Outreach section of NILD, Kolkata having significant role by impacting the lives of thousands of PwDs by providing essential services and support in collaboration with local organizations and government bodies.

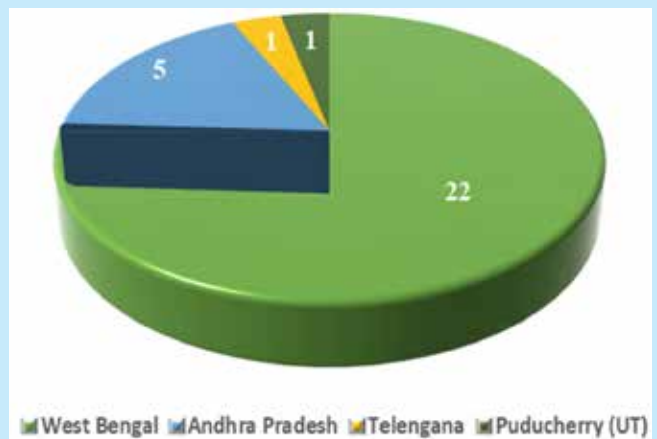

ACTIVITIES OF OUTREACH SECTION (2024-25)

Outreach Section conducts Assessment cum Identification and Distribution Camps and awareness programmes for the Persons with Disabilities under the Scheme of "Assistance to the Disabled Persons for Purchase/Fitting of Aids/Appliances (ADIP)", implemented by DEPWD, MSJ&E, Govt. of India. Accordingly, during the year 2024-25 camps were conducted under ADIP scheme in West Bengal, Andhra Pradesh, Telengana and Puducherry (U.T). The total 1647 number of PwDs were benefited by receiving 2111 number of Aids and Appliances through these camps.

