Government of Maharashtra has issued GR no. BPDP-2021/PRA.KRA 21/PARA-6, Dated 1.11.2021, regarding detailed guidelines for preparation of BPDP and DPDP

A. Process of BPDP

1. Constitution of Panchayat Samiti Planning Committee under Chairmanship of Saphapati and with upsabhapathi, 1/5th Zilla Parishad Members, All Block Level HoDs, All Block Level Line Dept. HoDs, One Sarpanch from each ZP Constituency, Two Chairperson of SHG federation, Expert in Sanitation and Environment, Chairman APMC, Lead Bank Representative as members and Block Development Officer as a member secretary
2. The Sectoral Working Groups on Following Sectors.
 1. Resource Development and Water Resources
 2. Economic Development and Income Growth, Poverty Eradication, Livelihood & Skill Development
 3. Education
 4. Women and Child Development
 5. Social Security and Social Justice
 6. Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Agri related activities
 7. Health
 8. Infrastructure Development
 9. Environment and Climate Change

3. Sectoral Working Group is constituted under Chairmanship of Block Panchayat Member with one Expert in concerned sector, two GP Sarpanch we have done excellent work in the sector as a members and concerned Block Panchayat Level HoDs as member secretary.
4. Sectoral Working Group will collect all the necessary information from different sources, surveys related to their sector, analyze it and prepare detailed report and submit to the Block Panchayat Samiti
5. The committee under chairmanship of Block Development Officer will collect reports from all the sectoral working groups and will scrutinize and consolidate all the report.
6. The consolidated reports from all SWGs will be submitted to Panchayat Samiti Planning Committee.
7. Sectoral Working Group will give presentation on there sectoral report to the Panchayat Samiti Planning Committee
8. After Presentation of all the committees, considering available funds for planning, Needs and Necessities and different sectors the priorities of different activities are finalized in Panchayat Samiti Planning Committee and draft Block Development Plan is prepared.
9. This draft Block Development Plan is technically scrutinized by a district level committee under chairmanship of Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad.
10. After technical scrutiny, Draft Block Development Plan is further discussed in and final approval is given by Panchayat Samiti Meeting.



B. Process of DPDP

1. Constitution of Zilla Parishad Planning Committee under Chairmanship of Prsident, Zilla Parishad and with Vice President Zilla Parishad, CEO, Zilla Parishad, Chairpersons of all Sectoral Working Groups, Two Zilla Parishad Members, Sabhapati, Block Panchayat, One Sarpanch from each Block, District Planning Officer, Forest Officer, Superintendent of Agriculture Officer, Chairman APMC , Lead Bank Representative as members, Expert in Sanitation, One Professor of Economics, All District Level HoDs and Addtl. Chief Executive Officer as a member secretary
2. The Sectoral Working Groups on Following Sectors.
 1. Public Administration, Financial Statistics & Records
 2. Processing and Marketing
 3. Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Fisheries
 4. Financial Development and Income Generation, Small & Micro Industries etc.

4. Sectoral Working Group will collect all the necessary information from different sources, surveys related to their sector, analyze it and prepare detailed report and submit to the Zilla Parishad
5. The committee under chairmanship of Addtl. Chief Executive Officer will collect reports from all the sectoral working groups and will scrutinize and consolidate all the report.
6. The consolidated reports from all SWGs will be submitted to Zilla Parishad Planning Committee.
7. Sectoral Working Group will give presentation on their sectoral report to the Zilla Parishad Planning Committee
8. After Presentation of all the committees, considering available funds for planning, Needs and Necessities and different sectors the priorities of different activities are finalized in Zilla Parishad Planning Committee and draft Zilla Parishad Development Plan is prepared.
9. This draft Zilla Parishad Development Plan is technically scrutinized by a district level committee under chairmanship of Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad.
9. After technical scrutiny, Draft Zilla Parishad Development Plan is further discussed in and final approval is given by Zilla Parishad General Body Meeting.

Recommendation from States on Draft Report on Project Driven BPDP and DPDP

1. Chapter 5 DPDP needs to revise (a) Detailed formation of DPDP Committee given in Chapter 6 logically should be in chapter 5. Bring the composition of DPDP table in chapter 5. (b) need to highlight and suggest the ways to bring out coordination and convergence between DPDP planning under FC and District planning by DPC under state budgetary allocation for harmonious district vision.
2. Chapter 6 needs to revise (a) Tables on Composition of Block and District planning committees will go in chapter 4 and 5 respectively on block and district planning to avoid repetition and longevity of the report (b) Table 6.2 and discussion followed under it in chapter 6 looks misplaced so better to make it more logical or remove from there (c) Discussion at 6.2 on focus areas of planning to be make more detailed in line with 9 thematic areas considering the VISION it aims to achieve, e.g. theme 1 poverty free village has 'social protection' as major area of focus but it is not reflected in the discussion. Similarly theme 3 on CFP major aspects of child protection and participation is missing which is critical to address. So all thematic areas need to address this aspect so as to leaving out critical areas from planning at block and district
