrative control of NILD as recommended in the meeting dated 3.10.2018 under the chairmanship of Secretary.

Decision: The agenda was deferred.

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99.04 To consider the proposal for ratification of Administrative and Financial powers of Director, NILD at par with the Director, NIEPMD as recommended in the meeting dated 3.10.2018 under the Chairmanship of Secretary.

Decision: EC felt that the matter needs to be examined in consultation with the Ministry and accordingly deferred the agenda.

99.05 To consider the estimated budget as submitted by CPWD for construction of building for setting up Regional Centre for NILD in Dehradun, Uttarakhand in the premises of NIEPVD.

Decision: EC decided to defer the agenda due to non availability of adequate budget provision.

99.06 To consider the proposal for providing the Medical reimbursement facilities to Retired Employees of the Institute on CGHS rates:

Decision: EC decided to defer the proposal and directed to continue with the existing practice of admissible Fixed Medical Allowance as per CS (MA) Rules.

99.07 To consider the proposal of one additional contractual staff at Accounts Department on consolidated amount.

Decision: EC did not approve the proposal.

99.08 To consider the proposal for Recruitment of Law Consultant on contract basis.

Decision: EC considered the proposal and approved for engaging the services of a legal consultant initially for 06 (six) months and directed that the proposal may be placed before EC for prior review before further continuation beyond 06 months.

99.09 To consider the proposal to re-constitute the New Academic Committee.

Decision: EC considered the proposal to reconstitute the Academic Committee and approved the same

99.10 To consider the enhancement of the quantum of leave for all contractual engagement of NILD Kolkata.

Decision: EC did not approve the proposal and rejected the same.

99.11 To consider the proposal for grant of one special increment at the time of regular promotion

Decision: EC noted that the proposal is not in accordance with extant rules and, accordingly, did not approve the proposal and rejected the same.

99.12 To consider the proposal for amendment of existing Recruitment Rules for the post of Deputy Director (Administration).

Decision: EC considered the proposal and desired that the proposed RRs may be referred to the Ministry as per modified format of RRs and be brought before EC for further consideration with comments of the Ministry.

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99.13 To consider purchase of "Digital Arm Trainer" on the basis of single bid received even after recurring tender

Decision: EC considered the proposal and deferred the same with the directions that it may be ascertained whether the equipment is a proprietary item, and, if so, the same may be submitted with Proprietary Certificate to the EC in its next meeting for further consideration.

99.14 To consider the escalated price amount of Rs.3,25,720/- than the approved budget for Full Auto Analyser for Pathology unit.

Decision: EC considered the proposal and approved the additional amount of Rs3.25.720/- (Three Lakh Twenty Five Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty only) for procurement of Full Auto Analyser for Pathology unit.

99.15 To consider the proposal to engage one X-Ray Technician on Contract (part time) on consolidated amount.

Decision: EC considered the proposal and approved engagement of one X-ray technician on contract basis @ monthly consolidated honorarium of Rs. 12,000/- initially for a period of 06 (six) months. EC further directed that the performance with report on increase in number of daily X-Ray may be submitted to the EC before expiry of 06 months for review and decision regarding further centinuation.

99.16 To consider the proposal for renovation of 9 (nine) nos of toilet blocks of the main Institute building of NILD, Kolkata under Swachata Action Plan (SAP).

Decision: EC considered the proposal and approved the same within the sanctioned fund under Swachata Action Plan with further advice to take up the work in a phased manner.

99.17 To consider the proposal for engagement of agency for providing 08 seater office vehicle on regular hired basis, on yearly contract.

Decision: EC did not approve the proposal for hiring 08 seater vehicle on regular basis and further directed to utilize need based services of existing App based Cab Services like Local Taxi, Ola, Uber etc.

99.18 To consider the proposal for procurement of 01 nos. of Ambulance for the patient services at NILD, Kolkata in emergency situation.

Decision: EC considered the proposal and approved hiring of one Ambulance through GeM only for a period of one year. EC also advised that efforts may be made for getting CSR funds/support for procuring an Ambulance.

99.19 To consider the proposal for approval of work for Accessibility provision for Disabled persons at Institute building for NILD, Bonhooghly, Kolkata

Decision: EC considered the proposal and approved the same subject to availability of funds from Accessible India Campaign of the Ministry.

1. NORTH EAST DISABILITY SUBMIT

It was informed to the EC that in a meeting held on 09.05.2019 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, DEPwD, it was decided that a North East Disability summit will be held on 12-13th July, 2019 in the campus of the Guwahati University in collaboration with Healthy India Chronicle. The motto of the event is to create awareness amongst all stakeholders including students, academicians, administrators; disability organization etc. in the North East Region about the provisions of RPwD Act, 2016, initiatives taken by the Govt, for the Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, schemes and programs meant for PwDs etc. It was also decided that all concerned like Ministries/Departments, the National Institutes and other Organizations of the department may consider supporting the summit. The approximate financial implication for participating in the event will be Rs.5.00 Lakh to be paid to the Health India Chronicle.

Decision: EC considered the proposal and approved funding of Rs. 5 lakh to be met from GIA-North East Funds.

Proposal to approve the Recruitment Rules for the posts in Prosthetic and Orthotics Department

Decision: EC directed to modify the RRs as per revised format after taking into consideration the comments/recommendations of the Ministry and thereafter to place the matter before EC for further consideration and approval.

3. Proposal to approve the Recruitment Rules for the post of Director

Decision: EC considered and approved the Recruitment Rules for the post of Director as per the Schedule enclosed to the minutes.

4. <u>Issue raised by one EC member regarding the missing pages in the file related to Electricity theft</u>

An issue regarding the missing pages in the file related to Electricity theft alleged against Dr. Mrs. Sarbari Sen, Lecturer and HOD Dept. of SRE and In charge Girls Hostel (now retired due to superannuation) was raised by a member of the EC.

Decision: EC instructed to reconstruct the file related to this issue and place the updated status in the matter before the next EC.
