CHAPTER-III

RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

The research and development unit conducted research projects in collaboration with Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO & coordinated with other departments of the institute to undertake rehabilitation research and JRF/SRF scholarship program. The details of the project and research works conducted or initiated during the year are appended below.

Ongoing research projects (Total: 03):

1. Project Title: Design, development and standardization of microprocessor controlled prosthetic knee joint and prosthetic multi axial foot piece for lower limb amputee (ISRO-NILD project).
2. Project title: Development and comparison of organic /inorganic fibre reinforced polymer nano-composite prosthetics for low cost advance running blades
Outcomes: Fabricated carbon fibre based runner blade for comparison and final prototype testing
3. Project Title: Quantification and analysis of Pathological Gait in persons with locomotor disabilities using soft computing tools and instrumented gait analyzer (Low Cost Pressure Sensor based Gait Mat, Force plate, EMG, Electro-goniometer and Metabolic analyzer).
Outcome: Database of PwDs 700 subjects Gait parameter stored, under process of Analysis and clinical correlation

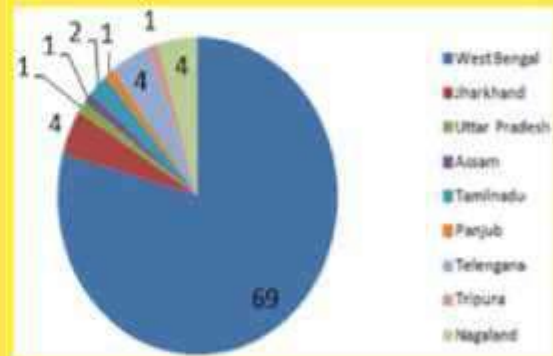
CHAPTER-V

EXTENSION AND OUTREACH SERVICE

Outreach Services unit conducts assessment, Identification and distribution camps for the Persons with disabilities under Govt. of India Scheme of Assistance to the Persons with Disabilities for purchase/fitting of Aids/Appliances (ADIP Scheme) and organizes sensitization program on disability and rehabilitation in different areas for the community stake holders. During the year 2019-2020 camps were conducted under ADIP scheme in West Bengal, Jharkhand, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamilnadu, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, Assam, Tripura and Nagaland, total 3727 numbers of PWDs were benefitted by receiving 5381 numbers of Aids and Appliances through these camps.

