As a continuous endeavor of this Ministry to enhance the systems, eGramSwaraj has now been successfully integrated with GeM so that the Panchayats at all tiers are enabled for; procurement through GeM and payments through eGramSwaraj in a seamless manner. This will allow local producers/cooperatives/artisans/Self Help Groups etc. to sell their products to Government entities directly thereby promoting the spirit of "Vocal for Local". This will further help reduce the carbon footprint too as products can be procured through local vendors rather than being shipped of from far off locations.
- 3. This integration has several benefits as it will introduce transparency in procurement by the Panchayats as all the purchases under GeM strictly comply with General Financial Rules, 2017. eGS-GeM interface will enable the PRIs to ensure transparency in their procurements and also ensure that goods/services are procured at standardized market prices. This will not only mitigate the chances of arbitrary award of contracts but also keep a check on procurement of items at inflated rates. The GeM based procurement is likely to be mandated in near future; so it is best to be not caught unawares.
- 4. Earlier, MoPR had issued a letter of even number dated 24thAugust, 2022 (*Annexure I*) to Additional Chief Secretary, Panchayati Raj Department or equivalent regarding onboarding the Panchayats in your State on eGramSwaraj-GeM (eGS-GeM) interface. In this regard, details regarding Panchayat functionaries of your State need to be uploaded on eGramSwaraj followed by a pilot project.
- 5. In the light of above, I request you to direct the concerned officials to expedite the pilot project and then subsequently roll out this interface in all Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) of your State. As you are aware, Ministry of Panchayati Raj (MoPR) has rolled out a new feature which enables the Panchayats to utilize the services of GeM (Government e Marketplace) portal for the procurement of their goods and services while seamlessly accounting for the same in eGramSwaraj.

- 2. Towards this end integration between eGramSwaraj and GeM has already been completed and a workshop on this has been conducted at NIC-MoPR, New Delhi during 12 to 13th May 2022. MoPR has rolled out a massive rollout program to enable the functionaries to utilize the features of eGS GeM interface. In this regard following activities need to be completed:
 - 1. Upload of data by States for Government email id creation

2. Selection and Sharing of Pilot Panchayats' data

- 3. Conducting training in GeM at the State level in consultation with the respective GeM state coordinator
- 4. Conducting Pilot in the selected Panchayat

State-wise status on the above points may be seen at Annexure 1.

3. Data pertaining to point 2.1 above is being uploaded by all States. However, it is mandatory that all States nominate a Delegated Admin (DA) to manage the email ids at the State level only once they are created. The SoP for the same may be seen at Annexure 2. It is requested that the details (as per format in Annexure 2) of the DA are shared with MoPR and NIC-MoPR at joshi.sk@nic.in and mohlt.gupta20@nic.in by 31 August 2022. Further, States who are yet to share the data of pilot Panchayats and conduct the training related to GeM in their States may do so before the target date mentioned in Annexure 1. It may be mentioned here that the progress on these parameters is being monitored by Prime Minister's Office and hence may be accorded Top Priority.

- 4. Contact NIC State coordinator for issuance of VPN IP for "Delegated Administrator" role for the nominated officer. (Attached Process can be downloaded from https://vpn.nic.in Manual --> VPN Applying Procedure New VPN request).
- 5. During submission of VPN request, DA user needs to follow:
 - a. VPN Services -> New Request -> Fill following details for NIC E-mail Group activation on DA's VPN
 - b. Choose Single IP
 - i. Enter Server IP: 164.100.14.22
 - ii. Application URL: https://mailadmin.nic.in
 - iii. Destination Port; 443
 - iv. Server Location: NDC Delhi
 - v. Enter Captcha and submit
 - vi. Details will be forwarded by NIC State coordinator to NIC Delhi email team
 - vii. On Approval, DA will get Private Key on Mobile and VPN certificate on E-mail ID. DA need to configure VPN Certificate on desktop/Laptop using the Manual --> For configuring the VPN on Window 8 & 10.
- 6. Open https://eforms.nic.in -> Login with eforms using government email id and password
- 7. Select DA Onboarding from Left Grid/Menu.
- 8. Enter VPN IP allocated and submit for approval
- 9. Approval of the same shall be done by NIC Delhi email team.
