Director, NILD Kolkata welcomed the Chairperson and Members and with the permission of Chair, point wise discussion on the agenda was taken and resolution adopted / decisions taken are stated as under.

#### 122.01 Confirmation of the Minutes of the 121st Meeting of EC.

**Decision:** EC confirmed the Minutes of the 121<sup>st</sup>Executive council meeting held on 27th August,2024 considering no objection/comments after circulation of the minutes.

# 122.02. Action Taken Report on the decisions taken in 121st meeting of EC, NILD held on 27.08.2024.

**Decision:** Action taken on the recommendations of 121<sup>st</sup> EC meeting of NILD Kolkata were noted and few directions were given as follows:

At the very outset of the meeting the EC directed that all the EC approval up to December, 2023 which were unattended till date will be null & void and also directed to submit fresh proposal with proper justification for not compliance and resubmit the agenda in the upcoming ECs.

- **121.09.** EC nominated the name of Dr. Alok Kumar "Bhuwan", Specialized in Rehabilitation Science & Special Education, Mobile No. 9990807772, Email id: <a href="mailto:alok.bhuwan@gmail.com">alok.bhuwan@gmail.com</a> out of the two names approved in the 121st EC Meeting as the member of the Academic Committee of the Institute.
- **121.12.** The Director reported about the pending DPC for the posts of Assistant Professor (OT) and Lecturer (OT), which would be vacated upon promotion of the current incumbents. The EC Chairperson agreed to convene the DPC at the earliest by obtaining suitable date from ministry.
- **121.17.** Chairperson EC ratified the proposal as approved in the Standing Committee of PDUNIPPD New Delhi vide agenda no 139.33 for engagement of Assistant Professor (Nursing) at a consolidated pay of Rs 75,000/- pm at NILD Kolkata in line with the pay approved for the equivalent post of Assistant Professor (On Contract) at PDUNIPPD New Delhi.
- **121.21.** The EC Chairperson directed the Director, NILD to visit Aizawl for an MoU with Zoram Medical College, Aizawl, for establishing a second campus of RC-Aizawl. Further it was directed to visit RC-Naharlagoon, Arunachal Pradesh to take a review its functioning.
- **121.23.** EC allowed CRC Sikkim to admit students from December 2024 for their conducting 6 months skill training course under PM Daksh skill training program of DEPwD at CRC Sikkim and instructed to ensure other arrangements i.e. tutor registration and also to ensure sustainable placement of the students after completion of the course.

EC member Dr. Yogesh Dubey emphasized for job opportunities with regard to trained students. The EC Chairman instructed Director, CRC-Sikkim, to collaborate with restaurant owners and other employers for placements. The Director, CRC-Sikkim reported on the discussions held with civil aviation personnel regarding placement of trained students and proposed including students with all types of disabilities in training, which the JS supported by suggesting rule amendments if needed.

The Director, CRC-Sikkim highlighted the long travel times for PwDs from remote areas to the Centre and proposed for enhanced travel allowances, which JS agreed to address through hill allowances as per applicable rules.
