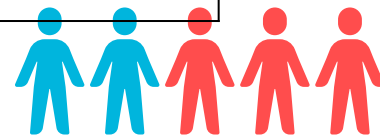

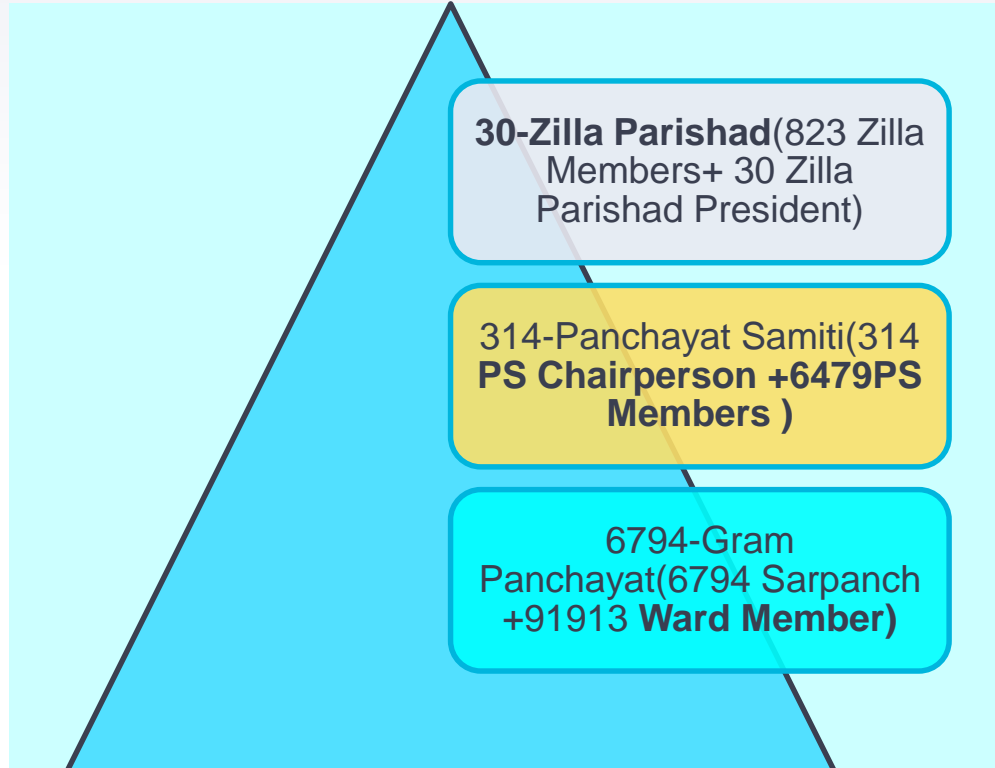

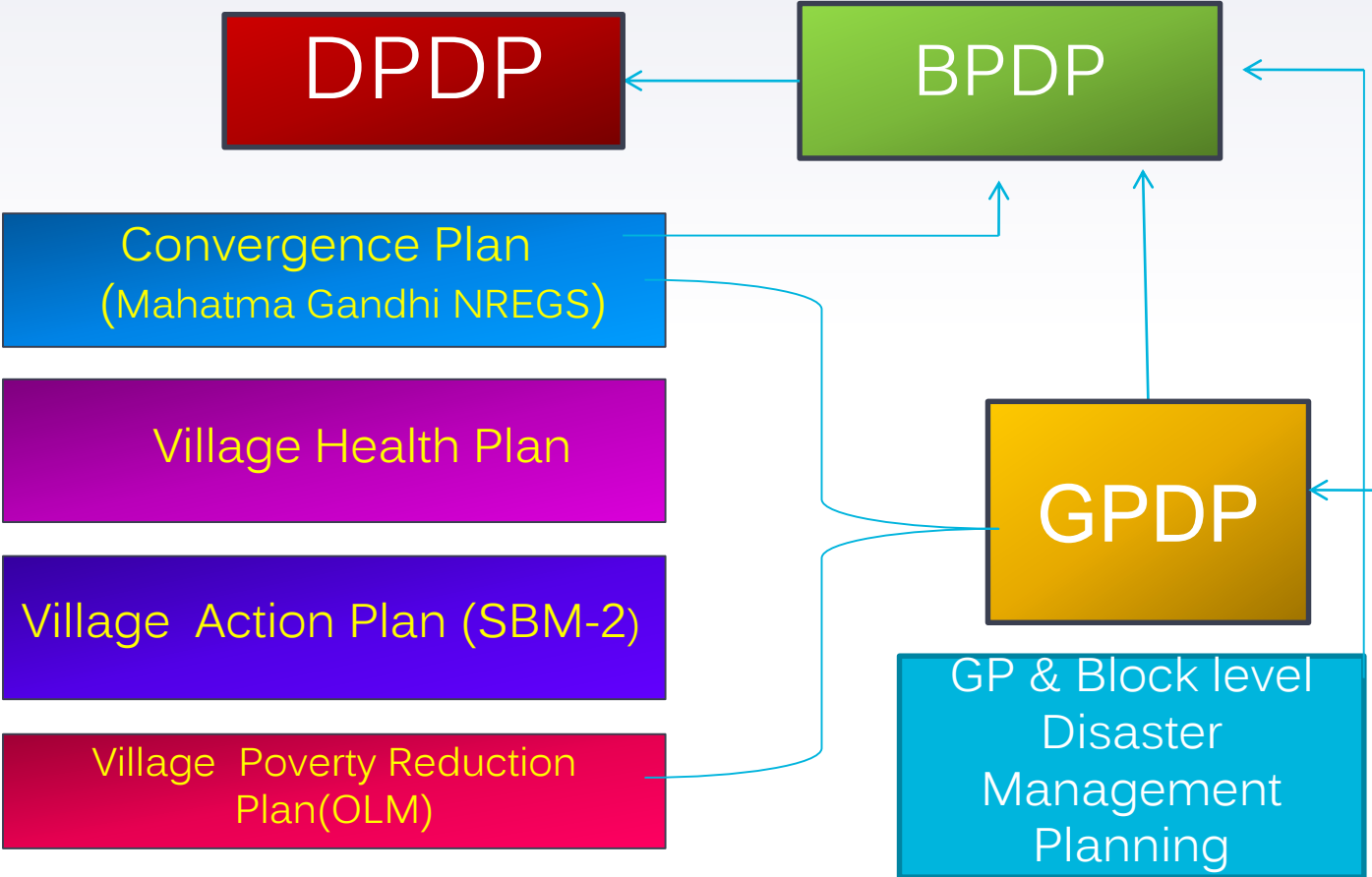

