FOREWORD

The Ministry of Panchayati Raj is mandated with the task of accelerating an enabling environment for Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) to bring about sustainable and inclusive development of the rural areas of the country. It has been recognized that participatory local self- government with accountability is the key to efficient delivery of services for social and economic change to make a visible impact on the lives of our rural brethren.

Our Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has clearly demarcated the roadmap for a strong and empowered India with good governance being the key to enable our country to take its rightful place in the comity of nations. Heading to his clarion call of Gramoday se Bharatoday, a silent revolution is in the making with PRIs in various parts of the country taking the initiative towards attaining accomplishments in different sectors and thereby contributing to making a marked difference in the socio-economic lives of people in their respective areas.

The Ministry incentivizes PRIs who have contributed immensely towards this end by awarding such Panchayats through a rigorous process of scrutiny. This year 30,000 Panchayats gave their nominations for the Panchayat Sashaktikaran Puraskars while about 13,000 entries were received for the Rashtriya Gaurav Gram Sabha Puraskars (RGGSP). All nominations are mandatorily received online. All nominations were scrutinized by Block, District and State level Committees set up by State Governments, whereupon the awardees were finalized from among the shortlisted panels after thorough reviews by National Field Level Agencies.

A notable feature this year is to name the Panchayat Sashaktikaran Puraskars after late Sri Deen Dayal Upadhyay, noted philosopher, economist, sociologist, historian and political scientist. He is remembered for having conceived the political philosophy of Integral Humanism. He also visualized for India a decentralised polity and self-reliant economy with the village as the base.

The Rashtriya Gaurav Gram Sabha Puraskars are being named after the notable social worker Padma Vibhushan late Sri Nanaji Deshmukh who devoted his life for upliftment of the rural poor. He established the Gramodaya Vishwavidyalaya at Chitrakoot (UP) and worked tirelessly in the fields of rural education, agriculture, rural health and cottage industry to transform rural economy into a self-reliant and compassionate example for the world to follow.

This year 189 PRIs are being awarded the Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay Panchayat Sashaktikaran Puraskars and 20 PRIs have been selected for the Nanaji Deshmukh Rashtriya Gaurav Gram Sabha Puraskars. 4 States viz. Karnataka, Kerala, West Bengal and Sikkim are being conferred e-Panchayat Puraskars for effective adoption, usage and encouragement of Panchayats in e-enablement.

The awardees deserve accolades and I hope that all Panchayats and States would continue their efforts towards building a strong base for grass-root democracy that will create an ecosystem of overall good governance.

DEEN DAYAL UPADHYAY (1916-1968)



Sri Deen Dayal Upadhyay was born on September 25, 1916 in the village of Nagla Chandrabani in Mathura District. Sri Upadhyay moved to Agra to pursue M.A. Later, he established the publishing house 'Rashtra Dharma Prakashan' in Lucknow and launched the monthly magazine 'Rashtra Dharma'. Later he launched the weekly 'Panchjanya' and still later the daily 'Swadesh'.

A profound philosopher, organiser and a leader with high standards of personal integrity, he has been the source of ideological guidance and moral inspiration for the public. His treatise Integral Humanism provides a holistic alternative perspective for political action and statecraft consistent with the laws of creation and the universal needs of the human race.

NANAJI DESHMUKH (1916-2010)



Chandikadas Amritrao Deshmukh, also known as Nanaji Deshmukh was a social activist from India. He worked in the fields of education, health, and rural self-reliance, and was honoured with the Padma Vibhushan by the Government of India. He was also a member of the Rajya Sabha. He was born on October 11, 1916 at Kadoli, a small town in Parbhani district of Maharashtra.

Nanaji actively participated in Bhoodan Movement started by Vinoba Bhave. By spending two months with Vinoba ji, he was inspired by the success and appeal of the movement. When Jai Prakash Narayan ji gave the call for "Total Revolution" he responded by giving total support to this movement. After retirement from active politics, Nanaji devoted his entire time to Deen Dayal Research Institute that he himself established way back in 1969. He also established Chitarkoot Gramodya Vishwavidyalaya, India's first rural university and was its first Chancellor.