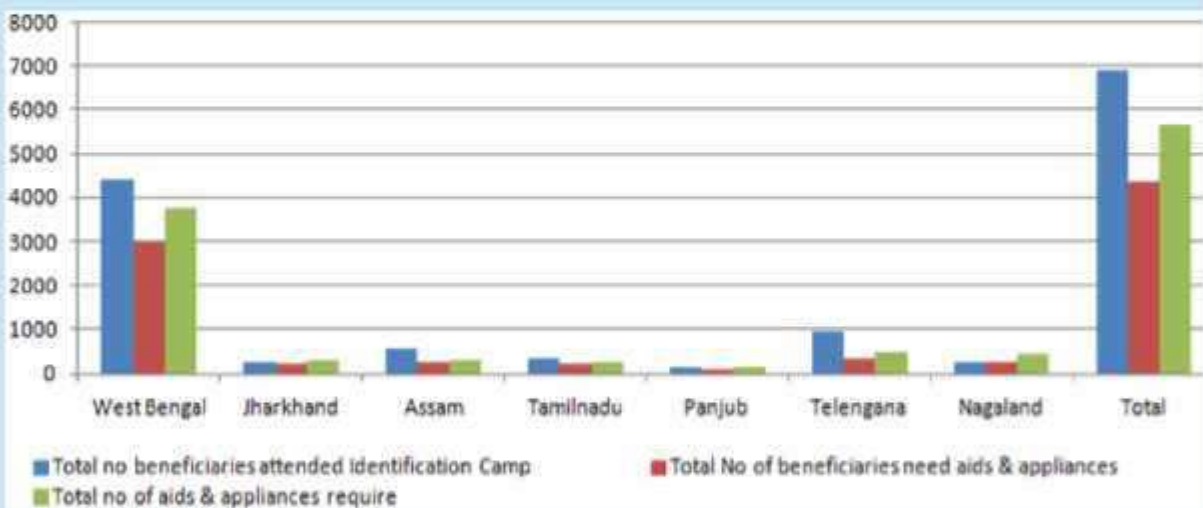

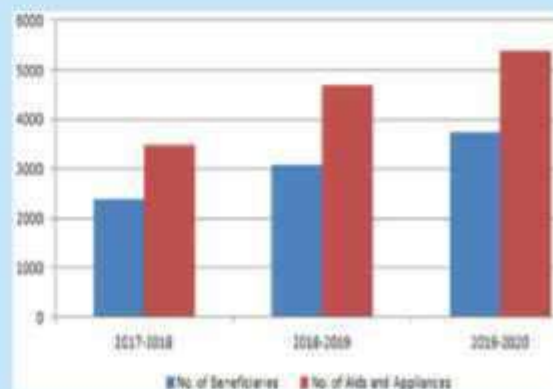

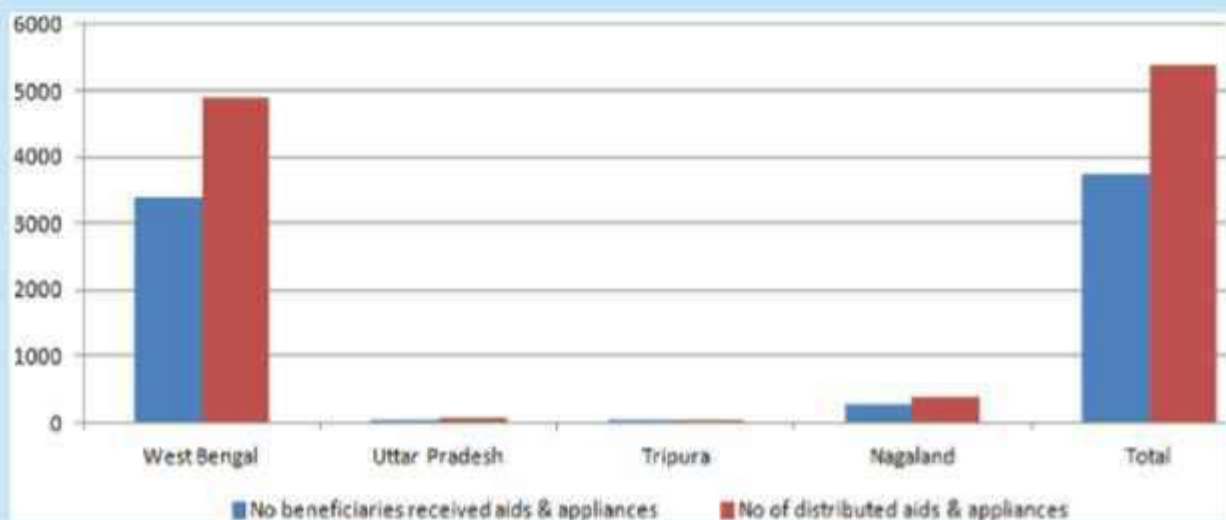

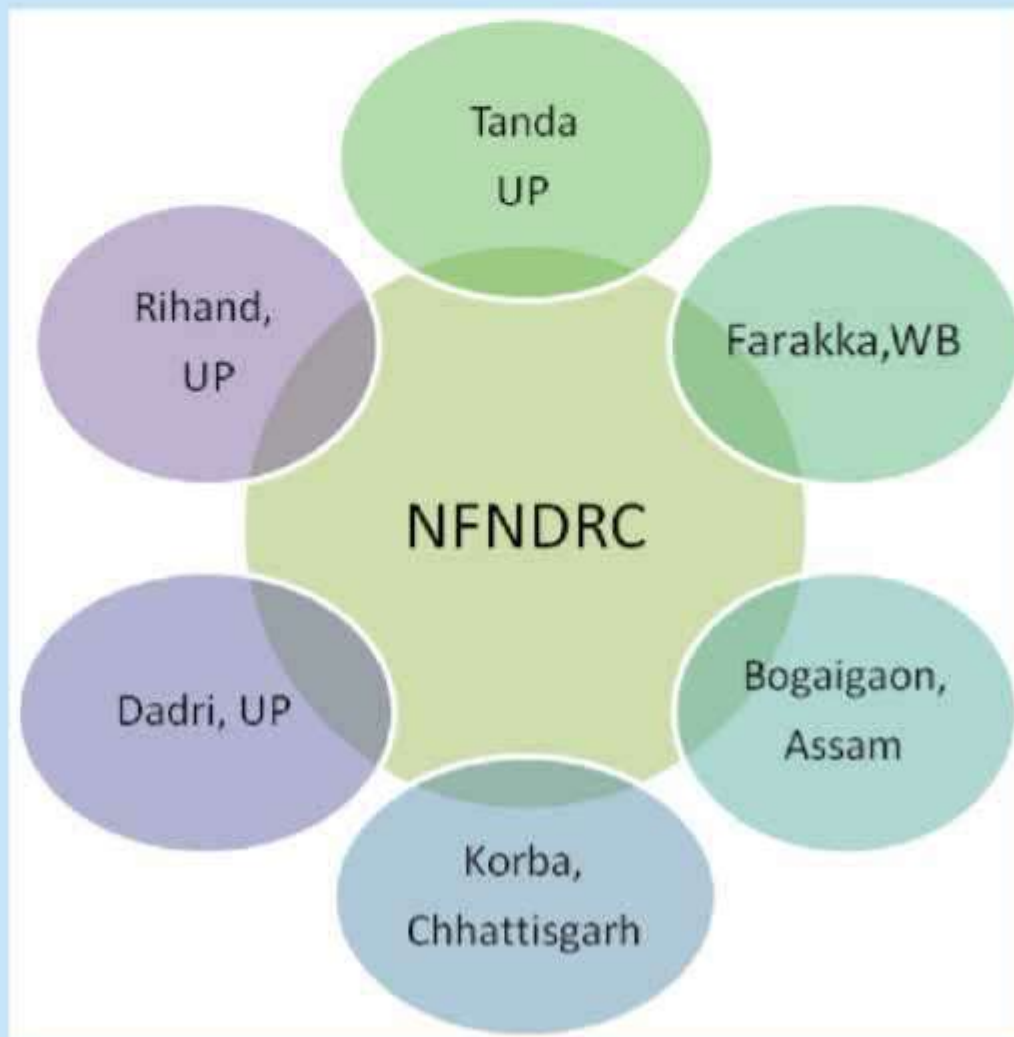


Collaborative Centre-NILD-NTPC Foundation (NFNDRCs)

NTPC foundation-NILD Disability Rehabilitation Centre (NFNDRC) established in collaboration with National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) and National Institute for Locomotor Disabilities (Divyangjan) (NILD), Kolkata with an aim to bring in significant changes in the life of differently-abled persons in the field of Locomotor Disability residing in the vicinity of NTPC projects in different parts of the countries.

The initiative is taken up under the aegis of NTPC foundation-NILD Disability Rehabilitation Centre (NFNDRC) providing rehabilitation services i.e Medical Interventions, Surgical Corrections, Distribution of artificial aids & appliances under ADIP scheme, therapeutic intervention, Audiometric testing services etc to the target group at community level.

For providing services in the area of rehabilitation, six NFNDRC have been established at NTPC, Tanda (UP), Rihand (UP), Dadri (UP), Korba (Chhattisgarh) & Bogaigaion (Assam) and NTPC Farakka, (WB)





Awareness Generation and Publicity

Various awareness materials were developed or updated for display and distribution to the persons with disabilities (divyangjan), officials, NGO functionaries, common public as well as other stake holders. These were distributed through exhibition, mela, fair, awareness program or camps etc.

A documentary was developed on the institute's activities for the purpose of awareness and propagation. Incentive Scheme for Providing Employment to Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) in the Private Sector

