




Block/District/State level Awardees under revamped National Panchayat Awards

- National Average participation for last 3 years was just 14.20%
- Earlier around 300-325 National Panchayat Awards were given to Panchayati Raj Institutions under 4 categories
- Under revamped National Panchayat Awards all (around 2.56 lakhs) GPs have to participate under all 9 thematic award
- Accordingly, exponential number of awardees are expected at various levels



- 2) Questionnaire based ranking of **all** GPs (each theme)
- 3) Field verification of top three ranking GPs (each theme) by BPPACs
- 4) Selecting top-three GPs as **Block Level Awardees** as per ranking
- 5) Nominating top three ranking GPs (**Block Level Awardees**) for District level Awards (each theme)

Similar process would be followed by Districts and States for finally forwarding the nominations for National Level Awards

Minimum Qualifying Marks:

Gram Panchayats = 50%.

Block/District level = 70%.

States may relax the criteria for selection of best performing GPs/BPs/DPs and felicitating them in a manner deemed fit in case no GP/BP/DP fulfils prescribed criteria for National Level Awards.





BPs and DPs will be assessed on basis of:

- 80% on the basis of average score of all its concerned GPs under that particular theme
- **20%:** DPDP 2023-24 to be uploaded; At least 50% of DP resources for concerned theme; 50% of funds on other LSDG themes.