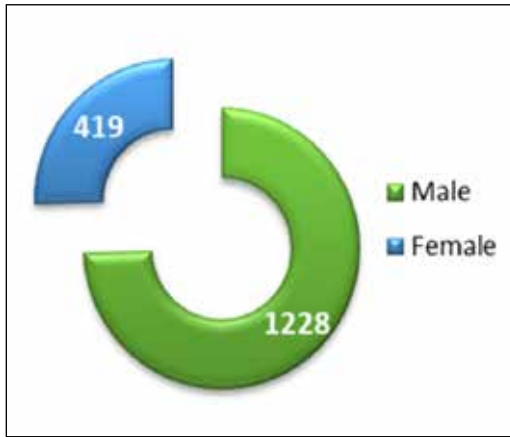

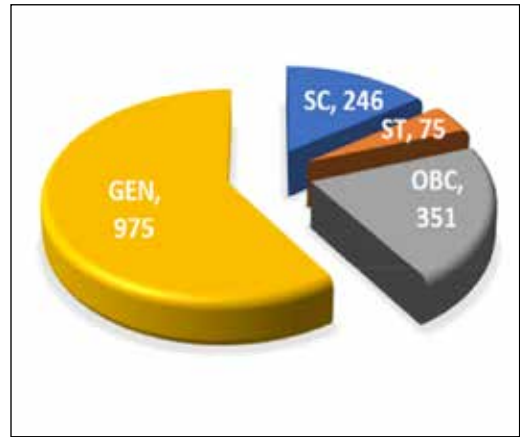

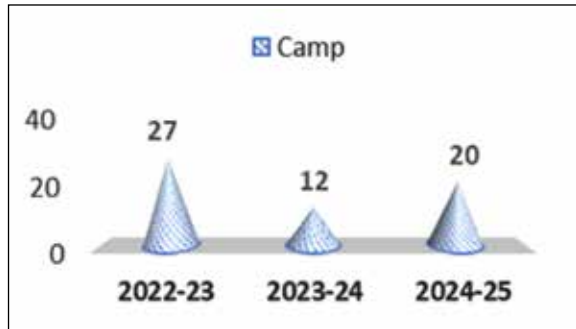
Male-Female wise Beneficiaries



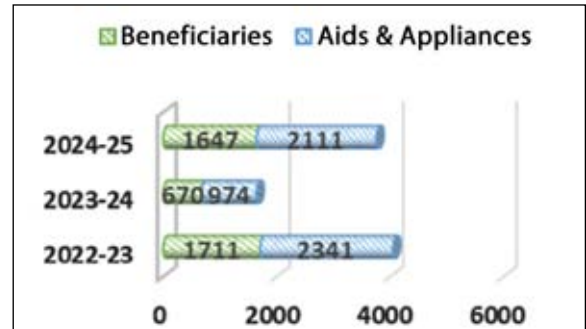

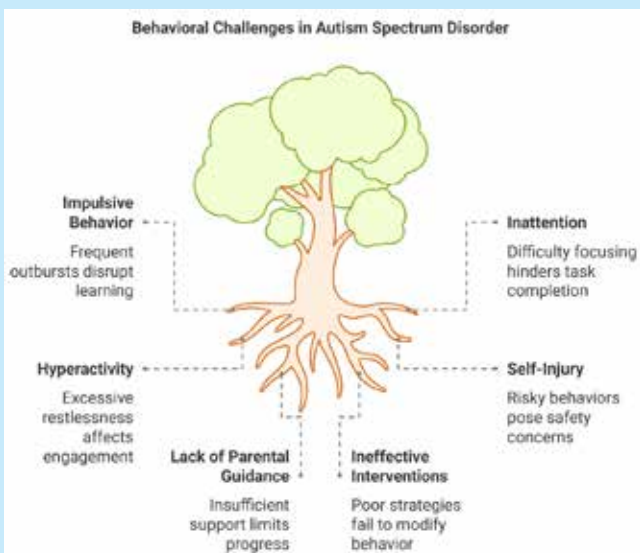

SUCCESS STORIES

Success Story-1 : Kabya Hari – A Journey Towards Progress

Kabya Hari, a 5-year-5-month-old boy, was diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). At the time of diagnosis, Kabya exhibited several challenging behaviors, including impulsive outbursts, difficulty focusing, inattention, hyperactivity, self-injurious tendencies, stubbornness, and aggression. These behaviors posed significant challenges to both his academic progress and daily functioning.



Recognizing the need for structured intervention, Kabya's parents sought help at CDEIC, where a comprehensive, multidisciplinary plan was designed for him. The

cornerstone of his journey was behavior modification therapy, which incorporated positive reinforcement, a token economy system, visual aids, and task breakdown strategies. Desired behaviors were encouraged through rewards like stickers and stars, and tokens earned for good behavior were exchanged for privileges. Visual aids, such as charts and checklists, helped Kabya stay organized and reduce frustration, enabling him to complete tasks effectively.

Alongside Kabya's behavior therapy, his parents also received psychological counseling and guidance. This support significantly reduced their stress and anxiety, empowering them to manage Kabya's behaviors more effectively.

Kabya also accessed services from other units at CDEIC, including occupational therapy, speech therapy, and special education. These interventions worked in harmony to develop his overall abilities, including communication, motor skills, and academic readiness.

Over the course of two years, Kabya made remarkable progress. His outbursts diminished significantly, and he began raising his hand to speak. His ability to focus and follow instructions improved, resulting in better academic performance. Kabya also demonstrated reduced restlessness, allowing him to participate in quiet activities. With these changes, his stereotypical behaviors improved drastically.

Today, Kabya is attending school regularly and achieving

age-appropriate developmental milestones. His journey is a testament to the transformative power of collaborative, multidisciplinary interventions and parental dedication. CDEIC is proud to have played a pivotal role in Kabya's success story, inspiring hope for many families navigating similar challenges.



Success Story 2 : Atryee Jana – A Journey Towards Independence and Inclusion

Atryee Jana, a five-year-old girl, first visited CDEIC in 2023 with concerns of hyperactivity and developmental delays. She was diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and faced significant challenges in socialization, educational growth, and communication. Her behavior and daily living activities were severely affected.

Due to zero sitting tolerance, lack of attention, and an inability to follow instructions, Atryee was repeatedly rejected by schools. Her hyperactivity made it difficult for her parents to manage her in public transport, and they had limited awareness of her condition.

At CDEIC, Atryee underwent comprehensive multidisciplinary interventions, including Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Behavior Modification, Special Education sessions, and parental counseling. Gradually, her situation began to improve. She started attending sessions regularly, and her parents became more aware and equipped to support her needs.

