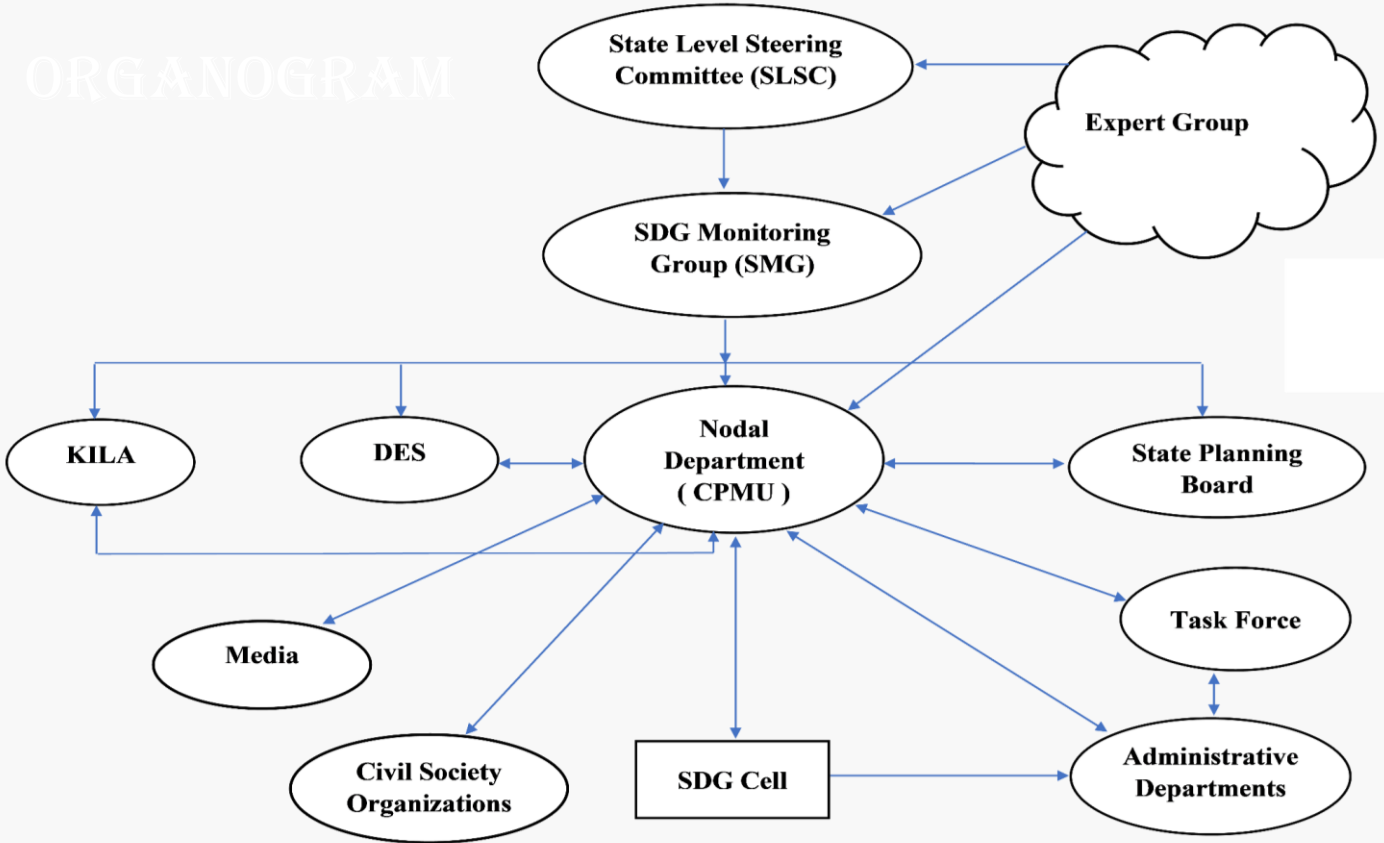

Interlinkages of SDGs and Convergence

- They are Ex-officio secretaries and implementing officers of the Panchayat
- Reporting to Panchayats
- Convenors of the Thematic Working Groups
- Resources converged at the Panchayat level
- Coordination Committee at the State level headed by the Minister LSGs and respective secretaries, meeting every two weeks.
- This is an empowered committee. They can invite other secretaries also.

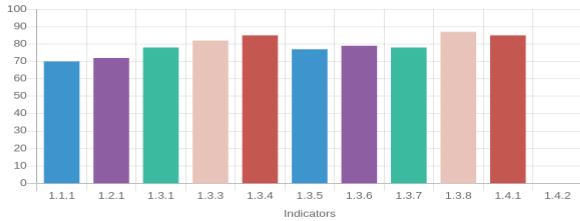

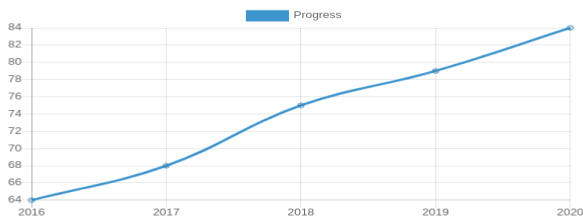

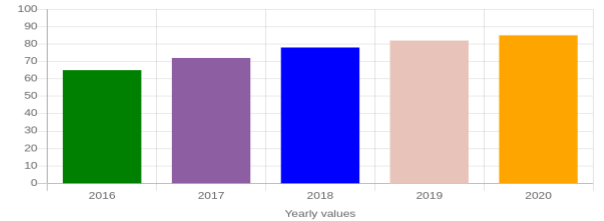
