





Pravin Kumar, HOD (PT), NILD, Kolkata, followed by Inaugural address by Dr. Lalit Narayan, Director, NILD, Kolkata in which he emphasized on multidisciplinary approach and role of rehabilitation team while managing children suffering from DMD. Sh. Sougato Banerjee, Dy. Director (Admn.), NILD, Kolkata also addressed the participants, about the DMD and the problems faced by such patients. The webinar was focused on the theme of DMD day covering both medical and rehabilitation aspect of DMD.

The first session was taken by Dr. Robin Dubey, Consultant Paediatrician, where he spoke to the participants about the medical aspect of the DMD including pathogenesis, clinical features, complications, diagnosis, medical management and recent research & advancement in managing DMD.






