Director, NILD Kolkata welcomed the Chairperson and Members and with the permission of Chair, thereafter point wise discussion on the agenda was held and resolution adopted / decisions taken are stated as under.

124.01: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 123rd Meeting of EC of NILD Kolkata held on 19/03/2025 through virtual mode .

Decision: EC confirmed the Minutes of the 123rd Executive council meeting held on 19th March 2025, considering no objection/comments after circulation of the minutes.

124.02: Action Taken Report on the decisions taken in 123rd meeting of EC held on 19th March, 2025 through virtual mode.

Decision: The Executive Council noted the Action Taken Report on the recommendations of the 123rd EC meeting of NILD, Kolkata. However, with respect to the following points, the EC recommendations are as hereunder.

- **Point 123.03** (regarding the introduction of B.Sc. (Nursing) course at NILD, Kolkata): The Chairman, EC, directed the Director, NILD, Kolkata, to visit the Ministry of Health, Government of India, at the earliest and take necessary action in this regard.
- **Point 123.08** (regarding initiation of a new course in MOT (Rehabilitation)): The EC noted the status. Additionally, concerning the withholding of admissions to the master's level course from the last academic session, the Chairman, EC, stated the Director, NILD, Kolkata, that he would personally write a letter immediately to the Vice Chancellor, West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS), requesting the commencement of admissions to the said course.

124.03: To consider the proposal of renaming National Institute for Locomotor Disabilities (Divyangjan) as Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee National Institute for Locomotor Disabilities (Divyangjan), Kolkata.