PANCHAYAT AWARDS - 2017

There are about 2.55 lakh Panchayats: 2,48,160 Gram Panchayats (GPs), 6,284 Intermediate Panchayats (IPs) and 595 District Panchayats (DPs) across the country. These Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) have differential performance based on size, staff available, functions exercised, resource available, capacity built, leadership and In spite of constraints and limitations, there are many outstanding performances among Panchayats all over the country. To build models and to nurture schools of practice, such Panchayats need to be identified and encouraged. This is achieved through awareness and incentivisation. Similarly, elected district/ village councils in North-East States also need to be incentivized, to give due recognition to grassroots democratization undertaken.

Due recognition of PRIs that perform their role well and correct feedback to those that do not, can (a) be an incentive for PRI representatives to improve PRI performance, (b) bring the issue of PRI performance into prominence and focus the attention of policymakers and (c) encourage State Governments to develop their systems of assessment and encouragement.

Ministry of Panchayati Raj (MoPR) has been incentivizing best performing Panchayats and also documenting their best practices since 2011-12 under Panchayat Empowerment and Accountability Incentive Scheme (PEAIS). Since 2013-14, it has been a part of Rajiv Gandhi Panchayat Sashaktikaran Abhiyan (RGPSA). Presently under the "Incentivization of Panchayats" Scheme, the awards are given on the National Panchayati Raj Day celebrated on 24th of April every year. This incentivization encourages Panchayat representatives who make special efforts; creates models for the Panchayats and Gram Sabhas to follow and focuses public attention on good performers, which encourages all Panchayats to improve their performance. Finally, this creates an eco-system for overall good governance at the local level.

Categories of Panchayat Awards:

1. e-Panchayat Puraskar

e-Panchayat Puraskar is given to incentivize States/UTs to adopt and implement the PES Applications, automate the internal workflow processes of Panchayats and equivalent Rural Local Governments, enable electronic delivery of services making them more transparent, accountable and effective as organs of decentralized self-governing institutions through adoption & implementation of the e-Panchayat Applications. The States for this year's e-Pursakar has been grouped into two categories -- those States/ UTs which have won e-Panchayt Puraskar in the previous year(s) as category-I and those States which have not won e-Panchayat Puraskar so far constitute category-II. This was done to make the competition more intense. The States are evaluated on the following basis:

- i. Performance of the States / UTs with respect to their actual usage of the PES Applications viz accounting, planning, monitoring of works, electronic

delivery of services, social audit, etc. Weightage is also given to corresponding State specific applications.

- ii. Innovative Measures taken by States/UTs for rollout of e-Panchayat MMP and operationalization of any State-specific software application for Panchayats.

It was decided to retain most of the existing performance parameters as it gave a true picture of actual utilization of PES Applications. However, changes in weightage were accorded to areas of focus to certain Applications. Since few States have their own state specific applications with similar functionalities as that of PES Applications; weightage to those state specific applications has also been provided. In addition to these performance assessment parameters; States/UTs are also evaluated on the basis of Innovative and Incremental measures undertaken by them for arranging infrastructure, computers, network and trained manpower for PRIs and the quality of the data entered in the respective PES Applications. The attributes of data quality identified are completeness, accuracy, authenticity and frequent updation.

2. **Nanaji Deshmukh Rashtriya Gaurav Gram Sabha Puraskars (NDRGGSPs)** have been instituted in the year 2010 in order to incentivize, appreciate and encourage the Gram Panchayats of the country, for outstanding performance, through effective Gram Sabhas, especially in respect of creating improvements in the social and economic structure of the village. The main objective of instituting this award is to strengthen the institution of Gram Sabha and to highlight it as the institution for people's participation, collective decisions and social audit. From the year 2017, Rashtriya Gaurav Gram Sabha Puraskar has been renamed as Nanaji Deshmukh Rashtriya Gaurav Gram Sabha Puraskar.
