Significance of 23rd March in Indian Freedom Movement : Shaheed Diwas – 23rd March 1931 is remembered as the day when three brave freedom fighters namely Bhagat Singh, Shivaram Rajguru and Sukhdev Thapar were hanged by the British.

Objective: Jan Sanvaad (जन संवाद) and Jan Jagran (जन जागरण) about various facets of Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav in all villages under the jurisdiction of Panchayati Raj Institutions across the country for ensuring Jan Bhagidaari (जन भागीदारी) in 75-week long Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav.

Proposed activities during **Week 3** [26.03.2021 – 01.04.2021] for Panchayati Raj institutions to conduct Awareness Campaign involving officials/ functionaries of the concerned / line Department to discuss and sensitize the villagers regarding the initiatives / schemes relating to **Agriculture**, including **agricultural extension** as listed among 29 subjects/ matters in the Eleventh Schedule of the Constitution of India with an aim to achieve Aatmanirbhar Panchayat:

Objective: At the core of Self-Reliant India (Aatmanirbhar Bharat) is a village and agrobased economy, and making farmers self-reliant has been a cornerstone of the Aatmanirbhar Bharat campaign. Panchayati Raj Institutions may conduct awareness campaigns/ activities to inform every villagers / farmers regarding planning, implementation and monitoring of agricultural programmes targeted for rural areas and benefits under these Schemes with an aim to achieve Aatmanirbhar Panchayat.