The most important aspect of rehabilitation of PwDs (Divyangjan) is their economic rehabilitation which can be achieved by providing employment or through self-employment. Government has been promoting the self-employment of PwDs (Divyangjan) by providing vocational training and loan on concessional rates through National Handicapped Finance Development Corporation (NHDFDC). Employment of PwDs (Divyangjan) in the Government is promoted through reservation under Section 33 of the PwDs (Divyangjan) (Equal Opportunities, Protection Rights and Full Participation) Act, 2016 provided for a reservation of 4-5 persons with Benchmark Disabilities. To promote employment PwDs (Divyangjan) in the expanding private sector, Govt. of India is promoting by giving incentive to the private sector employers.


The Scheme

- The employers need not deposit the G1 / L1d contribution in respect of their PwD employees. The employers just need to intimate the KPFD / FSC regarding appointments made by them and furnish employee's contribution to G1D / L1d. The employer's contribution

Guidelines for Patients & Care Givers

ELIGIBILITY TO GET AIDS / APPLIANCES UNDER ADIP SCHEME



A person with disabilities falling in following conditions would be eligible for assistance under the Scheme of Assistance to Disabled Persons for purchase / fitting of Aids / Appliances under ADIP Scheme:

Indian Citizens
Holds a 40% Disability Certificate

Persons who have not received assistance from the Government, local bodies and Non-Govt. Organizations during the last 5 years for the same purpose. However, the child is below 12 years of age, this limit could be 1 year.

