**Subject:** C.M. Announcement regarding free Transport facility to the spouses suffered during the emergency period, in the buses of Haryana Roadways and providing 75% rebate to the spouses in Volvo buses alongwith one attendant in case of widow or widower.

Please refer to your office note dated 04.09.2015 on the subject noted above.

2. Sanction of the Governor of Haryana is hereby accorded to allow free transport facility to the spouses suffered during the emergency period in the ordinary buses of Haryana Roadways and to provide 75% rebate to the spouses in Volvo buses alongwith one attendant in case of widow or widower, on the basis of Identification issued by the District administration.

3. The other terms and conditions are as under:-

i) The I cards to the spouses who suffered during the emergency shall be issued by District Administration. The facility shall be available to both the sufferer and the spouse, in case both are alive and both will be issued I-Cards by the District Administration.

ii) The facility shall be limited to the jurisdiction of Haryana only including Chandigarh & Delhi being State Capital & National Capital.

iii) In case of widow or widower, one attendant is allowed to travel free alongwith the widow/widower who suffered during the period of emergency. The attendant will not be entitled to travel free in the buses of Haryana Roadways alone.

4. Further, 75% rebate in bus fare has been granted to such I-Card holders as under:-

i) Two seats be kept reserved for such I-Card Holders in every Volvo/AC Bus.

ii) If web enabled reservation is in place, the reservation be made available from any point to any point on the route.

iii) If web enabled reservation is not in place but at any point, after the departure a vacant seat is available, it will preferably be allotted to such I-Card holders.
