## About NIC Maharashtra and Major Projects

NIC Maharashtra State Centre is headquartered at New Administrative Building, Mantralaya, Mumbai, with centre's in 36 districts; Focus Centre's include Software Development Unit, Pune, and SDTC Nagpur; High Court Mumbai with benches in Nagpur, Chatrapati Sambhaji Nagar and Kolhapur; IVFRT presence at international Airports in Mumbai, Pune, Nagpur, seaports at Mumbai, Nava Sheva, and FRRO, Mumbai.

### Major Projects of NIC Maharashtra:

- **eHRMS:** 27,000 active employees across 42 Government of Maharashtra departments
- **S3WaaS:** 161 websites; 145 integrated with Bhashini (Translation + Text-to-Speech)
- **eOffice:** 1.5 lakh users, 700 offices, 43 lakh transactions
- **NIC Email Services:** 4.4 lakh accounts; 1.6 lakh migrated to Zoho
- **eCabinet:** 27 eCabinet meetings held so far using e-Mantrimandal app.

## About NIC Pune Activities

**eVetanSeva New Sevaarth - Employee Information System (EIS):** eVetanSeva has been implemented at six DDOs of the Maharashtra State Government, and salary bills are successfully processed using eBill with eSign. Data migration from the legacy system was completed successfully through web services

**eTransport MMP:** New Development in eTransport project during the month:

- **Vahan 4.0:** Online T.O. Facility in DAUC (Dealer Authorization Certificate Portal), Implementation of new GSR 850(E), CMVR Rule125H, new Tax schedule for RMA vehicles, AFMS portal for MH15, Removal of VAHAN fitness service access from MH15.
- **Sarathi 4.0:** Customised DL test Duties for the IMV / AIMV, Customised Only One captcha for the LL exam for both Faceless and Non-Faceless mode, New Sarathi Support System helpdesk tested on Prepod.
- **eChallan:ITMS** (Intelligent Traffic Management System) Dashboard implemented for Transport department.
- **Parivahan:** Highlighted the new portal <https://www.allcservices.shop/> accessing the real time data for Vahan, Sarathi & eChallan
- **PUC:** PUC Renewal Payment Gateway, as there were issues earlier with processing payments for PUC renewal applications
- **Tickets:** 449, 254, 56, 21 tickets raised by state RTOs on the Sarathi, Vahan, eChallan, PUC Helpdesk were resolved.

- API development of RTS Services for Maharashtra Government whatsapp Chabot (In progress).
- Total No. 14815 of tickets booking of the Safari booking and 329 No. of Resort Booking of various safaris.
- Total - 126 eAuctions have been conducted of the Timber, Bamboo and Firewood.

### Document Registration Division (DRD):

- iSarita 1.9: The application covers major applications like Document registration, Leave n License, eFiling, eASR, eValuation, eScanning, eSearch 1.9, Section 10D.
- iSarita 2.0: eRegistration (first sale of property), eFiling 2.0, Leave and License 2.0 (pilot for Pune rural and Mumbai), GSO 2.0, Paperless Custom eBond, Pay2IGR (Unified payment gateway for all receipt side revenue of registration department) are implemented.
- Emerging Technologies used: ElasticSearch, Block chain
- A mobile app for licensed stamp vendor has been developed for paperless working of LSVs.
- Banker's portal to verify the charges on a property before disbursing the loan to applicant is ready for roll out.

### DILRMP (Digital India Land Records Modernization Program - <https://mahabhumi.gov.in>)

The project is being executed by Settlement Commissioner, Maharashtra with ICT support of NIC. Applications launched for Ease of Living of citizens like Mahabhumi, OrderMutation, eFerFar, ePCIS, ePCIS-Mumbai, ePeekPahni, AgriStack, AadharSeeding, API Portal, Bhulekh, e-Records etc.


During the month, new services / modules like Swamitva Urban Notices on Aapli Chawdi, Speed-post integration, Generic and objection modules for e-Property Card of Mumbai, Interfaces for rural and urban revenue officials for Aadhaar Seeding etc. were developed. API for Order Mutation, e-Property Card of Mumbai, History API for Agri Stack, API for TRTI and Relief and Rehabilitation Department were developed. Inclusion of Mumbai City Property Card on Bhulekh website.

### The Integrated Financial Management System (IFMS)

It facilitates the management of government finances and ensures smooth coordination between various financial departments. Key Modules: BEAMS, Bill Portal, TreasuryNet/ Unified Treasury, SNAP, Cyber Treasury, GRAS, GST, IPLA, VPDA, Arthwahini/ Koshwahini, Deposit Work Module.

### Education (SARAL)

- Implemented the KPI-based SARAL Dashboard, providing consolidated insights across key applications. It covers School, Student, PM Poshan, eMarksheet, and RTE 25% Admission.
- Implemented a comprehensive Student Safety and Security framework for Maharashtra schools based on a point base checklist provided by Maharashtra government covering POCSO awareness, CCTV monitoring, staff background verification, grievance mechanisms, bullying prevention, and digital safety. The system ensures full compliance by tracking safety measures across infrastructure, staff, students, and committees.





### MAHA-PAR Implementation status