On 12th December 2023, Atryee was enrolled in the School Readiness Program. Over time, her progress was remarkable. She developed the ability to identify and write letters A-Z (in both capital and small cases) independently. She also learned to write the names of five fruits, five vegetables, five animals, all core colors, and all shapes. Additionally, she mastered naming the seven days of the week and twelve months of the year.

Her academic skills advanced significantly as she began counting numbers, performing addition and subtraction, and understanding concepts like "before" and "after" numbers. Her communication skills improved noticeably, enabling her to express herself clearly and confidently. She also gained independence in her daily living activities and began managing her own tasks without support.

Today, Atryee is attending a general school regularly. She actively participates in classroom activities and engages successfully in both curricular and co-curricular programs. Her transformation is a testament to the power of early intervention, multidisciplinary support, and the unwavering commitment of her parents and therapists.



Atryee's journey inspires hope for families facing similar challenges and reinforces the impact of collaborative efforts in enabling children with ASD to thrive.

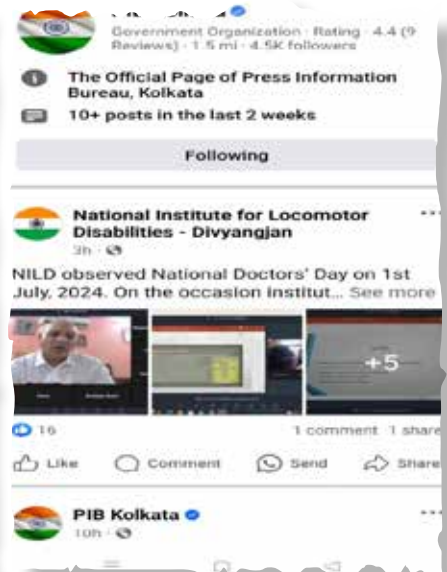

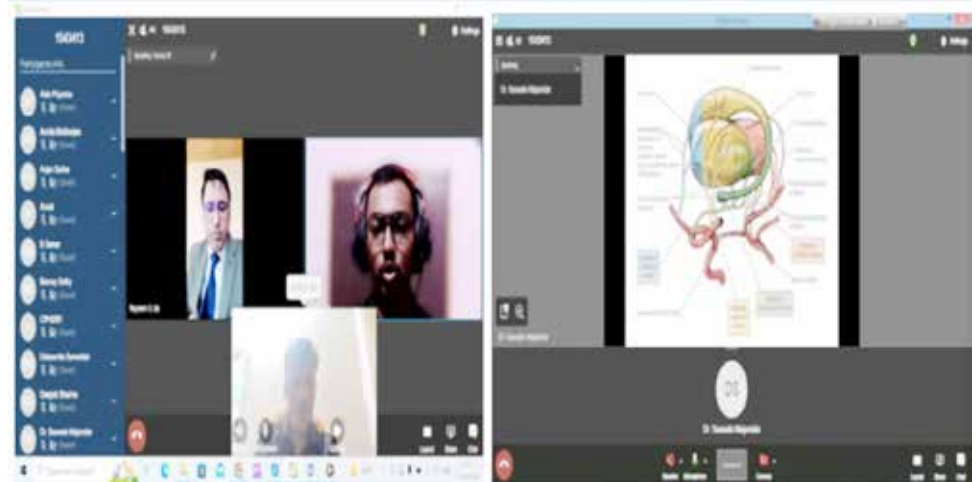
Celebrations and Observance of Important National Events

