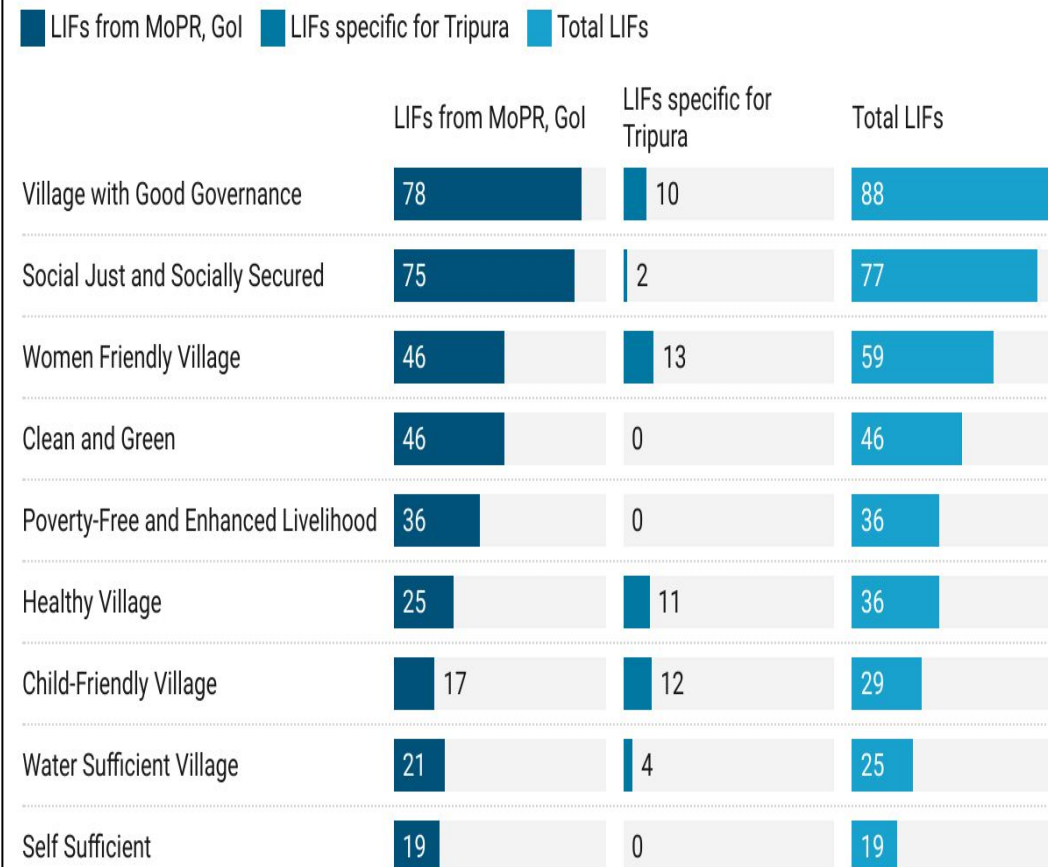
Strategy- LSDGs and preparation of LIFs in Tripura

- ❑ The Rural Local Bodies in Tripura were motivated to participate in the development of Local Indicator Frameworks for the LSDGs along with active participation of Blocks and Panchayat Raj Training Institutes.
 - ❑ Each faculty member of PRTI's, initially oversaw five Gram Panchayats from different Blocks. Their extensive field-level involvement revealed certain gaps.
 - ❑ Following an in-depth analysis of RLB realities & utilizing the Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Government of India indicators, many additional state-specific indicators were introduced.

- ❑ Planning department has published one advisory which is named **Vision 2030**.
 - ❑ The State Policy on LSDGs keeping parity with the MoPR, GoI guidelines has been drafted.
 - ❑ Steering Committee is already been formed under the chairmanship of the Secretary.
 - ❑ Standing Committees at Zilla Parishad, Panchayat Samity, and Gram Panchayat have been formed with assigned responsibilities.
 - ❑ For expert suggestions, tied up with different agencies like Tripura University (a Central University), Agartala Government Medical College, NIT Agartala, etc. have already been done.

- Each indicator will have the same weightage.