Income Limit	
Total Income	Amount of Assistance
Up to Rs. 45,000/- per month	Full Cost of aid / appliance
Rs. 45,000/- to 25,000/- per month	80% of the cost of aid / appliance

In case of dependent the income of parents/guardians should not exceed Rs. 20,000/- per month.

Verification of Income by any of the following authorities:
Revenue Authorities or RPI, Child or MGNREGS Cluster, District Planning Fund or Certificate from MGNREGS or Gram Panchayat, Village Health Nurse and ASHA.

Quantum of Assistance

- Aids / Appliances cost upto Rs. 10,000/-
- Aids / Appliances cost upto Rs. 12,000/- in the case of student with disability beyond IX standard.

Types of Aids/Appliances to be provided as follows

IV. Persons with Locomotor Disability

- All prosthetic and orthotic devices, stability aids, manual foot wear, BML slings, all types of device for ACH, activity or daily living as recommended by expert committees from time to time.
- Manufactured supplies and wheelchairs for severely PwDs (Drapyangan) and for non-drapping PwDs (Muscular, Dyslexic, Stroke, Cerebral Palsy, Hemiplegia) and any other person with such conditions where either locomotor limbs or one half of the body are severely impaired, status of severity will be fix. In cases, this will be provided to the person of age 16 years and above, more than 10 years. However, severely PwDs (Drapyangan) of 16 years and above are having mental impairment shall not be eligible for manual tricycles and wheelchairs since it may have a risk of serious accident personal harm.

