Free travel concession to the blind in the buses of Haryana Roadways.

Please refer to this office memo No. 2547-59/CA-4 dated 8.7.81 on the subject noted above.

According to the decision of the Government the Deputy Commissioner are authorised to issue the identity certificates to the blind persons to enable them to avail the advantage of free travel concession in the buses of Haryana Roadways. Instances have come to the notice of the department that sometimes conductors do not allow the blind to travel free in the buses because they are not sure about the genuiness of the certificates issued by the Deputy Commissioners which causes inconvenience to the blind. The matter has been considered and it has been decided that while issuing the certificate the DC's will affix their seals on each certificate besides some other mark, which is difficult to forge, under intimation to the General Manager, Haryana Roadways so that there is no doubt about the genuiness of the Identity certificates and blind persons are not put to any sort of inconvenience while travelling in Haryana Roadways buses.

They are advised to ensure that the blind persons who are in possession of Identity Certificate issued by the Deputy Commissioner are allowed to avail free travel concession in Haryana Roadways buses. Strict action should be taken against the conductor in case of any complaint for not having allowed the blind (Identity Certificate holders) to travel free. Strict instructions in this behalf should, therefore, be issued to the conductors and checking staff working under their control.