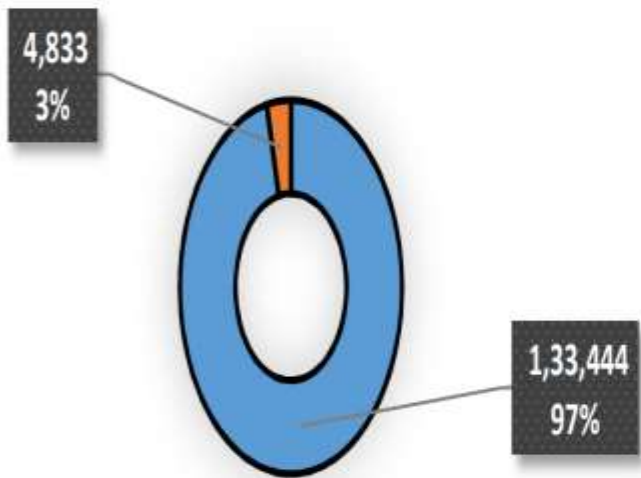

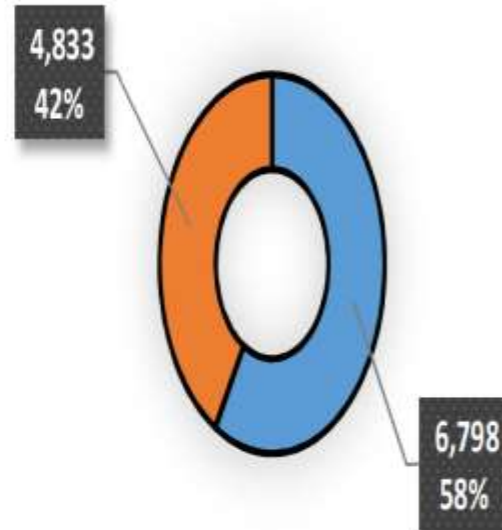
Sankalp GPs in Odisha vs ROI