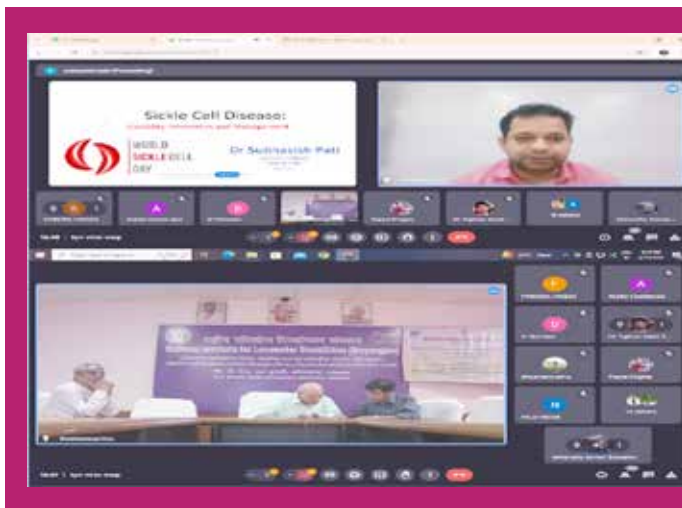

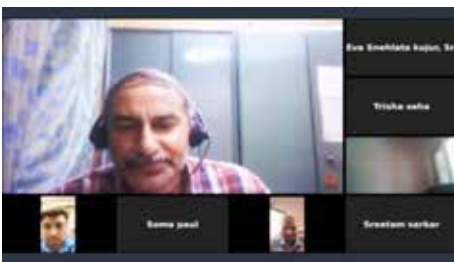


and Sign Language. Total 108 no. participants present during the program.

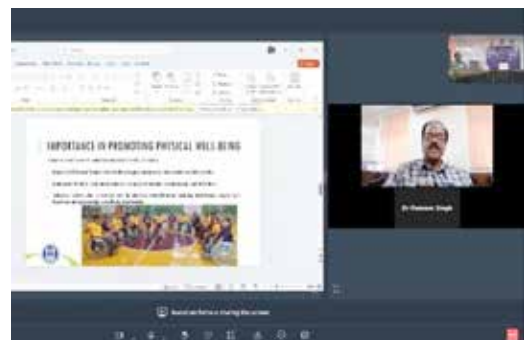
concluded with the prize distribution ceremony for the patients.