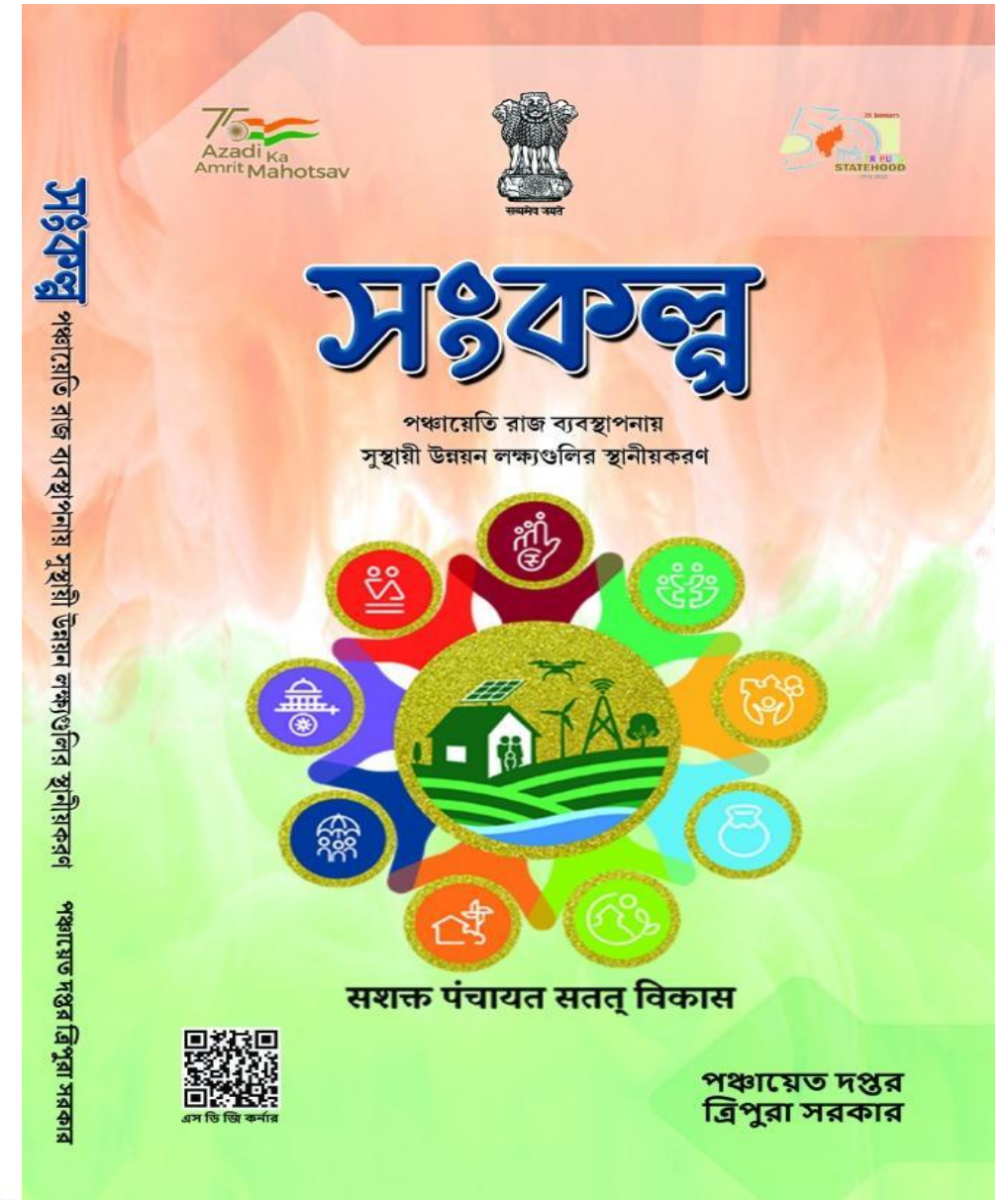

Special initiatives so far..

- ❑ Special mentorship drive has been taken up by engaging all the faculties of the Panchayat Raj Training Institutes. As a way forward two major gaps have been identified:
 - ❑ Lack of records.
 - ❑ The line department employees of all the departments are not present.
 - ❑ Ten block-level master trainers have been identified per block and the first phase of their training has already been done. The second phase will commence shortly.
 - ❑ The Government is planning to develop one dashboard to monitor the progress of achieving the LSDGs which is in the initial phase.
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Innovative approach

- ❑ The RD (Panchayat) Department has distributed a Bengali book called "Sankalp" to all blocks and districts to clarify LSDGs.
- ❑ Tripura University's Department of Rural Studies will assist 428 Gram Panchayats in drafting LSDG-backed GPDPs.
- ❑ The Tripura Rural Livelihood Mission has been tagged to include SHG-related components in the LSDG-backed GPDP.
- ❑ A repository was created for all blocks to create a video on the finest LSDG models.

- ❑ It is a web-based platform for grievance redressal.
- ❑ To raise & report various issues of rural people related to various Departments.
- ❑ To ensure efficient monitoring and effective implementation of various Govt. Schemes (Both State & Central).
- ❑ The problems/ grievances/ issues faced by people will be identified by the RPM/PS/VS/RPS/GRS with a photograph
- ❑ They will opt for two modes - (i) Village Walk & (ii) Amar Sarkar Day, to identify the issues.
- ❑ These issues in the portal will be tagged with the concerned line Department.
- ❑ The issue requires to be addressed in the system with relevant photographs.
- ❑ It is helping to assess the goals of development – a tool for LSDG