GP adopting Sankalp vs Total GPs in OD

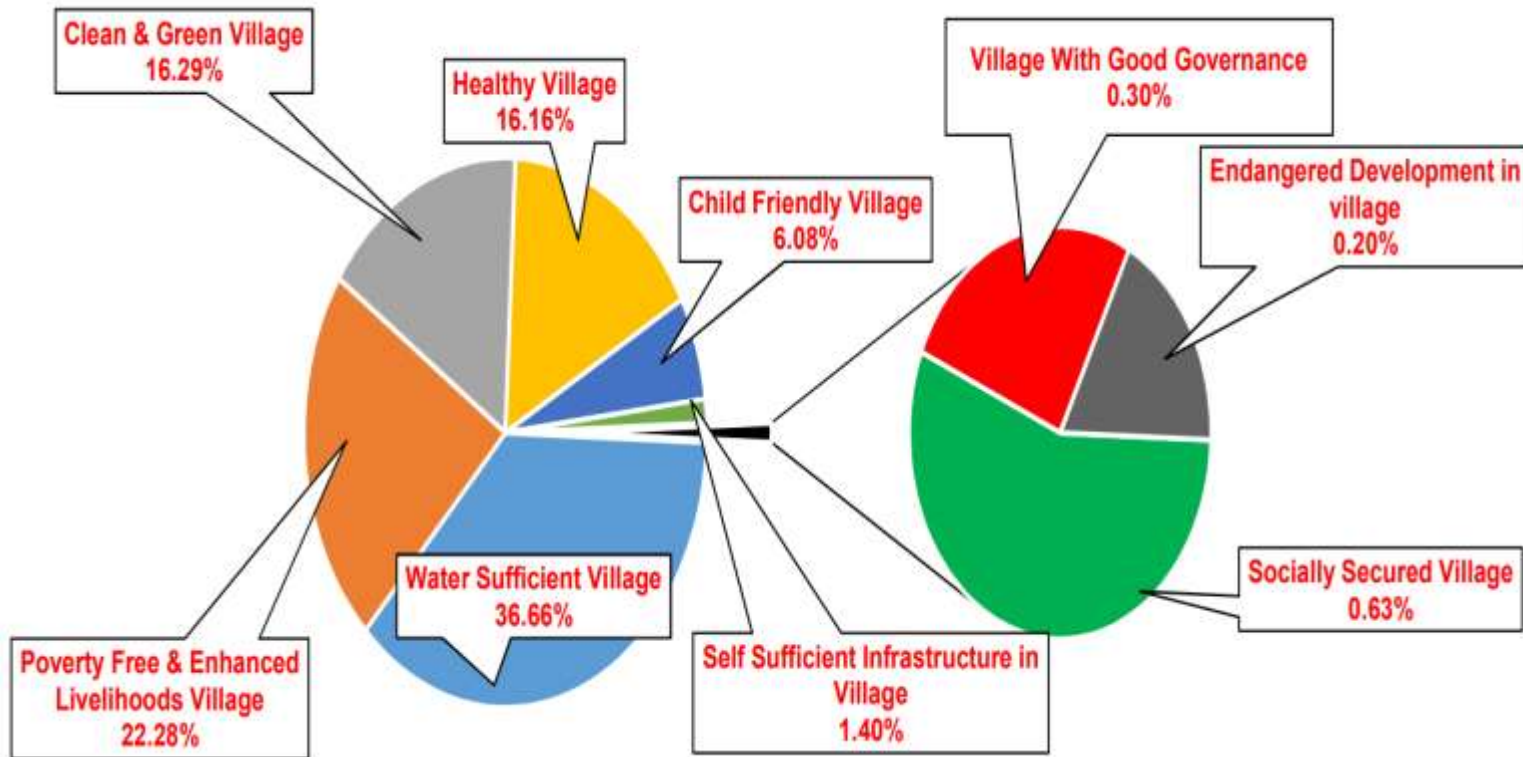

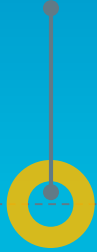