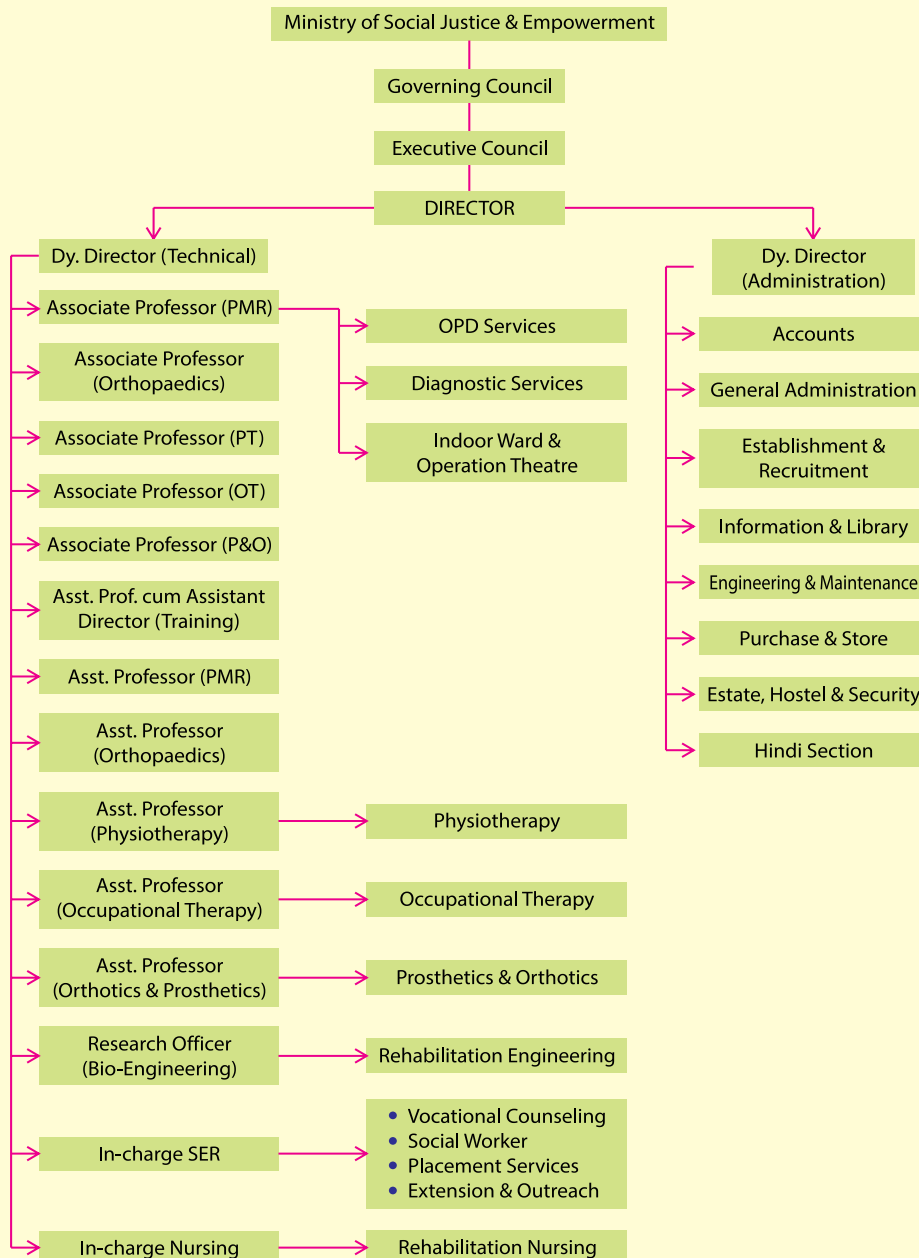

- ➔ The centre provides Comprehensive Rehabilitation Services through team approach consisting of Physiotherapist, Occupational Therapist and other support staff.

- ➔ Co-ordinate and assist camps to implement ADIP Scheme of GOI, which are being conducted by NILD, Kolkata.

CHAPTER 10

Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development, Rehabilitation & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Patna



COMPOSITE REGIONAL CENTRE - PATNA

The Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development, Rehabilitation & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (CRC), Patna was established in 2009 by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India. It functions under the administrative control of the National Institute for Locomotor Disabilities (Divyangjan), Kolkata.

CRC Patna serves as an apex institution in the region, carrying out three core functions: training, research, and service provision for persons with all types of disabilities. The Centre is steadily advancing in its mission to empower persons with disabilities through long and short-term human resource development programmes, development of service delivery models, documentation and dissemination of information,

community-based rehabilitation, extension and outreach programmes, and fabrication and fitment of aids and appliances.

The Centre maintains a special focus on reaching the unreached in the region. Through consistent professional efforts, CRC Patna aims to empower persons with disabilities by facilitating access to a comprehensive range of rehabilitation interventions — educational, therapeutic, vocational, employment-related, as well as opportunities for leisure, sports, cultural participation, and full societal inclusion.

2. Objectives of CRC Patna

The Composite Regional Centre (CRC), Patna was established with the mission to enhance the quality of



life for persons with disabilities. Its key objectives include :

1. To serve as Resource Centre for rehabilitation and special education of persons with disabilities.
2. To undertake human resource development by training rehabilitation professionals, for providing services to persons with disabilities.
3. To undertake public education programs for creation of awareness in the parents and the community.
4. To undertake designing, fabrication and fitment of aids and appliances.
5. To undertake services of education and skill development leading to enhancement of opportunities for employment, Rehabilitation, Mobility communication recreation and Integration in society.
6. To undertake research and development with specific reference to needs of diverse groups of people with disability, keeping in view the nature and severity of disability in the region.
7. To develop strategies for delivery of rehabilitation services suitable to the socio-cultural background of the region.
8. To stimulate growth of services by encouraging and supporting voluntary organization, parent groups and self-help groups.
9. To establish linkages with existing Medical,

Educational and Employment services, following the principles of Community-Based Rehabilitation and offer extension services in the rural areas.

3. Hostel Infrastructure Development

To support the growing needs of persons with disabilities in the region, the foundation stone for a dedicated hostel building was laid on 8th July 2018 by the then Hon'ble Cabinet Minister Shri Thawarchand Gehlot, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India. The inauguration of the hostel building with intake capacity of 100 beds (both boys and girls) was held on 21st February 2024 through virtual mode by Dr. Virendra Kumar, Hon'ble Cabinet Minister, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India. Development work in hostel premises is under progress.