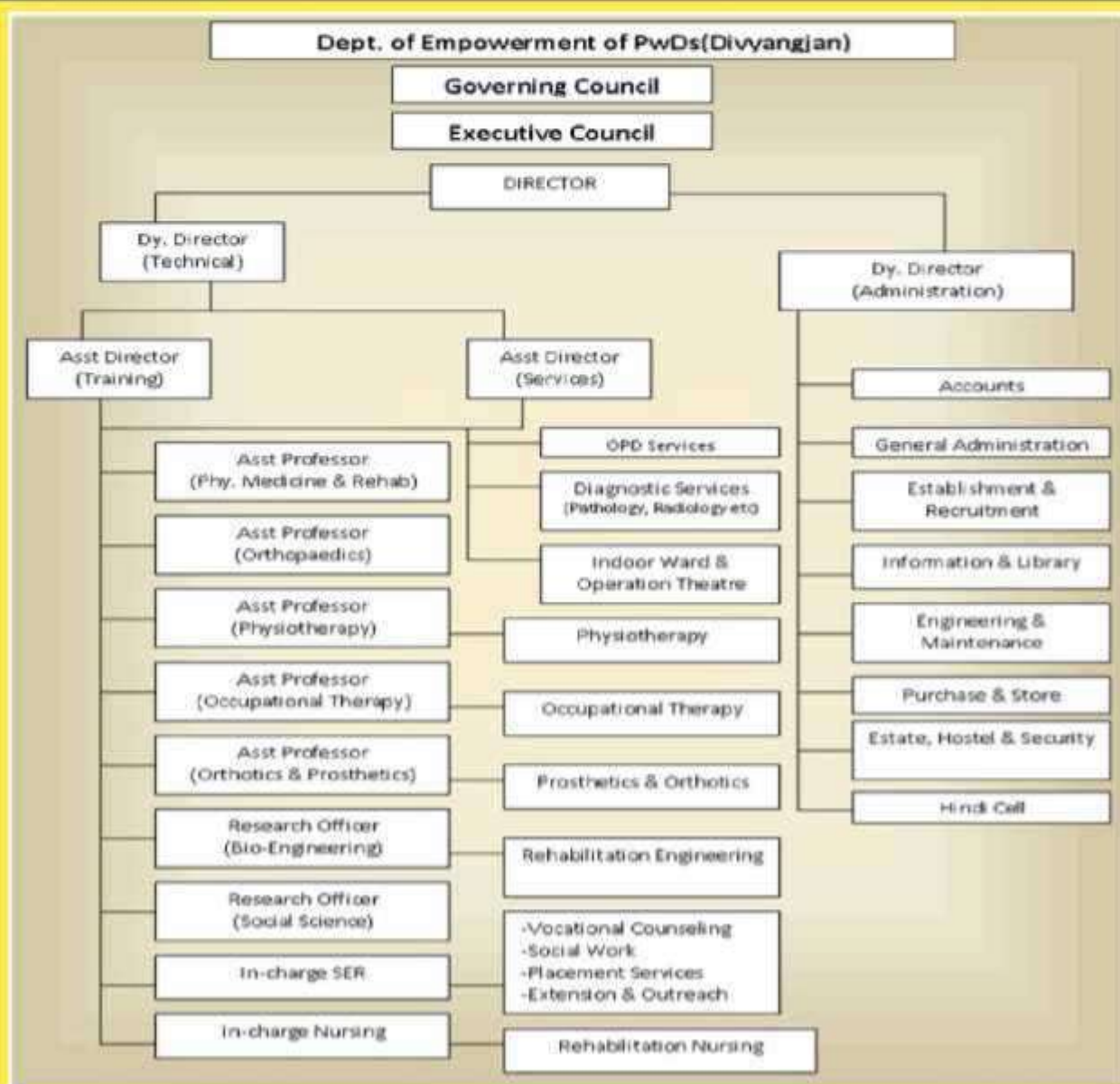

WORKSHOP ON IMPLEMENTATION OF RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005

Right to Information Act, 2005 is an act passed by Indian Parliament which gives access to information by all citizens of the country.

The National Institute for Locomotor Disabilities (Divyangjan), Kolkata conducted a one day workshop on Implementation of Right to Information Act: 2005* on 30/08/2019. The workshop was inaugurated by Dr.A.Biswas, I/C, Director, Mr.Pankaj Bajpai, DDA (O) and Speaker of the workshop Shri Sumanta Biswas, Eminent advocate, Calcutta High court, West Bengal. The workshop was attended by the PIOs, First Appellate Authorities, all group-A officers and In-charges of the Institute and Regional centers of NIEPID, NIEPVD & AYJNISHD.

Dr.A.Biswas, I/C Director explained the importance of RTI Act for the citizens and Mr.Pankaj Bajpai, DDA (O) emphasized on the role of RTI Act for improving transparency in public offices. Shri Sumanta Biswas, Speaker of the workshop explained the details of the Act pertaining to what is the right of a citizen, what are the types of information she/he can obtain under this Act, what are the types of records that can be obtained, what are the obligations of public authorities, the roles and responsibilities of Public Information Officers (PIO) and Assistant Public Information Officers (APIO), Central and State Information

Since then the RC-Dehradun is providing Rehabilitation services to the persons with locomotor disabilities in the state of Uttarakhand and neighboring districts of Uttar Pradesh and Himachal Pradesh and also engaged in training and sensitization in the field of Disability and Rehabilitation.

Aims and objectives:

The main aims and objectives of regional chapter-Dehradun are as follows:

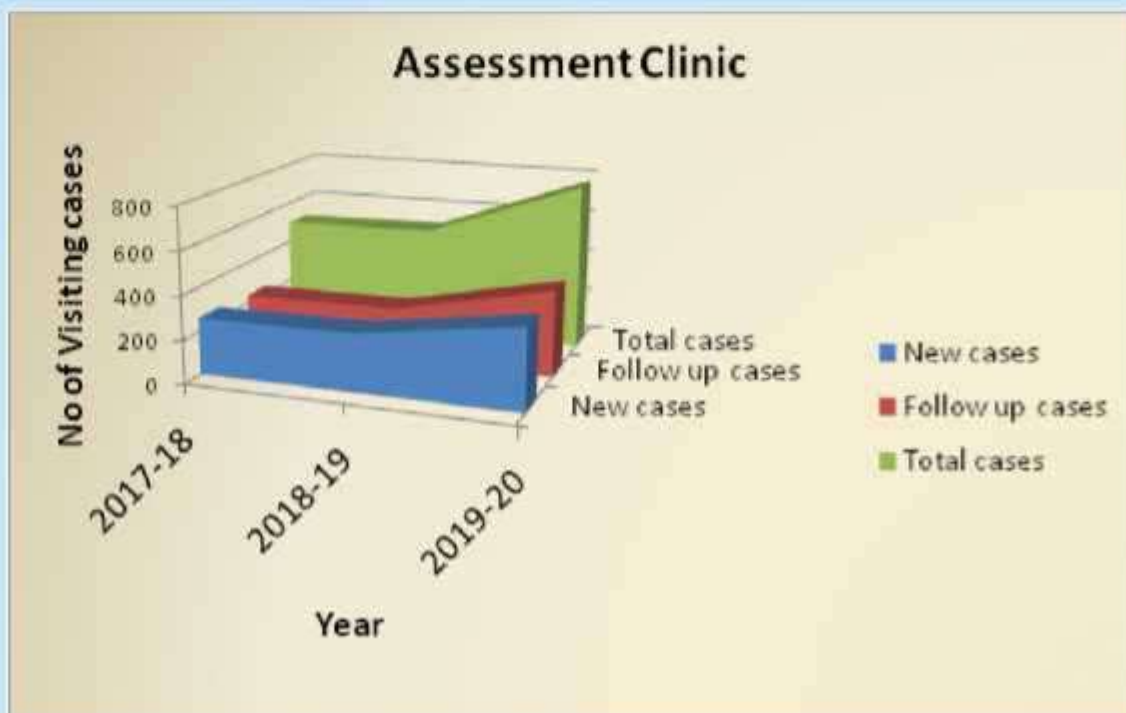
- To undertake manpower development training programme in the field of Disability and Rehabilitation
- To offer educational training, work adjustment and such other rehabilitation services as the society may deem fit to the locomotor disabled persons with or without associated mental retardation
- To undertake fabrication and distribution of such aids and appliances as are needed for the education, training and rehabilitation of the disabled persons
- To provide such other services as may be considered appropriate for promoting the education and rehabilitation of the disabled persons including organizing meetings, seminars and awareness sensitization programmes.
- To cooperate with national, regional or local agencies in Uttarakhand to promote development of services for the persons with locomotor disabilities

