- ➤ Linking of work included in BPDP & DPDP which require land with the GATI Shakti Portal for a seamless execution
- ➤ Listing of works included in BPDP & DPDP on portal which can be accessed by Companies wanting to execute under CSR or NRIs wanting to implement projects in their native village
- ➤ Classification of executable works into Priority and Non-Priority Ensuring 75% Grant Allocation to Priority Works and 25% to Non-Priority Works