4. Target Population

According to the Census of India 2011, there are 2.68 crore persons with disabilities (PwDs) in the country, constituting 2.21% of the total population. In the state of Bihar, the population of persons with disabilities is recorded at 23.31 lakh, which accounts for 8.69% of India's total disabled population and 2.23% of Bihar's population (total population: 10.41 crore).

6. Other services :

As part of its commitment to inclusive service delivery, CRC Patna conducted assessment camps under 100 days vision in three districts and distribution at headquarter under the Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase/ Fitting of Aids and Appliances (ADIP) Scheme. The primary objective of this scheme is to support needy persons with disabilities (pwds) in acquiring durable, scientifically designed, and modern assistive aids and appliances, thereby facilitating their physical, social, and psychological rehabilitation. These assistive devices are intended to enhance the independent functioning of pwds, minimize the impact of disabilities, and prevent the onset of secondary disabilities, while simultaneously contributing to the economic empowerment of beneficiaries.

During the reporting year, a total of 315 persons with disabilities benefitted from these outreach efforts, receiving 177 aids and appliances through multiple assessment and distribution camps organized by CRC Patna.

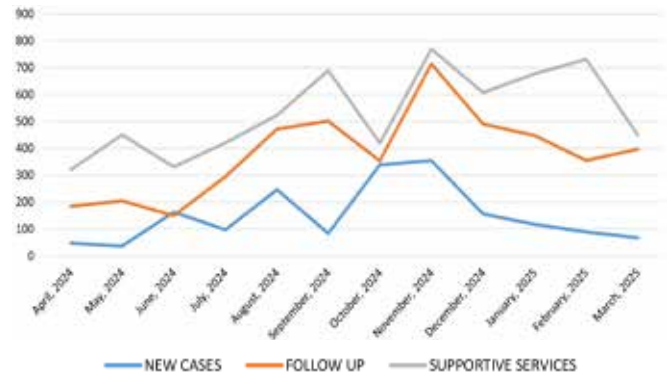

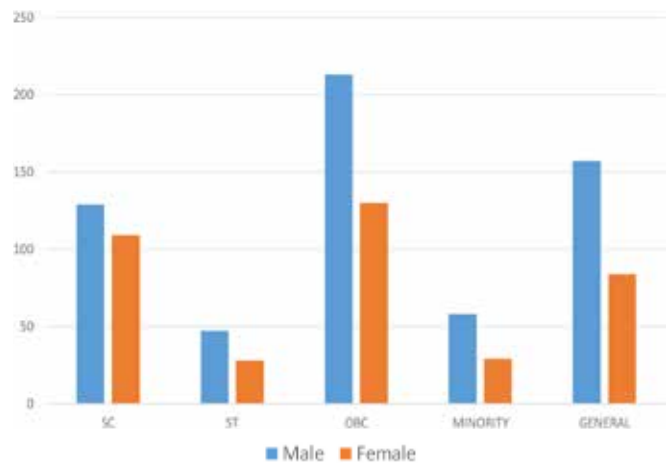

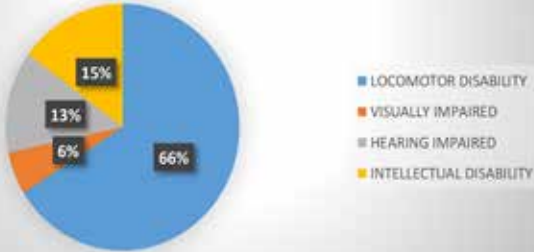
Caste Wise Demographic Data of Centre Based New Clients

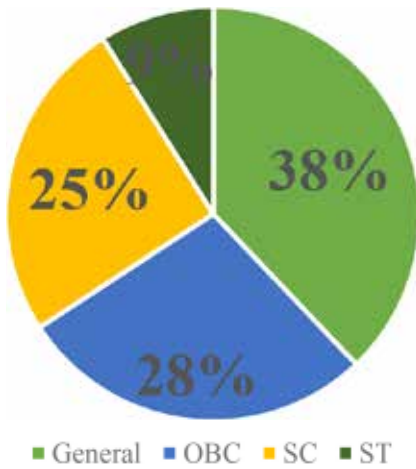