The above activities were undertaken by various, units, functioning under the administration of the centre.



Physiotherapy Unit :

This unit provided various rehabilitation services to the patients through exercise therapy & electrotherapy using various latest equipments like IFT, Hydrocollator, Traction, paraffin wax, electrical stimulator, TENS, SWD etc. Persons with neurological, orthopaedic, neuro muscular and variety of other conditions visit the Physiotherapy unit in search of treatment. Unit provides Physiotherapy services on the recommendation of visiting Orthopaedic Surgeon, who visits the OPD clinic of centre bi-weekly.



Occupational therapy unit :

The unit was involved in improving the level of functional independence in PWDs and CWDs through various activities to help in achieving independence in daily living skills and work performance. During the year Paediatric, neurologically impaired children as well as upper limb amputees were given rehabilitation services for achieving highest performance levels.



Prosthetic & Orthotic Unit :

The P&O unit fabricated and provided prosthetic & orthotics, aids and appliances under ADIP scheme of Govt of India along with Gait training. The functioning and techniques of wearing and removing orthotic & prosthetic aids were also provided / demonstrated to the beneficiaries through the P&O unit of the centre.

NILD-RC, Aizawl provides :-

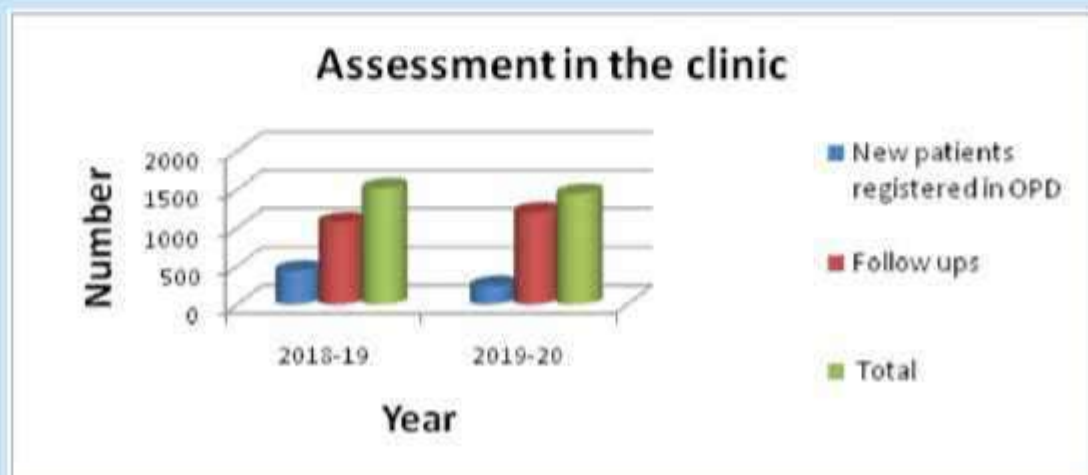
- Assessment, medical guidance and referral for surgery etc.
