
### State Policy and Institutional Mechanism

- Planning department has published one advisory which is named as Vision 2030.
- State Panchayat Department has drafted one advisory on LSDGs.
- Indicators (224 nos.) and targets have been identified for 9 themes.
- Steering Committee is already been formed under the chairmanship of Principal Secretary.
- Committee will be set up at each level e.g. District, Block and GP level.
- Standing Committees at Zilla Parishad, Panchayat Samity and Gram Panchayat will be assigned responsibilities.
- · For expert suggestions, tied up with different agencies like Tripura University (a Central University), Agartala Government Medical College, NIT Agartala, ICMR.
- Special steps are taken to sensitize the line departments.


