





Recommendation from States on Draft Report on Project Driven BPDP and DPDP

- Prioritization of initiatives based on plan rather than based on the project to create greater impact
- Ensuring regular meetings of planning committees and working groups at District and Block levels
- Evidence based planning based on data-collection and data-analysis from the field offices and databases of grassroots institutions such as AWC, CHC, PHC, Schools etc.
- Considering block as a unit of development when preparing BPDPs
