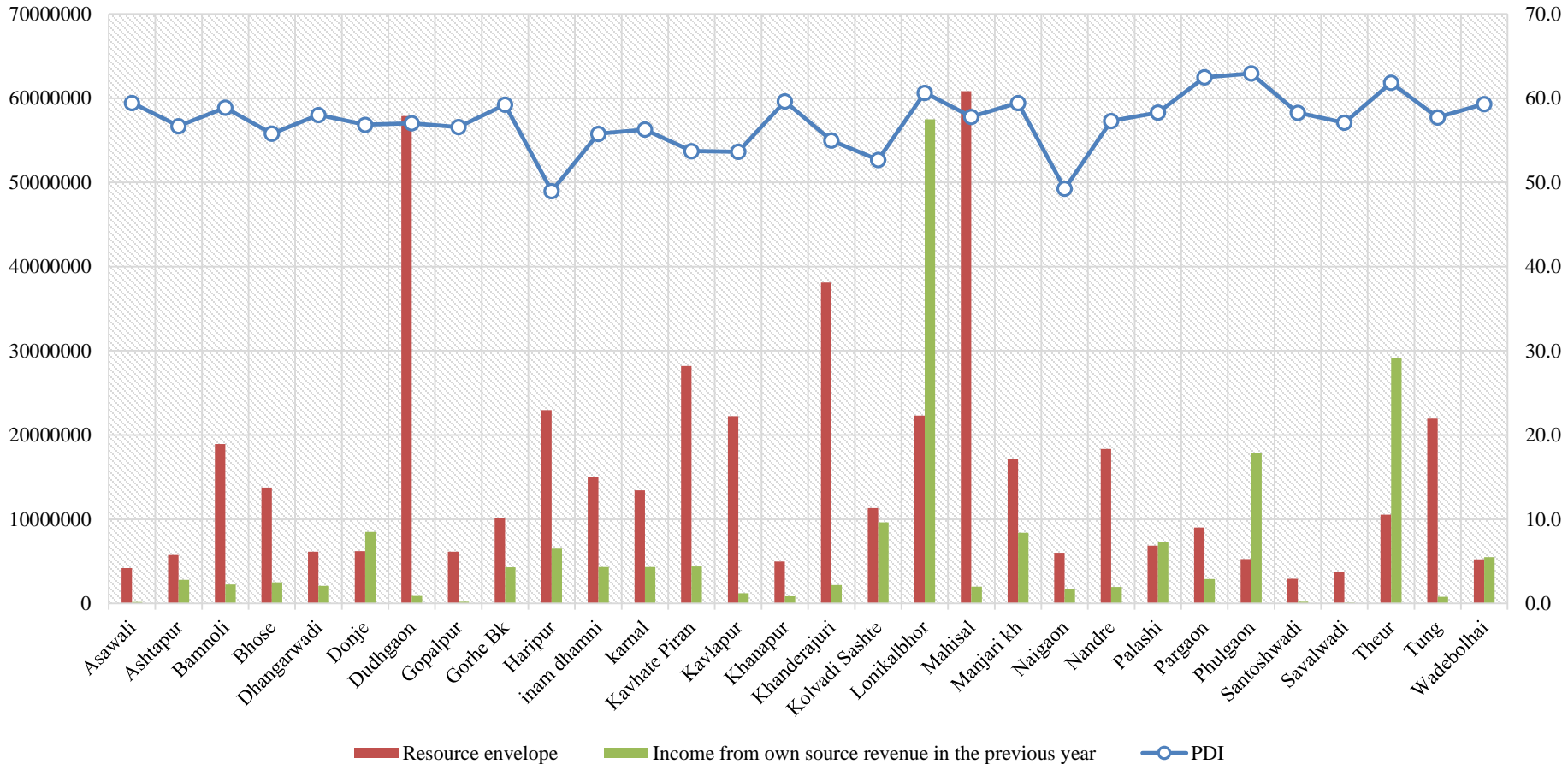

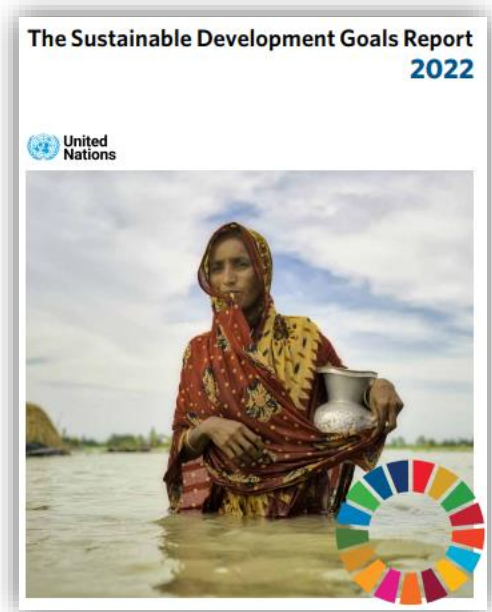

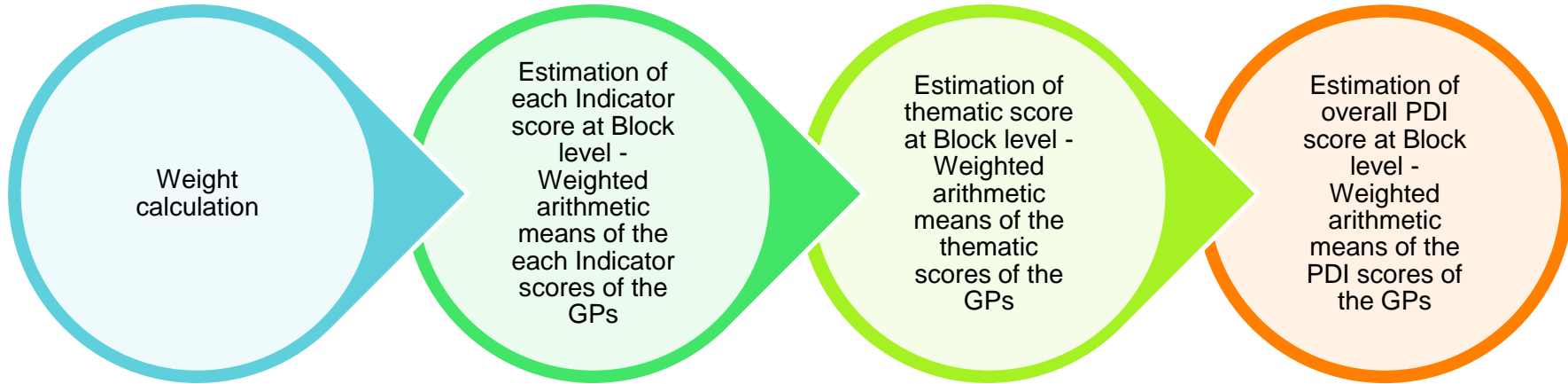

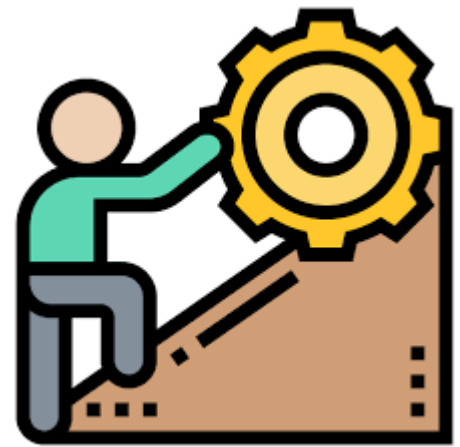
# PDI – Challenge and Limitation

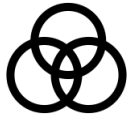
